

2. **BID OPENING**

PART- I (Techno-Commercial Bids) will be opened at **12:00 P.M.** on the due date in the presence of bidders who may like to be present. Date and time of opening of Part - II (Price Bids) shall be communicated separately.

3. The bid shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of offers. No revision of prices shall be entertained after bids have been opened. Bidder shall not be entitled during this period to revoke or vary the content of bid or any terms thereof. In case of any unsolicited variation subsequent to bid opening, the bid shall be treated as "Rejected".
4. No revision of prices shall be entertained after bids have been opened.
5. Prices shall remain firm without any variation till completion of contract.
6. Illustrative leaflets giving technical details of items offered should be enclosed, wherever necessary.
7. BHEL shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other bid and shall have the right to accept or reject any bid in part or in full without assigning any reason whatsoever. BHEL also reserves the right to reject any or all quotations without assigning any reason whatsoever. Quotation of the parties which have been black-listed / debarred / banned by PSUs / kept on hold by any office of Delhi-based Divisions of BHEL during the last three years will be rejected. Late tenders will be rejected.
8. Late tenders will be rejected.
9. Contract value means total contract value including all taxes

10. **PRICE DISCREPENCY:**

- a) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in the words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail.
- b) If there is such discrepancy in an offer, the same may be conveyed to the bidder with target date up to which the bidder has to send his acceptance on the above lines and if the bidder does not agree to the decision of the purchaser, the bid is liable to be ignored.
- c) Taxes and duties if not specified clearly as extra shall be considered as included in the basis price and, therefore, shall not be reimbursed separately.

11. **EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD):**

**EMD of Rs 1,840/- (Rupees One Thousand Eight Hundred Forty only)**

**The EMD may be accepted only in the following forms:**

- (i) Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before tender opening)
- (ii) Banker's cheque/ Pay order/ Demand draft, in favour of BHEL (along with offer in a separate envelope)

**No interest shall be payable by BHEL on EMD amount.**

The EMD shall be forfeited in case of:

- i) After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.
- ii) The Contractor fails to deposit the required Security deposit or commence the work within the period as per LOI/ Contract.
- iii) EMD by the tenderer shall be withheld in case any action on the tenderer is envisaged under the provisions of extant "Guidelines on Suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors" and forfeited/ released based on the action as determined under these guidelines.
- iv) If operations of the contract are not commenced from the date indicated in the award of contract.

12. **PERFORMANCE SECURITY DEPOSIT:**

**Security Deposit shall be collected from the successful bidder herein after called 'caterer'. The rate of Security shall be 5% of total contract value.**

50% Security Deposit shall be submitted by the caterer before the start of the work. The EMD amount of successful bidder shall be adjusted against security deposit and the balance 50% security deposit can be recovered from the running bills on pro rata basis (@ 10% of running bill value). No interest will be payable on Security Deposit.

Failure to pay the security deposit shall be treated as failure to discharge the duties under the contract and shall result in cancellation of the offer of the contract and the caterer shall be liable to compensate BHEL for any losses incurred by BHEL. The security deposit shall be refunded within a reasonable time after the date of expiry of the contract subject to the caterer carrying out all obligations / operations as required under the contract.

BHEL reserves the right to appropriate any part / whole of the amount of the security deposit without prejudice to other claims against the caterer for losses suffered by BHEL due to failures on the part of the caterer due to termination of contract or caterer becoming disqualified because of liquidation / insolvency. The decision of BHEL in respect of such losses, damages, charges, expenses, costs, shall be final and binding on the Caterer and the decision shall not be questionable.

13. **Delivery:** Bidder must be ready to provide the services of this Contract within 7 Days from the date of LOI/ award of the work. For delay, LD shall be levied as per clause No. 20 of Commercial Terms & Condition.

**14. TAX DEDUCTION AT SOURCE:**

Tax shall be deducted at source from the running bills as per applicable Income Tax Rules and other statutory requirements.

**15. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:**

If at any time during the currency of contract, the Contractor defaults in performance of the work with due diligence and continues to do so or commit any default in complying any of the tender terms and conditions even after the notice (in writing) is given to him, BHEL may, without prejudice to any other, has right to remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue thereafter to BHEL, to terminate the contract.

16. **SHORT CLOSURE OF CONTRACT:** BHEL reserves the right to short close the contract with one month notice without assigning any reason.

17. **DEVIATION:** The Contractor must comply with the tender specification and all terms and conditions of contract. No deviation shall normally be entertained.

**18. EVALUATION CRITERIA:**

Evaluation will be done on the Total amount 'T' quoted as mentioned in price format. In the event of more than one bidder having quoted identical lowest rates, work shall be awarded to the bidder having higher of average financial turnover of last three years.

19. In case of any act of default/ omission/ pilferage/ prejudice to any interest of BHEL, BHEL may take action against Contractor as per company guidelines in addition to the penalty & action explicitly mentioned in this tender document.

