Tenderers are requested to sign and put seal on all pages of tender documents and submit else their offer shall be liable for rejection.

General Conditions:

1. BHEL, RCPuram is in requirement of 3 non AC Ambulances [similar to 1066 (1 no) and 108 (2 no)] for the use of General Hospital and Factory Medical Centre @24 hrs/day on all days (including Holidays & Sundays).
2. Category 1 - Ambulance 1066 (1 no) and Category 2 - 108 (1 no) shall be for the use of General Hospital and the average km run per month for these Ambulances is 3000 km. Extra km amount shall be paid thereafter to these Ambulances.
3. Category 3 - Ambulance 108 (1 no) shall be used for the use of Factory Medical Centre and the average km run per month for these Ambulances is 3000 km. No extra km amount shall be paid to this Ambulance.
4. The Ambulances shall have all the equipment mentioned in Annexure-III and each Ambulance shall be supplied along with 3 Qualified Medical Technicians (trained in BCLS and ACLS) @24 Hrs Per day for a period of two years.
5. Contractors in possession of at least 1 Ambulance as mentioned above can take part in the tender by submitting all the relevant documents at the time of submission of tender. Ambulance(s) shall be in the name of Contractor only. Ambulance(s) on partnership deeds/on power of attorneys/authorizations and on lease basis are not accepted.
6. Contractors not in possession of Ambulances need not take part in the tender. They shall be technically disqualified even if taken part.
7. All the documents required for technical qualification (as mentioned in Annexure II) needs to be submitted.
8. The fuel shall be in scope of the Contractor only. However, fuel escalation charge as applicable will be paid.

Signature of Contractor

9. Transport Contractors shall quote for **ONE or TWO or THREE** Ambulances and the same shall be mentioned in Annexure II point 10.
10. All the terms and conditions stated in the NIT shall be applicable for each Ambulance.
11. The Year of Manufacture of Ambulance(s) shall be June 2013 & later Models only and the ambulance(s) shall be in perfect working condition.
12. If the Ambulance(s) runs for all days in a month, basic payment as finalized shall be made irrespective of km run. However, in case the vehicle(s) does not run on any day, proportionate hourly/daily penalty shall be levied as mentioned later in the NIT.
13. Once the contract is awarded, the Ambulance(s) shall be brought for inspection along with the original documents (as mentioned below) as per the Date & Time mentioned in the Work Order / Letter issued by transport pool.
14. The following documents (applicable and valid) need to be submitted before the work commences.
 - a. Registration Certificate
 - b. Driving License(s)
 - c. Comprehensive Insurance
 - d. Pollution Certificate
 - e. Permit
 - f. Road Tax
 - g. Fitness Certificate
15. If any of the above certificates gets expired during the contract period, the same shall be renewed and copy shall be submitted to Contract Executing officer in Hospital Admin. Dept. in time.
16. Once the Contract is finalized, the Ambulance(s) shall be at the operational disposal of BHEL for the entire contract period.

Signature of Contractor

17. In case of any change in the contact details of either the Contractor/Driver, the same shall be reported to Hospital Admin. All the correspondence will be done as per the available contact details only.

18. As per the policies of BHEL, the amount of Security Deposit shall be @ 5% of Contract value.

The tenderer shall submit their offer in two part bids

- a. Techno-commercial bid consisting of Annexure – I, II and III duly signed on all pages along with DDs original for Rs.1000/- (cost of tender documents) & Earnest Money Deposit.
- b. Price bid consisting of Annexure – IV duly filled in & duly signed.

The above two bids are to be placed in separate covers duly sealed. The cover for Techno-commercial bid should be super-scribed as “Techno-commercial bid for Hiring of Ambulance(s)” and Price bid shall be super-scribed as “Price bid for Hiring of Ambulance(s)”

ANNEXURE-I

Terms & conditions for entering into rate contract for **“Hiring of non AC Ambulances similar to 108 (2 no) and 1066 (1 no) for a period of two years.”**

1. The basic rate for 24 Hrs operation per day and 3000 KMs Run in a Month should be quoted in Annexure – IV and/or with Rate per Extra KM beyond 3000KMs run in a Month.
2. The Transport Contractor should ensure that the Ambulance(s) drivers shall meet the following:
 - Minimum of 2 year experience of driving vehicles with proof of valid license.
 - Maintain Dress Code, Strict Discipline, punctuality and keep the vehicle always neat and clean.
3. The Contractor shall maintain regular contact with the designated employee of BHEL and shall interact on matters relating to the work awarded under this contract.
4. All the offers received will be scrutinized and only the technically qualified offers will be considered. Technically not qualified offers will be rejected.
5. All entries in the Tender should be clearly written in ink pen or ball point and corrections, if any, are to be duly attested by the tenderer.
6. Issue of Tender documents does not mean that the bidder fulfills the qualifying requirements of the contract.
7. Submission of offer shall mean that the bidder has read the bid documents and agrees to abide by the terms & conditions mentioned in the documents.
8. Quotation should be valid for a period of three months from the date of opening of Techno-commercial bid.
9. No other person except Contractor's authorized representative will be allowed in BHEL premises.
10. Within BHEL premises, the Contractor's personnel should not do any work other than the normal duties allotted by Hospital Authorities.
11. Transport Contractor should provide Cell phone at Contractor's cost to the drivers to facilitate communication for taking duties on day to day basis and at the time of emergencies / breakdowns / accidents and any other important message to be passed to the contractor or to BHEL staff.

