Technical Pre-Qualification Requirement Criteria are part of NIT and the bidders are required to submit Technical Pre-Qualification Requirement Criteria along with their offer. **Only those bidders, who fulfill these requirements, shall be considered further for evaluation.**

17. BHEL reserves the right to finalize Prices by conducting RA or by conventional way of price bid opening, which will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. In view of this, Bidder is requested to quote their most competitive prices as **no negative price impact** shall be applicable on account of non-conduction of RA. 18. Evaluation will be done on L1 (Total cost to BHEL i.e. FOR site price) basis excluding GST.
19. CIF is not available for subject package.
20. Foreign and indigenous bidders participating through open tenders will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs issued by the certifying authorities in India for future tenders. GST shall not be inclusive as evaluation is to be done excluding GST.