20. **LD:** It is clearly understood among the parties to the contract that time is the essence of the contract. Therefore, the delivery of the works specified in the Order should be started within the stipulated delivery period. Where work is started after the stipulated period, the BHEL shall be under no obligation to accept the works. However, if accepted, penalty at the rate of 1% per week or part thereof of delay limited to 10% (excluding taxes) of the total contract value, without prejudice to any other relief or compensation due to the contractor under any other condition of the Work Order.

21. **Penalty clause:** The contractor has to start the work within 7 days as per delivery terms of contract, failing to which a penalty @ Rs.1000/- per day of delay shall be levied on contractor. Also, the work has to be completed within 15 days (including holidays) from the date of start of work as per work completion period terms of contract, failing to which a penalty @ 0.5% per week of delay or part thereof shall be levied on total contract value subject to maximum 10% of total contract value.

22. **Payment Term:** In case of award of the work, all Invoices in conformation with the measurement books, along with specified documents shall be submitted in duplicate (one original & one copy), to HR-GAX Department of BHEL/PS-PEM, PPEI Building, NOIDA and the payment will generally be made within 30 days after receipt of bill correct in all respect, measurement and verification by BHEL representative for satisfactory completion of the work. Payment will be made through e-payment (through electronic fund transfer (EFT) / RTGS) and in concurrence with applicable Statutory Guideline as per Govt. of India. Details of your bank account for the same shall be submitted by you. **No advance money** will be paid under any circumstances. Also no interest shall be paid due to delay in making the payment.

**Specified documents** which are required to be submitted with Invoice are as follows: GST Compliance Invoice (clearly mentioning the GST number of vendor and GST number of BHEL), Product Warranty Card/Undertaking(If any), Copy of PAN Card, GST undertaking, NEFT Details (if not provided, for first time vendor, cancelled cheque.

### GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### 23. ARBITRATION

In the event of any dispute or difference arising out of the execution of the Order/Contract or the respective rights and liabilities of the parties or in relation to interpretation of any provision between BHEL & Service Provider in any manner touching upon the Order/Contract, such dispute or difference shall (except as to any matters, the decision of which is specifically provided for therein) be referred to the arbitration of the person appointed by the competent authority of BHEL.

Subject to as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The venue of arbitration shall be at Noida.

#### 24. LAWS GOVERNING THE CONTRACT

The Order/Contract shall be executed and governed by the laws of India and the courts of India alone shall have jurisdiction in respect of any matter arising under or in connection with the Order/Contract. Extant regulations of Govt. of India will be applicable. Law of land will supersede any condition given in tender enquiry, in case of any contradiction.

#### 25. JURISDICTION OF COURT

Courts at Noida/Gautam Budh Nagar shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide the dispute, if any, arising out of or in respect of the contract(s) to which these conditions are applicable.

#### 26. STATUTORY VARIATION:

- i) Statutory variation for CGST/SGST/UGST/IGST is applicable based on the Govt. Notifications on the date of service.
- ii) No other variations such as on minimum wages, prices of controlled commodities, any other input etc. shall be payable by the purchaser.

27. ## Technical Terms & Conditions

Annexure-VII

### 1) Scope of work

The scope of work covers supply & execution of aluminium partition in BHEL, PS-PEM, at plot no.25, sector 16A, Noida.

The scope of work includes all the following works as per BOQ and specification but not limited to the following:

- a) Supply, cutting & fabrication and erection of new aluminium partition as per specification.
- b) Fixing of partition in wall & floor properly and glass & particle boards will be fix in the partition as per drawing.
- c) Providing matt white privacy grade window film.
- d) Disposal of all debris generated in all type of fixing & dismantling will be disposed by the bidder outside the BHEL campus as per guideline of ministry of environment.

The Bidder shall visit the site and assess the involvement of works under the scope of work. Bidder shall apprise himself fully with existing site conditions to meet the stipulated time frame laid down in the specification. The bidder is expected to get clarified any doubts about the specification etc., before bidding through discussion with the Owner recorded in writing in respect of interpretation of any portion of this documents. No extra claim shall be entertained for any unforeseen reason. The details provided by the Owner/BHEL in the bid documents are for bidder's information and guidance only.

### 2) Execution

The work shall be executed in a professional approach, adhering to quality & safety requirements & to the entire satisfaction of Engineer in Charge. Sufficient manpower & resources shall be deployed to complete the work in an un-interrupted manner. As the office work is functioning in the MPL Building and employees are seated there, adequate measures shall be undertaken by the contractor to ensure that the day to day office works of BHEL are least affected due to execution of work under this contract.

#### 2.1. Demolishing / Dismantling

The demolition/ dismantling for grouting of partition shall always be well planned before hand and the operations shall be got approved from the Engineer-in-Charge before starting the work. Necessary temporary enclosures or partitions and necessary scaffolding with suitable double scaffolding and proper cloth covering shall also be provided to ensure the safety of the adjoining work or property before demolishing/ dismantling is taken up and the work shall be carried out in such a way that no damage is caused to the adjoining work or property. Necessary precautions shall be taken to keep noise and dust nuisance to the minimum. All work needs to be done under the direction of Engineer-in-Charge. Helmets, goggle, safety belts etc. should be used whenever required and as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge.

