8.The work should be completed within 50 days from the date of receipt of work order.

9. "The offers of the bidders who are under suspension as also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL web site www.bhel.com.

10. Bidders must go through Guidelines for suspension of business dealings/Reverse Auction. Guidelines for suspension of business dealings/Reverse auction with suppliers/contractors are available on website www.bhel.com on "supplier registration page".

11. MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (2 years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with attested copy of CA certificate (format enclosed as per Annexure I where deemed validity of EM II certificate of 2 years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the date of bid opening (Part I in case of 2 part bid). Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bids at par with other bidders. 14. In case of any damage to property due to lapse by the tenderer/employee of

the tenderer, BHEL shall have the right to recover the cost of such damages from the payments due to the tenderer

15. The Contractor shall during the performance of the contract take out a Third Party insurance cover against bodily injury or death suffered by any third party/parties or damage to property occurring during the course of execution of this contract in accordance with appropriate statutory requirements

16. Tenderer shall indemnify BHEL against claims and losses under various Labor Laws, statutes or any civil or criminal law in connection with employees deployed by him.

17. The liability for any compensation on account of injury sustained by an employee of the tenderer will be exclusively that of the tenderer.

18. CERTIFICATE OF INDEMNITY

In case of any dispute, the decision taken by BHEL Management will be final and binding on the successful tenderer.

19. The successful tenderer will be responsible for the quality of the job/ services and will immediately rectify the deficiency pointed out in the job performed

20. PERFORMANCE & PENALTY

a. **Penalty @ 5% per week** of the contract value pro rata will be levied, if there is **delay** beyond the schedule completion period, subject to a maximum of 20%.

b. The penalty will be imposed if the performance achieved by the tenderer is below expected standards. The decision of BHEL work in -charge on the question of penalty will be final and binding.

c. **Defect Liability:** Contractor shall be responsible to make good and remedy any defect in work noticed before expiry of one year from date of successful completion of work failing which the security deposit shall be forfeited

21. Sub contract not allowed

22. BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract by giving 2 days notice in writing in case the services are not found satisfactory and forfeit the security deposit.

23. The party shall indemnify BHEL for all the losses / damages

occurred during the operation of the contract.

24. **Offer Validity:** 30 days from date of Tender opening.

25. **Evaluation Criteria :**

1. Party who is over all L1 will be awarded the contract (Total of A + B)
2. BHEL reserves right to negotiate with the L1 party

26. **Security Deposit:**

Successful bidder has to deposit security deposit at the rate of 5% of the contract value, before start of the work. Security deposit may be furnished in any of the following forms:

- IV. "CONTRACTOR" or "MTO" shall mean the individual, Partnership firms or Private / Public Limited Co. or any legal entity who enters into Contract with BHEL and shall include their executors, administrators, successors and assigns. "CONTRACTOR" shall also mean "CONTRACTOR", "CONTRACTOR" "CARRIER" "TRANSPORTER" or "MTO" where the context so requires.
- V. 3.1 Except as provided elsewhere in this Contract, in case amicable settlement is not reached between the Parties, in respect of any dispute or difference; arising out of the formation, breach, termination, validity or execution of the contract; or, the respective rights and liabilities of the Parties; or, in relation to interpretation of any provision of the contract; or, in any manner touching upon the contract, then, either Party may, by a notice in writing to the other party refer such dispute or difference to the sole arbitration of an arbitrator appointed by Head of the BHEL Unit/Region/ Division issuing the contract.

3.2 The arbitrator shall pass a reasoned award and the award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the Parties.

3.3 Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitrations and Conciliation Act 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made there under and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause. The seat of arbitration shall be Delhi.

3.4 The cost of arbitration shall be borne as per the award of the Arbitrator.

3.5 Subject to the arbitration in terms of Clause 16 above, the Courts at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any matter arising out of or in connection with this contract.

3.6 Notwithstanding the existence or any dispute or differences and/or reference for the arbitration, the contractor shall proceed and continue without hindrance the performance of its obligations under this contract with due diligence and expedition in a professional manner except where the contract has been terminated by either Party in terms of this contract.

In case of contract with Public Sector Enterprise (PSE) or a Government Department : In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred by either party for arbitration to the sole arbitrator in the Department of Public Enterprises to be nominated by the secretary of the Government of India in-charge of the department of Public Enterprises. The arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 shall not be applicable to arbitration under this clause. The award of the arbitrator shall be binding upon the parties to the dispute, provided, however, any party aggrieved by such award may make further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law Secretary, Department of Legal affairs, Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the special secretary or Additional Secretary when so authorized by the Law Secretary, whose decision shall bind the Parties hereto finally and conclusively. The Parties to the dispute will share equally the cost of arbitration as intimated by the Arbitrator

4) Statutory Levies:

The contractor will pay all statutory liabilities of the workers and employees engaged by him and ensure that they are paid minimum wages as notified by the State Government from time to time and all other statutory laws shall be complied by the contractor.

5) Workmen Compensation:

It is the sole responsibility of the contractor to insure his staff engaged in the BHEL Flats under Workmen Compensation Insurance Act against any unfortunate incidences/accidents while on duty.

