BHEL intends to enter into Rate Contract for hiring and maintenance for live potted plants on monthly rental basis for a period of 2 years in BHEL House Siri fort, New Delhi.

## 1) PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT (PQR)

- 1.1 The average annual financial turnover during the last 3 years of the bidder should be at least ₹ 0.62 lakhs (excluding GST). [Documentary evidence required in this regard is ITR for FY 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 along with audited Balance sheet and Profit & Loss account. In case, audited Balance sheet and Profit & Loss account is not available; a certificate from CA mentioning your turnover for above financial years is to be submitted.] (The condition of Prior Turnover is relaxed for all Startups whether Micro & Small Enterprises(MSEs) or otherwise subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications in accordance with the relevant provision of GFR 2017 or latest version and other DOE-PPD notifications for relaxation norms for Startups issued from time to time.)
- 1.2 The bidder should have experience of providing service for hiring and maintenance of live potted plants in the past during last 7 years ending on 31 May 2020. A copy of documentary evidence (Work Orders/Award Letters) in this regard for similar nature of work executed along with the completion certificate(s) has to be submitted as follows;
  - A) Three separate work orders of average annual value not less than ₹ 0.83 Lakhs excl. GST).

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B) Two separate work orders of average annual value not less than ₹ 1.04 Lakhs (excl. GST).

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C) Single work order of average annual value not less than ₹ 1.66 Lakhs (excl. GST).

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The term 'similar jobs/services' mentioned in Clause 1.2 (A, B & C) shall be related/refer to 'jobs/services' of live potted plants in Hotels/Guest houses/Transit flats etc. with any Central Govt. or State Govt. or PSU or Public Limited Company or Private Limited company.

[Documentary evidence in this regard is Copy of work orders and performance report/completion certificate/tax invoice copies or delivery challans/other relevant documents of successful execution of the order is required.]

- 1.3 Self-attested copy of PAN-Card.
- 1.4 GST registration certificate duly signed and stamped along with Part-1 bid.
- **1.5** Bidders must submit a copy of tender document duly stamped and signed on each page of tender document and mentioning 'Q' against the item of BOQ items in Annexure-A.
- 1.6 EMD amount of Rs. 9787/- as per clause 2.21 of the tender document.
  - a) Relaxation of Norms for Startups: The start-ups are exempted from paying of EMD on submission of documentary evidence per clause 14.
  - b) MSEs shall be exempted from payments of earnest money, provided certificate of MSE is enclosed by the MSE party along with the Part-I bid. However, there is no exemption of security deposit submission. The details regarding MSEs and other benefits are as per tender clause 15.

#### 2. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF TENDER:

- **2.1** The tender enquiry No. & due date must be legibly super scribed on the envelope.
- **2.2** Tenders shall be received and opened at BHEL House, Siri Fort, New Delhi on the due date and time as mentioned above in the presence of finance representative and bidders or their authorized representatives who may like to be present.
- **2.3** Tenders shall be strictly in accordance with the tender specifications. Any deviation may lead to rejection of tender.
- **2.4** The offers shall remain valid for 90 days' period from the date of opening of Part-I Bid & 60 days from the date of RA/Price Bid opening, whichever is later.
- **2.5** BHEL shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other tender and shall be entitled to accept or reject any tender in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- **2.6** BHEL reserves the right to accept/reject any offer.

