The IP as enclosed with the tender is to be submitted (duly signed by authorized signatory) along with techno-commercial bid (Part-I). Only those bidders who have entered into such an IP with BHEL would be competent to participate in the bidding. In other words, entering into this pact would be a preliminary qualification. Please refer Section-8 of IP for Role and Responsibilities of IEMs. In case of any complaint arising out of the tendering process, the matter may be referred to the any of the IEMs mentioned in the NIT. All correspondence with the IEMs shall be done through email only.

Note: - No routine correspondence shall be addressed to the IEM (phone/ post/ email) regarding the clarifications, time extensions or any other administrative queries, etc. on the tender issued. All such clarification/ issues shall be addressed directly to the tender issuing (procurement) department officials whose contact details are provided in this NIT.

23. Bidders who fulfil TECHNICAL & FINANCIAL PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT CRITERIA are eligible to participate in this tender. Bidders are requested to provide the details as per "TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS". Bids of only those bidders shall be evaluated who meet the Technical as well as Financial Pre-Qualifying requirements.

24. Tender Evaluation - Evaluation will be done on overall L1 (Total Cost to BHEL excluding GST) basis for complete scope of the tender with necessary loading as applicable.

25. Latest Update	All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extensions, clarifications, etc to the tender will be hosted on BHEL website (www.bhel.com), https://bhel.abcpurchase.com & BHEL-PEM website (www.bhelpem.com). Bidders should regularly visit websites to keep themselves updated.
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26. Integrity commitment, performance of the contract and punitive action thereof:

26.1 Commitment by BHEL:

BHEL commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption in connection with the tender process and execution of the contract. BHEL will during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) in a transparent and fair manner, and with equity.

26.2 Commitment by Bidder/ Supplier/ Contractor:

26.2.1 The bidder/ supplier/ contractor commit to take all measures to prevent corruption and will not directly or indirectly influence any decision or benefit which he is not legally entitled to nor will act or omit in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India.

26.2.2 The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract and shall adhere to relevant guidelines issued from time to time by Govt. of India/ BHEL.

26.2.3 The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasonable cause, which causes loss of business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL.



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If any bidder/ supplier/ contractor during pre-tendering/ tendering/ post tendering/ award/ execution/ post-execution stage indulges in mal-practices, cheating, bribery, fraud or and other misconduct or formation of cartel so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price or acts or omits in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India, then, action may be taken against such bidder/ supplier/ contractor as per extant guidelines of the company available on www.bhel.com and/or under applicable legal provisions”.

27. Deviations (Commercial as well as Technical) from NIT are generally not acceptable. In case of deviations from NIT, the tenderer shall give cost of withdrawal of such deviation as per Annexure-II of GCC Rev-06 along with reasons for taking such deviations.

28. Bidder is requested to quote their best competitive prices. “BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit ‘Process compliance form’ (to the designated service provider) as well as ‘Online sealed bid’ in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of ‘Process compliance form’ or ‘Online sealed bid’ by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer (Through e-procurement). **The price bid (Through e-procurement) of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & price through e-procurement) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.**

If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to price bid (Through e-procurement) for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).”

29. In case there is no change in the technical scope and / or specification and / or commercial terms and conditions, the bidder/s shall not be allowed to change his / their price bids after the due date within the validity period.

30. If any bidder has mentioned the term Not Applicable / Not required / Not Quoted in BHEL price format, the same to be substantiated by the bidder. If such item is required to be supplied for system completion in future, same will be supplied free of cost by Vendor.

31. Purchaser shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other tender and shall be entitled to accept or reject any/all tender(s) in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.

32. Tenderers must enclose the Quality Plan in the prescribed format, for approval. Equipment will be despatched only after Purchaser’s/Owner’s inspection at the hold points specified in the approved Quality Plan and issue of Material Despatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC).

