Technical Pre-Qualification Requirement Criteria are part of NIT and the bidders are required to submit Technical Pre-Qualification Requirement Criteria along with their offer. **Only those vendors, who fulfill Technical requirements, shall be considered further for evaluation.**

15. Evaluation will be done on overall L1 (Total Cost to BHEL) basis including applicable loading (if any) excluding GST.
16. In case of foreign bidders following term & conditions shall be applicable for importing materials on C&F basis.

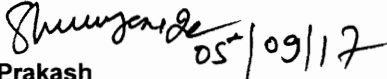