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- **2.7** All tools and tackles required for work shall have to be provided by the bidder at no extra cost.
- **2.8** Any damage due to mishandling by person deputed by the bidder shall have to be restored back to its original condition by the bidder at their own cost.
- **2.9** Tenders received after due date & time are liable to be rejected.
- **2.10** Tender should be submitted along with covering letter of the bidder and each page of the tender document must be stamped and duly signed by bidder.
- **2.11** Price quoted by the bidder will be firm and no escalation on account of labour, material or any other reason whatsoever will be paid to the successful bidder for execution of the above work. However, any change in taxes during the currency of contract will automatically be from the part of contract.
- **2.12** Total no. of plants indicated in Annexure-I are approximate and it may vary as per requirement of BHEL from time to time. BHEL reserves the right to increase/decrease the quantity of plants by 30% of original quantity at the same rate and terms and conditions of this contract.
- **2.13** Tender submitted by a techno commercially qualified bidder shall become the property of BHEL who shall be under no obligation to return the same to the bidder. However unopened price bids and late tenders shall be returned to the bidders.
- **2.14** BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by the bidder in the preparation of the tender irrespective of whether the tender is accepted or not.
- 2.15 Bid should be free from correction, overwriting, using corrective fluid etc. Any interlineation, cutting, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are attested under full signature(s) of person(s) signing the bid shall be liable for rejection. All overwriting/ cutting etc. will be numbered by bid opening officials and announced during bid opening.
- 2.16 In case any typing error/other clerical error in the tender document is noticed by the bidder, the same shall be pointed out & got clarified before submission of offer, or else BHEL's interpretation shall prevail & shall be binding on the bidder(s).
- 2.17 Lowest prices/service charge received against Tender need not be the acceptable to BHEL and in that case BHEL would not consider the same for award of Contract. BHEL would negotiate or re-float the Tender opened if L1 price is not the lowest acceptable price to them inter-alia other reasons. In the event of the final L1 prices are not reasonable / acceptable to BHEL, BHEL also may resort to short closure of this Tender.
- 2.18 Post techno-commercial evaluation of the bidders, BHEL may either opt for holding Reverse Auction or open the submitted Price Bids (Part-II Bids). For this, BHEL decision shall be final & binding

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- **2.19** The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list and also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL website <a href="https://www.bhel.com">www.bhel.com</a>.
  - **2.20 CORRECTION OF ARITHMETIC ERRORS**: Provided that the bid is substantially responsive, BHEL shall correct arithmetical errors on the following basis:
  - 2.20.1 If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the BHEL there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected.
  - **2.20.2** If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected.
  - **2.20.3** If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to 2.19 above.
  - 2.20.4 If any bidder does not accept the correction of errors, their bids will be disqualified.
  - **2.21 EMD**: Each bidder, participating in the tender has to deposit the requisite amount of **EMD** in any of the following forms:
    - i) Cash deposit as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act (before tender opening);
    - ii) Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before tender opening);

- iii) Banker's cheque /Pay order/Demand draft, in favour of BHEL (along with offer), payable at New Delhi.
- iv) Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) ISSUED BY Scheduled banks /Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the contractor, a/c BHEL)
- **2.21.1** EMD by bidder will be forfeited, if:
- i) After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.
- ii) The contractor fails to deposit the required security deposit or commence the work within the period as per LOI / Contract.

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- iii) EMD by the tenderer shall be withheld in case any action on the tenderer is envisaged under the provisions of extant "guidelines on suspension of business dealing with suppliers/Contactors" and forfeited/released based on the action as determined under these guidelines.
- **2.21.2** EMD given by all unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded normally within fifteen days from award of work.
- 2.21.3 EMD shall not carry any interest.
- **2.21.4** Each tender shall be accompanied by separate envelope carrying EMD as mentioned above failing which the tender will be rejected.
- 2.21.5 The bidder along with its associate /collaborators /sub-contractors/sub- vendors /consultants /service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL fraud prevention policy displayed on BHEL web site: http//bhel.com and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice.
- **2.21.6** EMD of successful tenderer can be converted into security deposit if desired.
- 2.22 Payment Terms (Clause 3) and Taxes and Duties (Clause 7) of the tender is indicative. The prevalent actual conditions of the said clauses shall be incorporated in the Award of Work by BHEL.

