E & C- Four (04) months from the date of availability of front at site. Site front availability will be reckoned as the date when site informs vendor for mobilization of manpower & resources

Mandatory spares - Mandatory Spares and Tools & tackles (if any) are to be delivered along with the last consignment of main supply within the contractual delivery period.

- (i) Company Profile
- (ii) List of projects executed/ on hand for power sectors / Govt. organizations for the subject package.
- (iii) Performance Certificates for satisfactory working of the system /equipment's.
- (iv) Copies of major supply order executed by the vendor.

Note: - Non-registered Vendors who wish to apply for registration in BHEL-PEM can apply through Online Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com - vendor section - Online Supplier Registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed and stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website and submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy of the filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed and stamped has to be submitted.

2.12 PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT: -

Bidders who fulfil TECHNICAL & FINANCIAL PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT CRITERIA are eligible to participate in this tender.

Bidders are requested to provide the details as per "TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS". Bids of only those bidders shall be evaluated who meet the Technical as well as Financial Pre-Qualifying requirements.

2.13 Evaluation will be done on overall L1 basis (Total Cost to BHEL) excluding GST quoted by bidder basis with necessary loading as applicable.

2.14 CIF content: - Not Applicable

2.15 Contractor will comply with HSE (Health, Safety & Environment) requirement of BHEL.

2.16 BGs should be in favour of BHEL-PSSR in place of PEM. Vendors will be required to submit BGs to executing agency BHEL-PSSR.

2.17 In case of joint bidding Bidders to furnish scope matrix which should be clearly defined between foreign bidder and their Indian representative along with the offer for the Main Supply and Erection & Commissioning

2.18 Prices shall be firm.

2.19 Foreign bidders will have to quote C&F (cost & freight) basis. For importing materials on C&F basis, bidders to note following:

As per Incoterms (CFR), risk transfers to buyer when the goods have been boarded on the ship in the country of Export. Hence, shipped on board date mentioned on the clear Bill of Lading or Air way Bill, shall be treated as the date of Shipment/ Dispatch for all contractual purposes including calculation of LD.

2.20 Foreign and indigenous bidders participating in subject tender will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs issued by the certifying authorities in India. Basic procedure /checklist has been uploaded on www.bhel.com for participating in subject tender enquiry through e procurement.

2.21 All the tender documents shall automatically become a part of the Order/Contract after its finalization.

2.23 The bidder along with its associate/collaborators/sub vendor/subcontractors/sub vendors/consultants/service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website www.bhel.com and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice. 2.24 Bidder is requested to quote their best competitive prices. "BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. The envelope sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.

If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com)."