Signature of Contractor

12. The breakdown / overhauling / preventive maintenance hours will not be counted in hours of operations.
13. Contractor is solely responsible for payment of wages / salaries and allowances to his personnel. BHEL will have no liability whatsoever in this regards.
14. The contractor shall arrange alternate driver immediately in case the actual driver falls ill, is on leave or absconds from duty.
15. The contractor shall make available similar relief Ambulance immediately in the event of any accident. Such relief Ambulance shall be in good running condition.
16. Transport Contractor to obtain insurance covered for his employees and shall take comprehensive insurance coverage at his own cost. BHEL will not be responsible for any loss / damage / pilferage or his property and or his employees.
17. Contractor shall be directly responsible for providing necessary staff like licensed drivers and qualified medical technicians with the prescribed uniform. He will also be responsible for their courteous behaviour towards BHEL & CISF authorities.
18. The Ambulance shall be registered; duly insured i.e. comprehensive insurance and the same should be renewed from time to time during contract period at his own cost. Transport Contractor will be fully responsible for the safe movement of the Ambulance users.
19. The Transport Contractor should abide by the Company's CISF Security rules and shall provide Safety PPEs (Personnel Protection Equipment) to the Drivers.
20. The Transport Contractor shall ensure that Ambulance(s) employed under this contract agreement is covered by a comprehensive insurance policy. Under no circumstances shall BHEL be liable to compensate for any loss or damage that may be caused to the Ambulance(s) by accident or complications arising out of such contingencies like theft, fire, riots, strike and terrorism damage whether inside or outside BHEL premises while engaged.
21. In case BHEL be held liable for any loss, damage or compensation to third parties arising from or in relation to Transport operations done by the Transport Contractor such loss, damage or compensation shall be paid by Transport Contractor to BHEL together with the costs incurred by BHEL on any legal proceedings pertaining thereto.
22. In case of any suit or legal proceedings arising under this contract, the court of Sangareddy (Medak District) Telangana only shall have the jurisdiction.

Signature of Contractor

23. The Contractor is directly responsible for injuries / death of occupants or other users arising due to accident or otherwise of Ambulance(s) during the contractual period. At any point of time, BHEL will not be responsible for any loss / damage either to the person or to the Ambulance(s) arising out of accident of the Ambulance(s) for performing contractual obligations.
24. The Transport Contractor will have to indemnify BHEL against the following, in case the same is thrust upon BHEL:
- a. All claims for injury or damage to any person, property caused by his negligence or negligence of his employees while on operations
 - b. Failure in observance of labour and industrial laws by the contractor.
 - c. All claims by way of compensation and all other types of unforeseen claims which may occur in the course of contract incurred by contractor.
 - d. All payments by way of compensation or otherwise which BHEL may be called upon to make under provisions of the relevant acts to any workmen as aforesaid and any cost incurred by BHEL in connection with any claim and demands whatever in respect thereof or in any loss, injury or damages whatever to any third person arising out of this contract by the Transport contractor, their workmen servants or agents shall be recovered from contractor
 - e. For all claims, payments and losses that BHEL may have to make or suffer on account thereof the transport contractor shall wherever required to do so by BHEL or Govt. officials authorized under law, produce for inspection all forms, register and other papers required to be maintained under various statutes.
25. The contractor shall indemnify the company against all losses or damages sustained by the company resulting directly or indirectly including his failure to give intimation in the manner aforesaid including the penalties or dues if any and become payable by the company, as a consequence of failure, the company to give notice under the workmen's compensation act or otherwise confirm o the provisions of the said act in regard to such accident.
26. Any amount recoverable from transport contractor towards the loss / damage will be recovered from the outstanding payments due or from the security deposit. In case the amount is insufficient for such recoveries, transport contractor shall make good the balance amount by remitting in the cash office at BHEL. The company reserves the right to enter into Parallel contracts for the same period or any part thereof.