#### **3. PAYMENT TERMS:**

- **3.1** Bill complete in all respect along with the requisite documents will be paid within 20 days of receipt through NEFT upon fulfilment of applicable GST rules.
- **3.2** Payment shall be made to contractor only after submission of GST complaint Tax invoice as mentioned above and other relevant documents. However, to protect BHEL's interest for GST input tax credit, the Contractor may submit Bank Guarantee of equivalent amount i.e. GST amount along with notional interest on GST credit for 2 months' period (presently rate of interest is @ 24% per annum i.e. 4% for 02 months) else GST amount plus 04% notional interest will be withheld from the bill.
- **3.3** The Contractor will have to intimate the bank account number, and other details of the bank to enable BHEL to credit the payments into the account.
- **3.4** The monthly bill will be prepared and payment will be made as per actual number of plants displayed in office on prorate basis and it will be released on submission of GST compliant invoice through NEFT within 20 days approximately.
- **3.5** No interest shall be payable for delay in making the payment. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any interest with respect to any money which may be due to him from BHEL.

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#### 4. EVALUATION CRITERIA:

Evaluation of the tender will be done on overall cost to company but excluding GST. The L1 bidder will be decided on the basis of overall L1 excluding GST (Sl. No. 3) of the price bid of Annexure-B.

In the course of evaluation, if more than one bidder happens to occupy L1 status, effective L1 will be decided by soliciting discount from the respective L1 bidders.

In case more than one bidder happens to occupy the L1 status even after soliciting discounts, the L1 bidder shall be decided by toss/draw of lots, in the presence of respective I1 bidder(s) or their representative(s)

Ranking will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situation shall be final and binding.

BHEL may finalize the contract by conducting **Reverse Auction** (RA), that shall be conducted with minimum three for Techno-Commercially qualified/acceptable bidders post evaluation of Part-1 bids submitted before/on due date / time of submission. Start price shall be lower of estimate or L1 of e-bid/sealed envelope price bid. Removal of H1 only if, there are more than four Techno-Commercially qualified bidders. No H1 removal if H1 happens to be MSE or qualifying PPP-MII, order-2017. In case of multiple H1s, all H1 bidders (excluding MSEs and bidders qualifying PPP-MII order 2017) shall be removed. If minimum three bidders remain in fray, there shall be no H1 removal.

### 5. SCOPE OF WORK:

- 5.1 The Bidder will arrange fresh and healthy plants of different varieties such as: -
- (a) Indoor Plants: Araucaria, Erica Palm, Drawsenia, Jarvera Money Plants, Defenbachia, Lily, Coroton, Son of India etc.
- (b) Outdoor Plants: Euphorbia, Servalis Palm, Fichus Benjamin, Chandni, Cycas Palm, Jamia Palm, Alpenia, Alstonia, China Orange, Pine etc.

Note: The plants shall be of best quality and to the entire satisfaction of BHEL.

- 5.2 Indoor plants shall be arranged in earthen pots of size 10" & 12" dia and Outdoor plants in 10", 12", 14" & 16" dia earthen / cemented pots as per requirement. The pots shall be clean, painted and decorative which shall be rested on proper base to avoid spilling of water on the surface.
- 5.3 The contractor will deploy an expert man for maintenance activities such as watering, cleaning of foliage, inspection for pests & disease, removal of spent leaves, regular cleaning and painting of pots in order to maintain high standard of maintenance activities. The terms and conditions of services of such manpower and payment of salary and other statutory obligation shall be the sole responsibility of the supplier and BHEL will not have any liability whatsoever on this account.

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- 5.4 To the extent of 15% of the total number of plants shall be replaced every months or even earlier if they lose freshness. The failure on the part of the contractors in meeting this requirement shall attract penalty as for relevant penalty terms of the contract.
- 5.5 Any damage to plants will be on supplier's account.
- 5.6 The total quantity of plants mentioned in BOQ are approximate and it may vary as per requirement of BHEL from time to time and contractor will have to meet the BHEL's requirement at the same rate quoted by vendor.
- 5.7 The monthly bill will be prepared as per actual number of plants displayed and payment will be made on prorate basis.
- 5.8 The above plants shall be provided in appropriate proportion to suit the requirement of BHEL.
- 5.9 The contractor is advised to physically visit our office at least twice in every month and personally see the condition of plants and ensure timely replacement of plants

#### 6. VALDITY OF CONTRACT:

This contract will be valid initially for two years from the date of award of work however BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time in-between without assigning any reason, for which the supplier will not have any claim whatsoever. The rate contract may be further extended on mutual agreement basis.

