Procurement of Integral or Deattachable Shank Hollow Tap

1. Tender Fee Deposit:

Tenderer to furnish tender fee of **Rs 500/- + GST Extra** along with Part–1: Technical-Commercial Bid of the offer.

- i. Tender Fee can be deposited online payment through SBI (SB Collect website: (<https://bpl.bhel.com/qcins/iccs.htm>))
- ii. Tender Fee is non-refundable.
- iii. If offer is received without Tender Fee, offer is liable for rejection.
- iv. Micro & Small enterprises are exempted from submission of tender fee. Traders/Agent are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises.

2. Technical Pre- Qualification Requirement (PQR) :

2. (i). **Technical (Specification cum compliance certificate):** To qualify against this tender vendor has to comply the qualifying requirement as per PQC documents ref. PQR/CTX/Hollow Tap/2020/02 dt. 24.10.20. Necessary supporting document must be attached by tenderer asked in PQR along with Part-1 (Techno –Commercial) bid. In case of non-submission of above document, the offer may be rejected.
2. (ii). **Financial:** Following documents must be furnished by bidders along with part-1 (Techno – Commercial) bid, otherwise offer is liable for rejection.

NOTE: (i) Relaxation in PQC criteria 2(ii) shall be given to bidders as per GOI guidelines policy circular no. 1(2)(1)/2016-MA dt. 10th March 2016, Circular no. F.20/2/2014-PPD (Pt.) dt. 25th July 2016, Circular no. F.20/2/2014-PPD (Pt.) dt. 20th September 2016, Circular no. 16(20)/2016-Coord dt. 28th October 2016, office memorandum F. No. 1(2)(1)/2016-MA dt. 09.02.2017 and F.20-2/2014-PPD (Pt.) dt. 27th July 2017.

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3. **Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):** If the bidder wants to avail the benefit, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders/Agent are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. Following Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid.

(i) Udyog Aadhar Memorandum/NSIC Certificate/Udyam

Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of offer at par with others and MSE status of such suppliers shall be shifted to non MSE supplier.

4. **Startups bidders:** Govt. of India guidelines for Startups bidder shall be applicable for this tender. Vendors should submit the requisite document as applicable along with techno-commercial offer (part-bid). Else offer may be rejected.
5. **Un-registered/ New Vendor:** Tenderer who are participating in this enquiry and not registered with BHEL Bhopal, should apply online for registration from website (<https://supplier.bhel.in/>).
6. **Ultimately availment of credit** - If BHEL fails to avail benefit of Cenvat credit due to delay in providing documents within specified statutory time limit, attributable to the seller, such loss will be recovered from the seller.
7. **General Terms & Conditions of the enquiry (BP-200102)-** Vendor to furnish their acceptance on General Terms & Conditions of the enquiry (BP-200102) attached as annexure in NIT.
8. **Penalty for Late Delivery (LD)** : Penalty for late delivery shall be 0.5% per week of delay or part thereof, subject a maximum of 10% of the order value. In case of LD recovery, the applicable GST shall also be recoverable from the suppliers.
9. **Clause no. 2 P of General Terms & condition (GTC) of enquiry BP 200102:** In place of clause no. 2 (P) of GTC BP200102, following clause is applicable: "In the course of evaluation, if more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status, effective L-1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from the respective L-1 bidders. In case more than one bidder happens to occupy the L-1 status even after soliciting discounts, the L-1 bidder shall be decided by a toss/draw of lots, in the presence of the respective L-1 bidder(s) or their representative(s). Ranking will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situation shall be final and binding."

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10. **PPP-MII Order. (Preference to make in India):** For this procurement, the local content to categorize a supplier as a class I local supplier/ Class II local supplier/ Non local supplier and purchase preference to class I local supplier /Class II local supplier / Non –local supplier, and purchase preference to Class I local supplier, is as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) , Order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 issued by DPIIT. In case of subsequent orders issued by the nodal ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items of the NIT, the same shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT, but before opening of part-II bids against this NIT.
