SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

The tenderers must submit their tenders as a TWO part bid to Officer inviting tender as per instructions in the NIT.

Tenders submitted by post shall be sent by "REGISTERED POST ACKNOWLEDGEMENT DUE / by COURIER" and shall be posted with due allowance for any postal/courier delays. BHEL takes no responsibility for delay, loss or non-receipt of tenders sent by post/courier. The tenders received after the specified time of their submission are treated as 'Late Tenders' and shall not be considered under any circumstances.

Tenders shall be opened by authorized Officer of BHEL at his office at the time and date as specified in the NIT, in the presence of such of those tenderers or their authorized representatives who may be present.

In case of omission in quoting any rate for one or more items, the evaluation shall be done considering the highest quoted rate obtained against the respective items by other tenderers for the subject tender.

Before submission of Offer, the tenderers are advised to inspect the site of work and the environments and be well acquainted with the actual working and other prevalent conditions, facilities available, position of material and labour, means of transport and access to Site, accommodation, etc. No claim will be entertained later on the grounds of lack of knowledge of any of these conditions.

SECTION 1 GENERAL TERMS

EVALUATION OF BIDS

Technical Bids submitted by the tenderer will be opened first and evaluated for fulfilling the Pre-Qualification criteria and other conditions in NIT/Tender documents, based on documentary evidences submitted along with the offer.

Tenderers whose bids are found techno commercially qualified shall be informed the date and time of opening of the Price Bids and such Tenderers may depute their representatives to witness the opening of the price bids. BHEL"s decision in this regard shall be final and binding.

Lowest bidder will be decided on overall cost.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

Upon acceptance of Tender, the successful Tenderer should deposit Rs 2.0L (Rupees two lakhs only) as Security Deposit.

The security Deposit should be furnished before start of the work by the contractor by Pay Order / Demand Draft in favour of BHEL

Security deposit can also be recovered at the rate of 10% from the running bills. However in such cases at least 50% of the Security Deposit should be deposited in as Pay Order / Demand Draft in favour of BHEL before start of the work and the balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills.

The Security Deposit shall not carry any interest.

RETURN OF SECURITY DEPOSIT

Security Deposit shall be refunded released to the Contractor along with the "Final Bill" after deducting all expenses / other amounts due to BHEL under the contract / other contracts entered into with them by BHEL

VALIDITY OF OFFER

The rates in the Tender shall be kept open for acceptance for a minimum period of 90 days from latest due date of offer submission (including extension, if any). In case BHEL (Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd) calls for negotiations, such negotiations shall not amount to cancellation or withdrawal of the original offer which shall be binding on the tenderers.

COMMENCEMENT OF WORK

The contractor shall commence the work within one week of issue of Letter of Intent from BHEL and shall proceed with the same with due expedition without delay.

If the contractor fails to start the work within stipulated time as intimated by BHEL, then BHEL at its sole discretion will have the right to cancel the contract. The Security Deposit with BHEL will stand forfeited without any further reference to him without prejudice to any and all of BHEL's other rights and remedies in this regard.

All the work shall be carried out under the direction and to the satisfaction of BHEL.

Billing: Apart from BOS items other consumable/useable items shall be billed as actual and on submission of receipt certified by site representative on monthly basis.

<u>Payment term</u>: Payment will be made from Headquarters (Bangalore) within 30 days from the date of receipt of bills certified by BHEL's site representatives.

Payment can be released by EFT (Electronic Fund Transfer). Acceptance for this arrangement to be indicated by the contractor in his offer.

Income tax as applicable shall be deducted while releasing the payment. TDS certificate for the year will be issued in the next financial year. For this purpose contractor shall furnish photo copy of PAN card issued by Income Tax Department.

<u>Sub Contract</u>: The contractor shall not sublet any portion of the contract without written permission of BHEL's representative.

<u>Arbitration</u>: Except if otherwise provided for in the contract all questions and disputes relating to the specification, instructions, orders of the execution or failure to execute the same whether arising during the tenure of contract or on completion shall be referred to the sole arbitration of AGM/PVSS, BHEL-Electronics Division, Bangalore..

Validity: The offer submitted by the contractor shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date set for opening of tender.

Scope of work and acceptance of terms and conditions: The contractor shall himself obtain all necessary information on local conditions and factors, which may influence or affect his offer. It must be understood and agreed that such factors have been investigated and considered while submitting the offer. Neither any change in the time schedule of the contract nor any financial adjustment arising thereof shall be permitted by BHEL-EDN, which are based on the lack of such clear information or its effect on the cost of the works to the contractor.

Submission of offer by the contractor implies that he has read all the tender conditions and has made himself aware of

- the scope of work
- Specification of the work to be done
- Local conditions
- Other factors bearing on the execution of work.

Firm price: The rate quoted shall be firm throughout the tenure of the contract and shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes as may be applicable and BHEL-EDN shall entertain no claim, whatsoever, on this account.

<u>Validity and termination of the contract</u>: The contract shall be valid initially for a period ONE YEAR from the date of award which can be extended further on same terms and conditions based on site requirement. The contract may be terminated by BHEL-EDN by giving a notice of 30 (THIRTY) days' notice and no compensation shall be paid for remaining period of the contract period.