### 2.2. Installation of aluminium partition with glass & particle board

All materials shall be stored by the Contractor in proper way to prevent all damage. The workmanship shall be according to best construction practice to give a finish to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

### 3) ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

The installations shall present a neat appearance and shall be checked for vibration & tightness. The following shall be checked:

- a) Grouted in the wall & floor properly.
- b) Absence of vibration.
- c) Provision of packing of glass & partitions properly.
- e) Proper installation of aluminium members & fittings.
- F) Proper pasting of window film.

The surface level shall be such as to allow smooth & scratch free anywhere. Joints should be sealed properly.

### 4) RATES AND MEASUREMENT

#### a) Rates

Rates shall be firm till the completion of work. Rates shall be unit rate for complete item described in "Schedule of Items" and shall include all wastage, royalty and carriages/cartage, equipment, tools & plant and labour, as detailed in this specification and BOQ unless any portion is specifically excluded in the "BOQ Items".

No extra shall be paid for making approaches, finishing, cartage etc.

No advance payments shall be made.

#### b) Measurement

All work shall be measured actual after installation is complete in unit mentioned in the price format. No extra shall be paid for cutting, wastage, laps etc. in works.

### 5) Variation in quantity/item:

The quantities mentioned in the schedule of quantities are based on estimate and are meant to be indicating the extent of work and to provide a uniform basis of tendering. However, the variation in quantity shall be limited to +/-30%.

The contractor shall be bound to carry out the work in accordance to the instructions given to him in writing by engineer in charge or his representative on behalf of company.

## General Terms & Conditions

### [A] Terms and Conditions:

1. **DELIVERY:** The bidder should start the work within seven (7) days from the date of work order. On delay, penalty will be levied as per penalty clause.
2. Bidder are requested to go through the scope of work, visit the BHEL's work premises etc. and get fully acquainted with the scope of works required and get their doubts clarified regarding the above job before submitting the offer.
3. Bidder must note that any false information / data or any suppression of facts will disqualify them even at a later stage also. The Bidder will have to deploy trained and efficient work force for the work.
4. The Bidder may be rejected on account of unsatisfactory part performance in the execution of an earlier contract if noticed during technical evaluation.
5. The successful Bidder will be responsible for the quality of the job / services and will immediately rectify the deficiency pointed out in the work performed.
6. If at any time during the period of contract, it is observed by BHEL or its authorized representative that the work being performed are not to the satisfaction or any terms of the contract are violated and Bidder does not respond for improvement of the same; in such situation BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract and may recover the undone cost from his bill.
7. Successful bidder shall take all precautions to ensure that no damage happens to any structure of the office building.
8. BHEL will have no liability whatsoever concerning the persons deployed by the contractor for the purpose. The contractor shall keep BHEL indemnified against all losses or damages or liability arising out of or imposed in the course of employment of persons by the contractor.
9. The contractor will be solely responsible for any unlawful act of their workforce while on duty. In case of theft or loss of BHEL's property takes place due to the negligence or carelessness of workforce, the contractor will be responsible and shall make good of the same.
10. In case of any dispute, the decision taken by BHEL Management will be final and binding on the contractor.
11. In case, while on duty and during the course of engagement in work premises of the Company under this contract, if any of the Contractor's workforce meet (s) with any injury / indisposition due to accident or other natural calamities, the Contractor shall ensure that immediate and adequate medical aid viz., first -aid and subsequent treatment facilities are provided to the person(s) concerned free of cost without fail. In addition, the Contractor shall also be liable for meeting with statutory liabilities like ESI etc. in respect to his workers.
12. Contractor will have full responsibility of proper up keep, maintenance of the equipments etc. handed over to them by the company.
13. No labour below the age of fourteen or who is not an Indian National shall be employed on the work.
14. Any discrepancy in the bid, if found advantageous to BHEL shall be considered for evaluation accordingly.

**18. SAFETY RULES:**

- a) The Contractor must inspect the area of work to decide the safety precautions necessary for executing this contract.
- b) No material of any kind shall be dropped or allowed to be dropped from any height.
- c) Defective ladders shall not be used at all.
- d) The necessary safety equipment such as gloves, safety belt, helmet, safety boot etc. must be issued to the workmen and strictly to be used while carryout the work. If Personal Protection Equipment not provided by the contractor, BHEL shall provide the required PPEs on chargeable basis, depending upon the stock availability.
- e) All safety precautions are to be taken by the contractor at his cost.

These safety measures shall be deemed to form an integral part of the Work Order/ Agreement.

**[B] Completion period:**

The total time fixed for completion of all the works is fifteen (15) days including holidays from the date of start of work. On delay, penalty will be levied as per penalty clause.