Signature of Contractor

27. BHEL reserves the right to refuse / cancel the tender at any stage without assigning any reason.
28. BHEL reserves the right to refuse / engage the Ambulance(s) if the driver or the Ambulance(s) engaged does not confirm to any of the regulations of MV Act or APMV Rules or blacklisted contractor of BHEL, Hyderabad – 502 032.
29. The contract may be terminated at any time without paying compensation whatsoever to the transport contractor in case of misbehaviour, disobedience, dishonesty, clandestine insolvency, any court order, non-sanction of road permit or any other related activities on their part or their failure to fulfill the terms & conditions of this agreement.
30. The Rates quoted shall remain valid for entire contract period. However reimbursement / recovery will be made for increase / decrease only in the cost of fuel. No other variations other than the cost of fuel will be allowed by BHEL during the tenure of the contract period. The escalation is based upon diesel cost on the date of opening of technical bids. Escalation for increase / decrease in diesel cost will be reimbursed / recovered at the rate of 0.01 rupee per KM for every 10 paise per litre increase / decrease in fuel cost. The escalation is applicable at actual KM run for reimbursement / recovery.
31. An amount towards EMD shall be paid by demand draft drawn in the name of “**Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited**” payable at Hyderabad and shall be enclosed to the Techno-commercial bid. No interest will be paid on EMD. The EMD is returned to the unsuccessful bidder only after 15 days from the date of finalization of tender.
32. EMD - Earnest Money Deposit will be forfeited in case of the following:
 - a. On withdrawal of the bid or increase in rates or changes in the bid conditions after opening of tender.
 - b. On refusal to enter into a contract after the contract is awarded.
 - c. In case of cheating, committing frauds, providing false information during any stage of tender process.
 - d. If the successful tenderer does not commence the service from the date indicated in Letter of Intent (LOI).
33. EMD furnished by the successful bidder will be adjusted as part of security deposit towards contract performance guarantee and shall be refunded within three months of the date of expiry / completion / revocation of the contract. In the event of the agency failing to comply with any provision of the contract, the security deposit shall be forfeited by BHEL.

Signature of Contractor

34. Successful tenderer shall pay a Security Deposit as per the works policy 2016, @ 5% of contract value for two years period.

Security Deposit:

- a. Cash (as permissible under income tax act)
 - b. The successful tenderers EMD paid will be converted and adjusted into Security Deposit.
 - c. Minimum 50% of the Security Deposit amount should be paid by Cash or Demand Draft at the time of agreement and before commencing the contract, balance 50% to be recovered from Monthly bills to the Maximum of 10% of the Total Contract value.
 - e. The Security Deposit will not carry any interest and will be paid after successful completion of contract to BHELs satisfaction.
35. The Transport contractor shall submit his bills on 5th day of the following Month. The trips will be authorized by the user or Transport pool authorities. In case the bills are not submitted by 5th of the following Month, these bills cannot be settled in the month in which the bills are received. All payments will be made only in the name of the Contractor mentioned in RC Book on whose name it is registered.
36. The orders, notices or any correspondence to the transport contractor will be sent by registered post to the address furnished. This is deemed to have been served on the transporter, on date of report of delivery of such correspondence. The Transport Contractor shall carry out the orders without any delay.
37. Withdrawal of contract during the contract period will entail BHEL, not only forfeiture of Security Deposit but also to appoint other Transporter at the risk and cost of the contractor.
38. Soon after the acceptance of the Order, the Transport Contractor shall enter into an agreement with M/s BHEL, Ramachandrapuram, Hyderabad – 502 032. The agreement shall be entered on Non-judicial Stamp paper of the value of Rs.200/- to be purchased by Transport Contractor at his own cost.
39. M/s BHEL, Ramachandrapuram, Hyderabad – 502 032 reserves the right to accept any tender or part of tender without assigning any reasons thereof irrespective of the fact whether the accepted tender is lowest or not.
40. The Contract once finalized will be valid for two years from the date of commencement of work and can be extended for a period of one year on mutual acceptance at same Scope, Rate, Terms & Conditions and passing fitness test.

Signature of Contractor

41. In case of any suit or other legal proceedings arising out of and relating to the contract to be entered into, the courts at Sangareddy in Medak District only shall have the jurisdiction.
42. Tax will be deducted at source from the running bills as per applicable income tax rules and other statutory requirements.
43. The Contractor shall ensure adherence to all statutory requirements applicable to Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited, Ramachandrapuram, Hyderabad – 502 032.
44. Any dispute arising out of this contract should be referred to the sole arbitration of Chief Medical Services BHEL, Ramachandrapuram, Hyderabad – 502 032 or his authorized representative and whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
45. In case the contractor does not carry out the contractual / statutory obligations or the services rendered by him are found to be unsatisfactory, BHEL shall bring the same to his notice and he will be obliged to discharge the obligations and rectify the anomaly within prescribed time failing which, BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract without assigning any reason whatsoever. In such an event no damages will be payable for short closure of the contract.
46. Notwithstanding anything contained in the contract agreement which will be entered after award of work, the contract may be terminated by BHEL, without assigning any reason.
47. Non-compliance of any provisions under the act / rule / instructions / guidelines shall make the contractor liable for penal action including termination of contract.
48. The Contractor shall not resort to sub-contracting under any circumstances. If found subcontracting at a later date, BHEL reserves the right to take whatever action it deems fit, including cancellation of the contract and forfeiture of security deposit.
49. On the occurrence of an accident, which results in the death of any of the workmen employed by the contractor or which is so serious as to be likely to result in the death of any such workmen, the contractor shall intimate within 24 Hrs. of the happening of such an accident intimate in writing to the company official in-charge of the work.
50. Wherever, BHEL / Company standards are mentioned, they shall be strictly followed.
51. Whenever the term Contractor is used, it shall be understood to refer to the particular person, firm or corporation with whom an agreement has been made by the concerned company official for executing the work defined in the concerned agreement and for the purpose of instructions regarding compliance with contract conditions. It shall include the contractors authorized agents, who are entrusted with the work by contractor.