6) Risk Purchase / Penalty:

BHEL reserves to itself the following rights in respect of this Contract without entitling the Contractor for any compensation.

- I. If at any time during the validity of the contract, the contractor fails to render all or any of the services required under the scope of work of the contract satisfactorily in the opinion of BHEL, whose decision shall be final and binding on the contractor, BHEL reserves the right to get the work done by other parties or departmentally at the risk and cost of the contractor and also forfeit the security deposit
- II. To recover any moneys due from the Contractor, from any money due to the Contractor under this or any other contract or from the Security Deposit.
- III. To claim compensation for losses sustained including BHEL's supervision charges & overheads in case of termination of Contract.

7) Cancellation of Contract:

BHEL shall have the right to cancel the contract for unsatisfactory performance i.e. repeated failure for arranging trailers/vessels and delivery of the cargo within transit time. BHEL shall have the right to forfeit the security for poor performance of CONTRACTOR leading to cancellation of contract.

If the CONTRACTOR fails or neglects or refuses to observe / perform any of the terms and conditions / obligation of or under the contract BHEL may without prejudice to any other rights terminate the contract by giving one month's notice in writing and recover from the Contractor any damage suffered by on account of the failure, negligence, refusal, violation or breach of contract or any part thereof including the amount by which the cost of completion of the work done by any other agency shall exceed the amount payable to the CONTRACTOR under the contract.

BHEL reserves the right to either short close the contract or terminate the contract at its discretion without assigning any reason by giving one month's notice by registered post acknowledgement due or in person under delivery.

8) Timing for the Work: We shall prefer to get the job during office hours from 9.00 to 17.30 on all working days.

9) Assistance in shifting the furniture and the other items, cleaning windows / glass panels, and re-arrangements shall be provided by _____ the

Contractor. The Debris should be removed and complete cleaning shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.

10) TDS/WCT as applicable will be deducted at source from your bill.

11) The offers of the bidders who are under suspension as also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL web site **www.bhel.com**.

12) Bidders must go through Guidelines for suspension of business dealings/Reverse Auction. Guidelines for suspension of business dealings/Reverse auction with suppliers/contractors are available on website **www.bhel.com** on “**supplier registration page**”.

13) Observance of Local Laws:

- I. The Contractor shall comply with all Laws, Statutory Rules, Regulations etc. The Contractor shall obtain all necessary permits/approval from the local Governing Body, Police and other concerned Authorities as may be required under law.
- II. The Contractor shall pay all taxes, fees, license charges, deposits, duties, tolls, royalty, commissions or other charges that may be Leviable on account of any of the operations connected with the execution of this contract.
- III. The Contractor shall be responsible for the proper behavior and observance of all regulations by the staff employed.

14) Insurance:

- I. The Contractor shall during the performance of the contract take a suitable insurance to cover against bodily injury, death or damage to property of the Contractor or his employees.
- II. The Contractor shall during the performance of the contract take out a Third Party insurance cover against bodily injury or death suffered by any third party/parties or damage to property occurring during the course of execution of this contract in accordance with appropriate statutory requirements.
- III. If due to Contractor's carelessness, negligence, non-observance of safety precautions, improper security arrangements or due to non-

compliance of paper work needed for lodging insurance claim, damage to BHEL/its Customer's property, and if BHEL is unable to recover its claim from the Insurance Company, the deficit will be recovered from the Contractor.

15) Laws Governing the Contract:

- I. The contract shall be governed by the Indian Laws for the time being in force and only courts in Mumbai, India shall have jurisdiction over this contract.

16) Indemnity:

- I. The Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified BHEL all losses, claims etc. arising out of any of his acts or out of the acts of his Contractors or associates or servants during the currency of the contract.

17) Requirements of Performance:

- I. All permissions/Clearances or any other relevant authorization from competent authority shall be obtained by the Contractor at his own cost. Any contingency arising in this respect shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. Also the Contractor shall be responsible for any mishap and consequences therefore including legal complications, if any.
- II. The contract as entered into between BHEL and the Contractor shall in no way, nullify, reduce, mitigate or absolve the parties of any responsibility, obligation or liability that may devolve upon them under the acts or laws governing such activity.

18) Earnest Money Deposit:

The offers from the bidders shall enclose a EMD as per Techno commercial Bid in any one of the following forms:

- III. EMD shall not carry any interest.

19) Invoices & Payment Terms:

- I. The Contractor will be required to raise the Invoice for the services rendered. The Invoices will have to be raised according to the explicitly agreed rates and payment terms of the contract.
- II. **In consideration of such services mentioned above rendered by the contractor, BHEL will pay charges to the contractor 15 days of submission of clear bills. TDS/WCT as applicable will be deducted at source from the payment .**
- IV. The payments shall be made through RTGS/NEFT. The contractor would be required to submit bank details for receiving the payments.
- V.

- III. Even if the **prices offered are excluding GST**, the contractor will have to produce invoices showing the GST elements separately.
- IV. In case the, TDS is not to be made, the contractor will have to produce the exemption letter from the relevant authorities to this effect along with bill submitted for payment.