SECTION 2

The contractor will be required to provide as per following Scope and terms & conditions:

Scope

Providing and maintaining site office set up items/materials as required by BHEL for setting up site office at proposed P4 block of NTPC SPV plant ,NP Kunte near Kadiri Anantapur District of AP. The contractor will maintain these facilities till the contract period completion.

- Contractor has to do supply, erection and commissioning of the site office setup as per the annexure requirement of BHEL.
- 2. The containers should be fabricated from tested quality steel duly welded, comprising of base frame, peripheral structure, self-draining roof, entry door and windows. The

four corner Column will be sufficiently strengthened to facilitate transportation, lifting and placing

- 3. Base Frame The base frame would be made of pressed mild steel channel section. The main structural element will be $122 \times 62 \text{ SQ}$ pipe 3mm thick and cross members should be of 'C' channels section size 75 mm x 40 mm.
- 4. The side and end frame made out of pressed sections of suitable profiles / Pillars of sufficient strength. Exterior wall made up of 18 SWG MS specially corrugated sheet, whereas 6mm thick decorative plywood wall cladding sheet to be used for interior walls. These steel sheets will be treated for corrosion resistant. Panels will be vertically corrugated. Sheets will be continuously welded to top side and base structure so as to offer better strength to weight ratio. All gaps to be sealed at edges and at seam, bottom etc to prevent ingress of moisture.
- 5. **Insulation** 50 mm thick Glass wool Insulation would be used for walls and 50 mm thick insulation material to be provided for roof and side walls.
- 6. Inner Paneling The interior will be aesthetically finished so as to give custom built appearance with extremely high quality workmanship. All vertically and horizontal corners should be neatly and smoothly finished. The Paneling of side walls and roof will be of 6mm thick decorative plywood.
- 7. **Flooring Systems** On the bottom frame 18 mm thick composite cement sheet/plywood will be fixed by means of self tapping screw. 1.3 mm thick homogeneous type PVC Vinyl flooring should be fixed on the cement sheet/plywood.
- 8. **Roof** Self draining type roof will be made out of 18 gauge thick M.S. Sheet, adequate roof bows are to be provided. Roof will be adequately cambered for draining of rainwater. Interior paneling would be done in 6mm thick decorative laminated plywood with adequate insulation.
- 9. **Main Entry Door** The size of the door will be of 6.5' height x 3' width. The door will be of external opening type made out of the same material as wall panels with door closing unit. The construction of the door would be double skin steel construction with 50 mm thick Glass wool insulation. The peripheral edges of the door will be sealed with double gaskets to make it waterproof & leak proof. The door interior will be finished with same material matching with that of the bunk house interior. The door will be provided with locking arrangement with separate handles on both sides of the door as required.

10. Aluminum Windows

Aluminum windows 2.5ft x 4ft, sliding type will be provided with safety grill and curtain made of Aluminum section, 4 mm plain vision glasses. All windows/doors will have external shades.

11. **Electrical System** the Bunk House will be provided with electrical wiring suitable for 250 volt, 50 HZ single phase AC power supply. All electrical wiring would be concealed. Bulk head and tube lights and ceiling fan will be provided. Suitable copper cables will be used for lighting circuits. The copper cables used will be of 1.5 sq mm. cables for lighting circuits. ISI mark and concealed in PVC conduits insulated copper wire will be used for wiring to be done in PVC conduit with small size distribution board with MCB protection and to separate with main supply.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS - SILENT DG SET

A. DIESEL ENGINE:

New Kirloskar/CUMMINS/ or any other reputed brands with silent version, cabling to the load to be included. , 3 cylinders, inline, 4 stroke cycle, Water cooled Natural aspirated, developing rated power at 1500 RPM under NTP conditions of BS: 5514. The engine shall be provided with electrical starting arrangement & shall give the rated electrical output at 0.8 power factor, 415V at the alternator terminal.

B. ALTERNATOR:

Single bearing alternator suitable for operation generating on required KVA rating at 1500 RPM, 415Volts, 0.8 power factor (lag) suitable for 50 Hz, 3 phase, 4 wire system, confirming to BS 5000/ IS 4722. The alternator is brushless type, screen protected, revolving field, self-excited, self-regulated through an AVR. The alternator should have the following features:

- ± 1.0% voltage regulation (max.) in static conditions
- IP: 23 protections with insulation class H
- Permissible overload of 10% for one hour in 12 hours of operation.

C. CONTROL PANEL:

The Control Panel is manufactured with 14/16 gauge CRCA sheet and is powered coated for a weather-proof and long lasting finish. The Control Panel consists of the following parts:

- Instrument fuses duly wired and ferruled
- MCCB of suitable rating with overload and short circuit protections.

PVC Water storage tank and plumbing materials should of reputed company and good quality. Motor for pumping the water from a sump to be considered including construction of a sump of suitable capacity for long term storage.

Securities should be in uniform and with adequate facilities for night duty with torch, flash light etc. Suitable lighting arrangement for night lighting for the yard and near the site office area may be considered in the overall quote.