Signature of Contractor

52. In the event of any question or dispute under this contract, the same shall be referred to a competent authority in the company for sole arbitration and his decision shall be final and binding on the parties to the contract.
53. All disputes, claims and demands arising in connection with the contract shall be settled by mutual consultation. If no such agreement is reached between the parties each party can appoint one arbitrator and the arbitrators so appointed can appoint a presiding arbitrator. The proceedings of the tribunal shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made there under. The venue of the Arbitration shall be at BHEL, Hyderabad or at such place as the arbitrators may direct. The award to be given by the arbitral tribunal shall be a speaking award. The costs, fees and expenses shall be borne by both the parties equally. The award of the tribunal shall be final and binding on both the parties equally. All questions, disputes, differences arising under, out of or in connection with this contract shall be exclusive jurisdiction of the courts at Sangareddy, Medak District, Telangana.
54. All the works shall be carried in accordance with the directions and to the satisfaction of the company official in accordance scope of work.

55. Finalization of Contract:

The price bids of all the technically qualified would be opened and the L1 party would be decided on basic cost (for each vehicle).

- a) If L1 party rates (all rates) are less than our estimation and are the least Work shall be awarded for acceptance and to produce the vehicle for inspection.
- b) If L1 party rates are greater than our estimation or not the least
Negotiations will be conducted with L1 party and rates would be finalized and work shall be awarded for acceptance and to produce the vehicle for inspection.

In case of tie in basic cost, cost for extra km shall be considered to break the tie. Even if tie exists at this stage, number of vehicles quoted for shall be used to break the tie (party quoting higher number of vehicles stands as L1)

56. Penalty Clause:

A penalty equivalent to payment per day shall be recovered from the bills or the SD apart from hourly proportional cutting in case the vehicle/manpower does not report on any day(s) or the vehicle is under break down or not as per the requirement or the manpower does not carry out the work as instructed by the BHEL nominated person(s).

57. Nothing contained in the contract agreement and its conditions shall be deemed to preclude or render in-operative the service of any notice, letter or other communication upon the contractor personally.
58. Any discrepancies in the tender documents shall be brought out separately on a letter.
59. Price bids should not contain any written content other than the quoted prices. Even if any content is written it shall not be considered.

General instructions to bidders:

1.	Bidders are required to go through instructions carefully and complete all the formalities as required. In event of furnishing false or incorrect information, the offers are liable for rejection and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard
2.	<p>Bidders are required to submit the offer in two parts:</p> <p>1) Techno-commercial bid along with un-priced bid 2) Price bid</p> <p>Each bid shall be kept in separate envelope, which should be properly sealed. Both envelopes shall be put together in a large envelope and shall be submitted to concerned official at vendor complex as per the tender date and time.</p>
3.	Bidders are required to ensure that all columns of the bid are duly filled in. If any incorrect rates or unusually low rates are quoted, offer is liable for rejection and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
4.	The Techno-commercial bid should accompany the Demand Drafts in original for Earnest Money Deposit and Cost of tender document along with other relevant supporting documents. In case of non-submission of Earnest Money Deposit / Document Cost along with the Technical bid, the offer is liable for rejection.
5.	Bidders are required to submit duly filled in tender documents before 1100 hrs by 2 nd December 2016 at Vendor Complex, Administrative Building (BHEL).
6.	The Techno-commercial bids will be opened on the same day i.e. 2 nd December 2016 at 1330 hrs at vendor Complex, BHEL, Hyderabad (unless extended)
7.	Bidders or Bidders representative may attend the tender opening on the above mentioned date, time and place. No separate intimation will be given to bidders.
8.	The sealed price bids of only those offers, which are technically acceptable, will be opened later. The bidders qualifying in Technical bid will be intimated separately for participating in price bid.
9.	In case, there is a discrepancy in values between the numerals and words anywhere in the tender document, the values in words shall be considered.