34. Foreign and indigenous bidders participating in subject tender will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs (Digital Signature Certificate) issued by the certifying authorities in India. 35. Important Details for Foreign Bidder- • Bill of Lading shall be considered as equivalent document (refer clause 9.7.1 b) for recognition of despatch. • For claiming payment under clause 9.1.1, 9.2.1 and 9.3.1 Bill of lading shall be considered instead of receipted LR (refer clause 9.7.2 b) • Freight is to be quoted as inclusive in basic price by vendor and is not to be asked separately. • There will be no change in MRC payment.	
36. Bidder to note that this is an Open Tender enquiry & price bid (Part-II) opening/RA participation shall be subject to following condition: a) Techno-commercial recommendation of bidder by the BHEL-PEM. b) Approval of bidder by End Customer. Same shall be taken up with end customer based on the latest credentials/reference list furnished by bidder. Accordingly, bidders are requested to submit credential as per the format enclosed (attachment 3K) herewith along with their technical bid. The bidders who are not registered with BHEL-PEM may apply for registration in BHEL-PEM through Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com-->vendor section-->online supplier registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed & stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website & submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed & stamped has to be submitted.	
37. The Bidder along with its associate/ collaborators/ sub-contractors/ sub-vendors/ consultants/ service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL Fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website http://www.bhel.com and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice."	
38. BGs should be in favour of BHEL-PSNR in place of PEM. L1 Vendor will be required to submit BGs as per GCC Rev-06. Refer enclosed BG format to NIT for BG Submission instead of format mentioned in GCC Rev 06.	
39. In case of joint bidding Bidders to furnish scope matrix which should be clearly defined between them along with the offer for the Main Supply and Erection & Commissioning.	
40. The Deed of Joint Undertaking should be submitted at the time of placement of order on successful bidder as per Tech-PQR. In such a case, the collaborator /Associate shall be required to furnish an on demand bank Guarantee for INR 1.6 Million(Rupee one Million & six hundred thousand) at the time of placement of order in line with Tech-PQR.	
41. Bidders to note that offers shall be submitted strictly in accordance with the requirements of the all the enclosed Tender Documents. shall automatically become the part of the Order/Contract after its finalisation.	
42. Risk & cost- Additional Overhead Charges shall be 5% instead of 30% as mentioned in Clause No 26.2.of GCC Rev 06.	
43. In the event of any contradiction in the terms and conditions mentioned, the order of precedence shall be N.I.T. covering letter (including Tech Spec) followed by SCC and followed by GCC terms & Corrigendum to GCC Rev-06 which is available on www.bhelpem.com	
44. CGST/SGST/UGST/IGST shall be paid at actuals against documentary evidence but restricted to the amount and percentage as per agreed HSN/SAC Code.	
45. Over all (%) quantity variation: The variation on overall package value due to changes in the scope shall be limited to +/-10% in place of 30% mentioned in clause no 6.0 of GCC-REV-06	



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- 46. Deductibles/ EXCESS:** Following Deductibles/ EXCESS may be considered.
- a) **Marine**-Rs. 20000/-
 - b) **Storage /Erection and Testing Cover**
 - (i) Rs 2,25,000/- or 5% of the claim amount whichever is higher for Normal Period.
 - (ii) Rs 6,00,000/- or 5% of the claim amount whichever is higher for Testing Period.
 - c) **Act of God (AOG) Perils:** 10% of the claim amount subject to a minimum of testing periods excess and maximum of 5 crs per event
 - d) **Fire / Explosion Claims:** 20% of the claim amount subject to minimum of testing period excess.
 - e) **Terrorism Cover:** 5% of loss amount subject to minimum of Rs. 1,00,000/- and maximum if Rs. 2,50,00,000/- each and every loss.
 - f) **Extended Maintenance Cover/ Defect Liability Cover:** As applicable for testing period excess.
 - g) **Third Party Liability Cover:**
 - (i) The policy excesses (Normal/ Testing periods) shall apply for third party liability property damage claims also.For third party liability claims arising out of Acts of God perils, the excess applicable to AOG claims shall apply.
- 47.** For this procurement, Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 15.06.2017 & 28.05.2018 and subsequent Orders issued by the respective Nodal Ministry shall be applicable even if issued after issue of the NIT but before finalization of contract/ PO/WO against the NIT. In the event of any Nodal Ministry prescribing higher or lower percentage of purchase preference and / or local content in respect of this procurement, same shall be applicable. The package is not divisible in nature. Vendors are required to provide the following certificate along with the part-1 bid:
- (i) Provide self-certification that the item offered meets the minimum local content as per above mentioned orders.
 - (ii) Provide the details of the location(s) at which the local value addition shall be made.
- 48.** Procedure for Conciliation shall be as per BHEL Conciliation Scheme – 2018. (Available at BHEL PEM website at Vendor Section-Important Instruction for Bidders.
- 49.** Total erection & commissioning charges including GST should be minimum 20% of the total quoted package (excluding mandatory spares but including all taxes & freight), falling which the break-up of price shall be adjusted accordingly for ordering.
- 50.** MSME/Start up Vendors to submit applicable documents along with their offer for availing the benefits as per GOI guidelines. Further PEM is already registered with RXIL(TReDS) Platform. You are requested to get registered with RXIL(TReDS) platform to avail the facility as per GOI guidelines.
- 51.** Bidders must visit site/ work area and study the job content, facilities available, availability of materials, prevailing site conditions including law & order situation etc. before quoting for this tender. They may also consult this office before submitting their offers, for any clarifications regarding scope of work, facilities available at sites or on terms and conditions. No additional claim shall be entertained by BHEL in future, on account of non-acquaintance of above.
- 52.** The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list as also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL web site http://www.bhel.com/vender_registration/vender.php.
