**Sub: Qualifying criteria for the vendors participating in "Open Tender"
for the supply of CS, AS & SS Seamless Pipes – Reg.**

1. The supplier / principals / manufacturers who are submitting the offer shall have in-house manufacturing, heat treatment and testing facilities and also, the offers are to be submitted by the facility/mill only. Offers submitted by manufacturer or their subsidiaries (own stockists) will only be considered. Offers from traders will not be considered.
2. The offer shall be accompanied with relevant list of the in-house manufacturing and testing facilities which must contain details of hot/cold working, heat treatment and testing facilities and their capacities / ranges etc.
3. Vendors to confirm that they will meet all the requirements of applicable latest BHEL specification provided with the enquiry. Any deviations from BHEL Specifications will lead to disqualification of Vendor.
4. The vendor must have experience of manufacturing and supplying pipes of the corresponding standards and grades as mentioned in the enquiry. Also, the TCs submitted as evidence must include details of the pipes of same or higher outer diameter and thickness as mentioned in the enquiry. Past experience data shall be submitted.

For CS/AS pipes

- a) At least one copy of the mill/manufacturer test certificates for the same or similar grade supplied to other customers shall be submitted along with the offer. The test certificates submitted as an evidence of the past experience of the manufacturer must indicate the compliance to all the supplementary requirements as mentioned in BHEL Specification.
- b) The mill test certificate shall include the results / reports for all the tests like Chemical, Mechanical, heat treatment charts (if applicable) and NDT etc. as required by BHEL Specification applicable to the Tender enquiry.
- c) The date of issue of "Test Certificate" shall not be older than 3 years from the NIT date.
- d) This compliance may be met through MTCs submitted against a single Customer Order or multiple Customer Orders.
- e) Conformance to BHEL Standard Quality Plan (SQP) is mandatory for considering your offer.

For SS pipes

- a) At least one copy of the mill/manufacturer test certificates for the same or similar grade supplied to other customers shall be submitted. The test certificates submitted as an evidence of the past experience of the manufacturer must indicate the compliance to all the supplementary requirements as mentioned in BHEL Specification.
- b) The mill test certificate shall include the results / reports for all the tests like Chemical, Mechanical, heat treatment charts (if applicable) and NDT etc. as required by BHEL Specification applicable to the Tender enquiry.

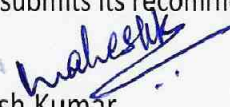
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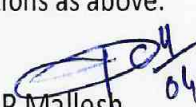
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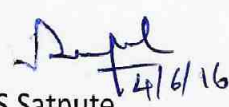

- c) The date of the issue of "Test certificate" shall not be older than 3 years from the NIT date.
 - d) This compliance may be met through MTCs submitted against a single Customer Order or multiple Customer Orders.
 - e) Conformance to BHEL Standard Quality Plan (SQP) is mandatory for considering your offer.
5. The following additional information needed to be submitted by stockists (as indicated in point # 1 above) along with details required as per clauses 2 & 3 (above) regarding manufacturers from whom the material are/will be sourced.
- a) Details of their stock yard w.r.to storage area.
 - b) Facilities for handling of the material.
 - c) Their system for document control.
 - d) Traceability of material in stock viz., documents like mill TC's.
 - e) Their system for preservation of the material.
6. For all new suppliers, TC review shall be done by BHEL before dispatch of the materials. And all the TCs shall be in English Language only.
7. In case of foreign vendors, Charges of Third Party Inspection shall be to vendor's account. Reputed inspection agencies like Lloyds, BV, DNV and TUV may be engaged due to their global presence. In the event any other agency is being proposed by the vendor, the same may be employed with explicit approval of BHEL.
8. As per "Ministry of Steel Order (latest as applicable)," if any of the enquiry items fall under "List of Steel Products under Mandatory Bureau of Indian Standards Certification," BIS certificate is to be provided mandatorily.
9. Vendor to mention applicable safeguard or antidumping duty or any other duties and taxes as the same will be considered for determining the L1 vendor.

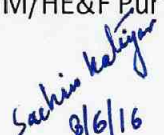

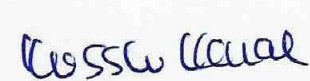

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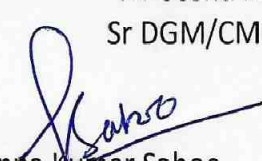

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