#### 7. TAXES & DUTIES:

- 7.1 To enable BHEL to avail GST Input tax credit, contractor shall submit GST compliant Tax invoice containing all the particulars as stipulated under Invoice Rules of GST Law. Payment shall be made to the contractor only after submission of GST complaint Tax invoice. The successful bidder shall raise GST compliant invoice affixing GSTIN of BHEL's unit availing the services.
- **7.2** BHEL reserves the right to protect its interest against any loss on account of availability of GST credit.
- 7.3 GSTIN of BHEL will be provided to the contractor along with the work order.
- 7.4 The Contractor shall ensure strict compliance under GST Act & Rules incl. any amendments thereof, so that Input Tax Credit is available to BHEL. In case of any loss to BHEL on account of the contractor's non-compliance, incl. all penalty(s) levied by the govt. authorities, the same shall be recovered from the contractor

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- **7.5** Any new/change in statutory levy as and when made applicable by the Government shall become applicable against documentary evidence.
- 7.6 Payment to the contractor will be subjected to TDS as per rules in force from time to time. The Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) shall be done as per the provisions of Income Tax Act & GST, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the contractor by BHEL.
- **7.7** Applicable GST shall also be recoverable from the contractor in case of LD recovery/penalty on account of breach of terms of contract.

#### 8. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

- **8.1** Security Deposit means the security provided by the Contractor towards fulfilment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract. The total amount of Security Deposit will be **5%** of the total contract value. Upon acceptance of tender, the successful bidder must submit the security deposit in any of the following forms:
  - i. Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)
  - ii. Local cheque of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL
  - iii. Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. {Copy of proper prescribed format of BG will be provided by BHEL along with Work Order/LOI and it will be verified verbatim on receipt with original document}.
  - iv. Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Contractor, a/c BHEL)
  - v. Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates,
  - vi. Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL)
    - (**Note:** BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith). Security deposit shall be released after three (03) months from the release of final bill.
- **8.2** The security deposit shall not carry any interest.
- **8.3** EMD of successful bidder shall be converted into security deposit.
- 8.4 The validity of Bank Guarantees towards Security Deposit shall be initially up to the completion period as stipulated in the Letter of Intent/ Award + 6 months, and the same

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shall be kept valid by proper renewal till the acceptance of Final Bills of the Contractor, by BHEL.

**8.5** BHEL reserves the right of forfeiture of Security Deposit in addition to other claims and penalties in the event of the Contractor's failure to fulfill any of the contractual obligations or in the event of termination of contract as per terms and conditions of contract. BHEL reserves the right to set off the Security Deposit against any claims of other contracts with BHEL.

### 9. RETURN OF SECURITY DEPOSIT:

Security Deposit shall be refunded/ Bank Guarantee(s) released to the Contractor upon fulfiment of all contractual/ statuary obligations or after expiry of the guarantee period the contract, after deducting all expenses / other amounts due to BHEL under the contract / other contracts entered into with them by BHEL.