20) Discrepancy In Words & Figures: Quoted In Offer

- I. If, in the price structure quoted for the required goods/ services/ works, there is discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (which is obtained by multiplying the unit price by the quantity), the unit price shall prevail and the total price corrected accordingly, unless in the opinion of the purchaser there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price corrected accordingly.
- II. If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- III. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail .
- IV. If there is such discrepancy in an offer, the same shall be conveyed to the bidder with target date up to which the bidder has to send his acceptance on the above lines and if the bidder does not agree to the decision of the purchaser, the bid is liable to be ignored

21) Reverse Auction:

2.1 BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders have to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

21.2 Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the *tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ Bidders (as available on www.bhel.com)*.

21.3 The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. **The envelope Sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.**

21.4 If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ Bidders (as available on www.bhel.com).

22) Prevention of Corruption:

- I. Canvassing in any form or any attempt to influence directly or indirectly any official of the company will lead to rejection of the bid & forfeiture of the EMD.
- II. The company shall be entitled to cancel the contract and to recover From the Contractor the amount of any loss resulting from such cancellation, if the Contractor has offered or given any person any gift or consideration of any kind as an inducement or reward for doing or intending to do any action in relation to the obtaining or the execution of the contract or any other contract with the company or for showing or indenting to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the contract with the company, if the like acts shall have been done by any persons employed by him or acting on his behalf whether with or without the knowledge of the Contractor in relation to this or any other contract with the company.

23) Laws Governing the Contract:

The Order/Contract shall be executed and governed by the laws of India and the courts of India alone shall have jurisdiction in respect of any matter arising under or in connection with the Order/Contract.

24) Jurisdiction of Court:

Courts at Mumbai shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide the dispute, if any, arising out of or in respect of the contract(s) to which these conditions are applicable.

25) Default/Breach of Contract, Insolvency and Risk Purchase:

- I. If the Service Provider / Contractor fails to provide the required services as per the Contract / fails to deliver the goods or materials or any instalment thereof within the period(s) fixed for such delivery or delivers goods or materials not of the contracted quality and failing to adhere to the contract specifications or at any time repudiates or otherwise abandons the contract before expiry of such period or refuses or is unable to supply / provide goods / services or materials covered by the Order/Contract either in whole or in part or otherwise fails to perform the Order/Contract or commits any breach of the Order/Contract not herein specifically provided for or in the event of the death or insanity or if the Seller/Contractor being an individual or if a firm on a partnership thereof, shall at any time, be adjudged insolvent or shall have a receiving order for administration of his estate made against him or shall take any proceeding for composition under any Insolvency Act for the time being in force or make any assignment of the Order/Contract or enter into any arrangement or composition with his creditors or suspend payment or if the firm dissolved under the Partnership Act or if the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) being a company is wound up voluntarily or by order of a Court or a Receiver, Liquidator or Manager on behalf of the debenture holders and creditors is appointed or circumstances shall have arisen which entitles the Court of debenture holder and creditors to appoint a receiver, liquidator or manager, the purchaser without prejudice to his right to recover any expenses, losses or damages to which the purchaser may be put to incur or sustain by reason of the Seller/Contractor's default or breach of Order/Contract shall be entitled to cancel the Order/Contract either in whole or portion thereof without compensation to the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) and if the purchaser so desires, he may procure upon such terms and in such manner as he deems appropriate, stores not so delivered or others of a similar description where stores exactly complying with particulars are not, in the opinion of the purchaser, which shall be final, readily procurable, at the risk and cost of the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) and the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs provided that the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) shall continue the performance of the Order/Contract to the extent not cancelled under the provisions of this clause. The Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) shall on no account be entitled to any gain on such repurchases.
- II. Cost of the purchases/service made by the Purchaser/Service taker at the risk and cost of the seller/contractor (Service Provider) shall be worked out after levying 30% overheads as departmental charges on the cost of materials / services so purchased/hired.

26) Integrity commitment, performance of the contract and punitive action thereof:

I. Commitment by BHEL:

BHEL commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption in connection with the tender process and execution of the contract. BHEL will during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) in a transparent and fair manner, and with equity.

II. Commitment by Bidder/ Supplier/ Contractor:

- i. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor commit to take all measures to prevent corruption and will not directly or indirectly influence any decision or benefit which he is not legally entitled to nor will act or omit in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India.
- ii. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract and shall adhere to relevant guidelines issued from time to time by Govt. of India/ BHEL.
- iii. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasonable cause, which causes loss of business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL.

27) If any bidder/ supplier/ contractor during pre-tendering /tendering/ post tendering/ award/ execution/ post-execution stage indulges in mal-practices, cheating, bribery, fraud or andother misconduct or formation of cartel so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price or acts or omits in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India, then, action may be taken against such bidder/supplier/ contractor as per extant guidelines of the company available onwww. bhel.com and/or under applicable legal provisions”.

28) Safety of men, Equipment, Material & Environment:

All safety rules, codes applied by BHEL/its customer at site shall be observed by the Contractor and his workmen without exception. The Contractor shall be responsible for the safety of the equipment/materials and work to be performed by him.