#### **10. BANK GUARANTEES:**

Wherever Bank Guarantees are to be furnished/submitted by the contractor, the following shall be complied with:

- **10.1** Bank Guarantees shall be from Scheduled Banks / Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act.
- 10.2 The Bank Guarantees shall be as per prescribed formats.
- 10.3 It is the responsibility of the bidder to get the Bank Guarantees revalidated /extended for the required period, as per the advice of BHEL. BHEL shall not be liable for issue of any reminders regarding expiry of the Bank Guarantees.
- 10.4 In case the Bank Guarantees are not extended before the expiry date, BHEL reserves the right to invoke the same by informing the concerned Bank in writing, without any advance notice/communication to the concerned bidder.
- Bidders to note that any corrections to Bank Guarantees shall be done by the issuing Bank, only through an amendment in an appropriate non-judicial stamp paper.
- The Original Bank Guarantee shall be sent directly by the Bank to BHEL under Registered Post (Acknowledgement Due), addressed to the LOI/LOA issuing department.

#### 11 REJECTION OF TENDER:-

- 11.1 BHEL reserve the right to cancel the tender or reject the lowest or any tender or accept any tender in full or in part without assigning any reasons whatsoever at any stage.
- 11.2 BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any of the bid / all bids with or without deviation or cancel / withdraw the invitation for bid without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case bidder shall have no claim arising out of such action by



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BHEL. The acceptance of tender will rest with BHEL which does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender.

- 11.3 Conditional tenders, unsolicited tenders, tenders which are incomplete or not in the form specified or defective or have been materially altered or not in accordance with the tender conditions, specifications etc., are liable to be rejected.
  - 11.4 Tenders are liable to be rejected in case of unsatisfactory performance of the tenderer with BHEL, or tenderer under suspension (hold/banning /delisted) by any Unit / Region / Division of BHEL or tenderers who do not comply with the latest guidelines of Ministry/Commissions of Govt. of India.
  - If a bidder who is a proprietor expires after the submission of his tender or after the acceptance of his tender, BHEL may at their discretion, cancel such tender. If a partner of a firm expires after the submission of tender or after the acceptance of the tender, BHEL may then cancel such tender at their discretion, unless the firm retains its character.
  - 11.6 BHEL will not be bound by any Power of Attorney granted by changes in the composition of the firm made subsequent to the execution of the contract. They may, however, recognise such power of Attorney and changes after obtaining proper legal advice, the cost of which will be chargeable to the contractor concerned.
- 11.7 If the tenderer deliberately gives wrong information in his tender, BHEL reserves the right to reject such tender at any stage or to cancel the contract if awarded and forfeit the Earnest Money/Security Deposit/any other money due.
- 11.8 Canvassing in any form in connection with the tenders submitted by the Tenderer shall make his offer liable to rejection.
- In case the Proprietor, Partner or Director of the Company/Firm submitting the Tender, has any relative or relation employed in BHEL, the authority inviting the Tender shall be informed of the fact as per specified format, along with the Offer. Failing to do so, BHEL may, at its sole discretion, reject the tender or cancel the contract and forfeit the Earnest Money/Security Deposit.
- 11.10 "The offers of the bidders who are under suspension as also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL website <a href="https://www.bhel.com">www.bhel.com</a>.

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12 Integrity commitment, performance of the contract and punitive action thereof:

<u>COMMITMENT BY BHEL</u>: BHEL commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption in connection with the tender process and execution of the contract. BHEL will during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) in a transparent and fair manner, and with equity.

COMMITMENT BY BIDDER/ SUPPLIER/ CONTRACTOR: The bidder/ supplier/ contractor commit to take all measures to prevent corruption and will not directly or indirectly influence any decision or benefit which he is not legally entitled to nor will act or omit in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract and shall adhere to relevant guidelines issued from time to time by Govt. of India/ BHEL. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasonable cause, which causes loss of business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL.

If any bidder/ supplier/ contractor during pre-tendering/ tendering/ post tendering/ award/ execution/ post-execution stage indulges in mal-practices, cheating, bribery, fraud or and other misconduct or formation of cartel so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price or acts or omits in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India, then, action may be taken against such bidder/ supplier/ contractor as per extant guidelines of the company available on http://www.bhel.com and/or under applicable legal provisions".

- 13 The Bidder along with its associate/ collaborators/ sub-contractors/ sub-vendors/ consultants/ service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL Fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website <a href="http://www.bhel.com">http://www.bhel.com</a> and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice.
- 14 <u>RELAXATION OF NORMS FOR STARTUPS</u>: The conditions of prior experience (as per clause no1.2 above) is relaxed for all Startups whether Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) or otherwise
  subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications in accordance with the relevant
  provision of GFR 2017 or latest version and other DOE-PPD notifications for relaxation norms
  for Startups issued from time to time. The startups are also exempted from paying of EMD (a
  PQR criteria as per clause no-1.6 above).

- 15.1) MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of either Udyog Aadhaar or EM-II certificate having deemed validity (five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM-II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM-II certificate along with attested copy of a CA certificate (format enclosed as Annexure- H) where deemed validity of EM-II certificate of five years has expired (applicable for the last audited financial year).   - 16.3 Non-completion of work/ Non-supply by the Contractor/ supplier within scheduled completion/delivery period as per Contract or as extended from time to time, for the reasons attributable to the contractor/ supplier.
  - 16.4 Termination of Contract on account of any other reason (s) attributable to Contractor/Supplier.
  - Assignment, transfer, subletting of Contract without BHEL's written permission resulting in termination of Contract or part thereof by BHEL.
  - 16.6 Non-compliance to any contractual condition or any other default attributable to Contractor/ Supplier.

#In-case inputs from BHEL are likely to be delayed or are actually delayed, this delay may also be taken into account while considering balance period available for execution of Contract.

- 17 The Tender submitted by a techno commercially qualified bidder shall become the property of BHEL who shall be under no obligation to return the same to the bidder. However unopened price bids and late tenders shall be returned to the bidder.
- 18 Unsolicited discount received after the due date and time of Bid Submission shall not be considered for evaluation. However, if the party who has submitted the unsolicited discount/rebate becomes the L-1 party, then the awarded price i.e. contract value shall be worked out after considering the discount so offered.



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- 19 BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by the bidder in the preparation of the tender irrespective of whether the tender is accepted or not.
- 20 The tender schedule and the tender shall be deemed to form an integral part of the contract to be entered into for this work.
- 21 **SUBLETING:** The successful bidder should not sub-contract part or complete work detailed in the tender specification undertaken by him without written permission of BHEL. The bidder is solely responsible to BHEL for the work awarded to him.
- 22 <u>TERMINATION OF CONTRACT ON DEATH</u>: Without prejudice to any of the rights or remedies under this contract, if the contractor dies, the accepting officer shall have the option of terminating the contract without compensation to the contractor's authorized survivors.
- 23 <u>RECOVERY FROM CONTRACTOR</u>: Whenever under the contract, any sum of money shall be recoverable from or payable by the contractor, the same may be deducted from any sum then due or which at any time thereafter may become due to the contractor under the contract or under any other contract with BHEL or from his security deposit, or the contractor shall pay the claim on demand without any terms & conditions.
- 24 Lowest prices/service charge received against Tender need not be the acceptable to BHEL and in that case BHEL would not consider the same for award of Contract. BHEL would negotiate or refloat the Tender opened if L1 price is not the lowest acceptable price to them inter-alia other reasons. In the event of the final L1 prices are not reasonable / acceptable to BHEL, BHEL also may resort to short closure of this Tender.
- JURISDICTION: Notwithstanding any other court or courts having jurisdiction to decide the question(s) forming the subject matter of the reference if the same had been the subject matter of a suit, any and all actions and proceedings arising out of or relative to the contract shall lie only in the court of competent civil jurisdiction in this behalf at DELHI (where this Contract has been signed on behalf of the CONTRACTOR) and only the said Court(s) shall have jurisdiction to entertain and try any such action(s) and/or proceeding(s) to the exclusion of all other Courts.

#### **26 ARBITRATION:**

26.1 Except as provided elsewhere in this contract, in case amicable settlement is not reached between the parties, in respect of any dispute or difference; arising out of the formation, breach termination, validity of execution of the Contract; or, the respective rights and liabilities of the parties; or, in relation to interpretation of any provision of the Contract; or in any manner touching upon the contract, then, either party may, by a notice in writing to the other party refer such dispute or difference to the sole arbitration of an arbitrator appointed by Head of the BHEL Unit/Region/Division issuing the Contract.

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The Arbitrator shall pass a reasoned award and the award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the Parties.

Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The seat of arbitration shall be at New Delhi.

The cost of arbitration shall be borne as per the award of the Arbitrator.

Subject to the arbitration in terms of Clause 1 above, the Courts at New Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any matter arising out of or in connection with this contract.

Notwithstanding the existence or any dispute or differences and /or reference for the arbitration, the Contractor shall proceed with and continue without hindrance the performance of its obligations under this contract with due diligence and expedition in a professional manner except where the Contract has been terminated by either party in terms of this Contract.

26.2 In case of order/contract on Public Sector Enterprises (PSE) or a Govt. Deptt., the following clause shall be applicable: -

In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the Contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred to by either party for arbitration to the sole arbitrator in the department of public enterprises to be nominated by the secretary to the Government of India in-charge of the Department of Public Enterprises. Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 shall not be applicable to arbitration under this clause. The award of the arbitrator shall be binding upon the parties to the dispute, provided, however, any party aggrieved by such award may make a further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law secretary, Deptt. Of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary or Additional Secretary when so authorized by the Law Secretary, whose decision shall bind the parties hereto finally and conclusively. The parties in the dispute will bear equally the cost of arbitration as intimated by the arbitrator.

### 27. DEFAULT/BREACH OF CONTRACT, INSOLVENCY AND RISK PURCHASE

27.1 If the Service Provider / Contractor fails to provide the required services as per the Contract / fails to deliver the goods or materials or any instalment thereof within the period(s) fixed for such delivery or delivers goods or materials not of the contracted quality and failing to adhere to the contract specifications or at any time repudiates or otherwise abandons the contract before expiry of such period or refuses or is unable to supply / provide goods / services or materials covered by the Order/Contract either in whole or in part or otherwise fails to perform the Order/Contract or commits any breach of the Order/Contract not herein specifically provided for or in the event of the death or



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insanity or if the Seller/Contractor being an individual or if a firm on a partnership thereof, shall at any time, be adjudged insolvent or shall have a receiving order for administration of his estate made against him or shall take any proceeding for composition under any Insolvency Act for the time being in force or make any assignment of the Order/Contract or enter into any arrangement or composition with his creditors or suspend payment or if the firm dissolved under the Partnership Act or if the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) being a company is wound up voluntarily or by order of a Court or a Receiver, Liquidator or Manager on behalf of the debenture holders and creditors is appointed or circumstances shall have arisen which entitles the Court of debenture holder and creditors to appoint a receiver, liquidator or manager, the purchaser without prejudice to his right to recover any expenses, losses or damages to which the purchaser may be put to incur or sustain by reason of the Seller/Contractor's default or breach of Order/Contract shall be entitled to cancel the Order/Contract either in whole or portion thereof without compensation to the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) and if the purchaser so desires, he may procure upon such terms and in such manner as he deems appropriate, stores not so delivered or others of a similar description where stores exactly complying with particulars are not, in the opinion of the purchaser, which shall be final, readily procurable, at the risk and cost of the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) and the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs provided that the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) shall continue the performance of the Order/Contract to the extent not cancelled under the provisions of this clause. The Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) shall on no account be entitled to any gain on such repurchases.

27.2Cost of the purchases/service made by the Purchaser/Service taker at the risk and cost of the seller/contractor (Service Provider) shall be worked out after levying 30% overheads as departmental charges on the cost of materials / services so purchased/hired.

#### 28 **FORCE MAJEURE:**

The conditions of Force Majeure shall means the events beyond control of the parties effected such as act of God, Earthquake, Flood, Devastating fire, War, Civil Commotion, Cyclone, Industrial Lockout and Statutory Act of the Government having bearing on the performance of the Contract. The party affected by Force Majeure shall be obliged to notify the other party within 48 hours, by fax/cable, of the commencement and the end of the Force Majeure circumstances preventing its performance of all or any of its obligations under this order. If performance of obligations under this order is delayed for more than one months due to a continuous Force Majeure, the party not affected by Force Majeure may at any time thereafter while such Force Majeure continues, by notice in writing forth with terminate all or any part of the unperformed portion this order. If this order or any portion thereof is terminated under Force Majeure conditions, the Contractor shall be liable to the COMPANY for any damages, losses or liabilities as result thereof.

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### 29 LD & PENALTY

29.1 PENALTY CLAUSES: The penalties imposed for violation of service agreement clauses shall be notified by BHEL as per the terms indicated. The Contractor shall be given 3 days to respond to the levying of penalties and submit representations if any. The representations shall be suitably considered by BHEL and decision taken shall be final and binding. The penalties imposed shall be deductible from payments due to the Contractor and/or from the Security Deposit. In the event the payments due to the Contractor and the security deposit available with BHEL falls short of the total penalty recoverable from the Contractor whether on account of the quantum of loss caused by the workmen of the Contractor or otherwise, the Contractor shall, on first written demand by BHEL pay to BHEL without demur or dispute the said sum as per BHEL's demand notwithstanding the pendency of any investigation/inquiry/legal proceedings whatsoever before any Court/Tribunal/Authority etc. The amount of loss determined by BHEL shall be final and binding on the Contractor.

#### 29.2 LD/PENALTY FOR DELAY & QUALITY:

- **29.2.1** The contractor need to maintain all the plants in healthy conditions always in good quality earthen pot falling which a penalty @ 10% of monthly bill will be levied and same will be deducted from monthly bill.
- **29.2.2** If the quality of work is not satisfactory, BHEL reserves the right to impose the LD up to maximum 10% of the contract value.
- **29.2.3** LD for delay as well as quality is to be considered in TOTO i.e. total LD shall be 10% of the contract value.
- **29.2.4** In case of LD recovery, the applicable GST shall be recovered from the service provider/contractor.
- 29.2.5 The above are not exhaustive but merely illustrative. BHEL reserves its rights to terminate the Contract at any time in the event the Contractor has contravened any provision of the Contract or any other legal requirement or due to repeated/habitual non-adherence to the qualitative, quantitative and time requirements stipulated in the Contract after giving a notice of 30 days for rectification of the same. If the Contractor has not rectified/ corrected the deficiencies stated in the written notice issued by BHEL, within the period of 30 days from the date of issue of notice, then the Contract may be terminated by BHEL by giving a written communication to the Contractor.
- 29.2.6 In the event of the termination of the Contract for any reason whatsoever, BHEL's liability shall only extend to making payment to the Contractor of the Contract Price accruing (prorated, if necessary) up to the date of termination for actual services rendered by the Contractor after making all deductions that BHEL is entitled to make pursuant to provisions of this Contract. BHEL shall not have any liability to pay

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to the Contractor any compensation or reimburse any costs incurred by the Contractor and the Contractor hereby waives any claim for compensation for losses/damages and/or reimbursement of costs.

29.2.7 All amounts including the losses / damages / penalties / compensations etc., resulting from non-compliance with the terms of Contract, payable by the Contractor to BHEL under the Terms of the Contract will be recovered from the outstanding payments to Contractor either under this Contract or any other Contracts or from Security Deposit or from both. In case this amount is insufficient for such recoveries, the Contractor shall make good the balance amount by actual payment. In addition, BHEL will recover the said amounts through its sister concerns, from the payments due to the Contractor in any of the Units of BHEL located in any part of India.

29.2.8 PVC, Bonus clause: Not applicable
