TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ENTERING INTO CONSULTANT JOB FOR LIASONING WORK AT BHEL, RCPuram premises under CMM-STORES DEPT. FOR Obtaining Storage License of 5250Kgs (35kgx150 Nos. cylinders Storage Godown/Shed) DURING 2014-15.

Definition of Terms:-

Consultant/Contractor/Agency shall mean the bidder whose bid will be accepted by BHEL and shall include such successful bidders, legal representatives, successors and assignees from time to time for the purpose of the contract.

Officer shall mean the official(s) authorized by BHEL to act as person-in-charge of Stores-CMM Department BHEL R.C.Puram Hyderabad – 502 032.

General Terms & Conditions:-

- 1. The basic rate stage wise completion basis should be quoted in Annexure-III (PRICE BID)
- 2. Contract will be finalised on least cost basis to BHEL job and stagewise cost on totality basis.
- 3. Once Contract is finalized the Job should be completed within time limit.
- 4. Bidding of Documents does not mean that the bidder fulfils the qualifying requirements of the contract.
- 5. Submission of offer shall mean that the bidder has read the bid documents and agrees to abide by the terms and conditions mentioned in the documents.
- 6. Quotation should be valid for a period of three months from the date of opening of Techno Commercial Bid.
- 7. No other person except contractor's authorized representatives will be allowed in BHEL premises.
- 8. Within BHEL premises, the contractor's personnel should not do any work other than their normal duties.
- 9. Liaoning contractor should provide cell phone to the supervisor to facilitate communication at the time of emergencies/breakdowns/accidents and any other important message to be passed to the contractor.
- 10. Contractor is solely responsible for payment of wages/salaries and allowances to his personnel. BHEL will have no liability whatsoever in this regard.
- 11. Failure to complete the job entails BHEL to take alternative Consultant and get the Liasoning Job done at the extra cost and recover costs from the pending bills of Original Consultant or from Security Deposit.
- 12. Consultant/ contractor to obtain insurance cover for his employees and equipment / tools / tackles etc. and take <u>third party risk insurance coverage at his own cost.</u> BHEL

- will not be responsible for any loss, damage, pilferage of his property and / or his employees.
- 13. Consultant/Contractor shall be directly responsible for providing necessary staff. He will also be responsible for their courteous behaviour towards the CISF authorities and BHEL authorities.
- 14. The personnel employed should be registered and duly insured i.e. comprehensive insurance and the same should be renewed from time to time during contract period at his own cost.
- 15. The consultant/contractor should abide by the company's CISF Security Rules and shall provide Safety PPEs (Personnel Protection Equipment) to the supervisor and labourers/helpers if engaged. Covered by a comprehensive insurance policy. Under no circumstances shall BHEL be liable to compensate for any loss or damage that may be caused to them by accidents or complications arising out of such contingencies like fire, theft, riots, strikes and terrorism damage whether inside or outside BHEL premises while being engaged.
- 16. In case BHEL be held liable for any loss, damage or compensation to third parties arising from or in relation to job work operations done by the contractor/consultant, such loss, damage or compensation shall be paid by the contractor to BHEL together with the costs incurred by BHEL on any legal proceedings pertaining thereto.
- 17. The consultant/contractor is directly responsible for injuries / death of supervisor, labourer or any person employed by him as well as to the third party occupants or other users arising due to accident or otherwise during the contractual period. At any point of time, BHEL will not be responsible for any loss / damage either to the person arising out of accident for performing the contractual obligations.
- 18. The consultant/contractor will have to indemnify BHEL against the following, in case the same is thrust upon BHEL:
 - (a) All claims for injury or damage to any person or property caused by his negligence or negligence of his employees while on operation which are to be settled by contractor.
- (b) Failure in observance of Labour and Industrial Laws by the consultant/contractor.
 - (c) All claims by way of compensation and all other types of unforeseen claims which may occur in the course of contract incurred by consultant/contractor.
 - (d) All payments by way of compensation or otherwise which BHEL may be called upon to make under the provisions of the relevant acts to any workmen as aforesaid, and any cost incurred by BHEL in connection with any claim preferred by such workmen and or against all action, claim and demands whatever in respect thereof or in any loss, injury or damages whatever to any third person arising out of or occasioned by the negligent, imperfect or

- improper performance of this contract by the contractor, their workmen servants or agents shall be recovered from contractor.
- For all claims, payments and losses that BHEL may have to make or suffer on (e) account thereof the contractor shall whenever required to do so by BHEL or Govt. officials authorized under law, produce for inspection all forms, register and other papers required to be maintained under various statutes.
- 19. Any amount recoverable from contractor towards the loss / damage will be recovered from the outstanding payments due or from security deposit. In case the amount is insufficient for such recoveries, contractor shall make good the balance amount by remitting in the cash office at BHEL. The company reserves the right to enter into parallel contracts for the same period or any part thereof.
- 20. BHEL reserves the right to refuse / cancel the tender at any stage without assigning any reason.
- 21. BHEL reserves its right to refuse / engage any other consultant if not conform to any of the regulations blacklisted contractor of BHEL, Hyd-bad-502032.
- 22. This contract may be terminated at any time without paying compensation whatsoever to the contractor in case of misbehavior, disobedience, dishonesty, clandestine insolvency, any court order, non-sanction or any other related activities on their part or their failure to fulfill the terms and conditions of this agreement.
- 23. The rates quoted shall remain valid till the end of Job work assigned during 2014-15.
- 24. (A)Successful tenderer shall pay a security deposit of 10% of the overall contract value for the period.

SECURITY DEPOSIT CLAUSE:-

Security Deposit should be collected from the successful tenderer. The rate of Security Deposit will be as below:-

Upto Rs.10 lakhs	:	10 %

- (Certificates should be held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly pledged in favour of BHEL and discharged on the back).
- ii) Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks / Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The Bank Guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL.
- iii) Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks / Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The FDR should be in the name of the contractor, A/C BHEL, duly discharged on the back.
- iv) Security deposit can also be recovered at the rate of 10% from the running bills. However in such cases at least 50% of the Security Deposit should be collected before start of the work and the balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills.
- v) EMD of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted against the security deposit.

- 27 Withdrawal of contract during the contract period will entail BHEL to encash security deposit, but also to appoint other Consultant at the risk and cost of the contractor. Soon after the acceptance of the tender, the contractor shall enter into an agreement with M/s. BHEL, R.C.Puram, Hyderabad 502 032. The agreement shall be entered on Non-judicial stamp paper of the value of Rs.100/- to be purchased by the contractor at his own cost.
- 28. M/s. BHEL, R.C.Puram, Hyderabad-502032 reserves the right to accept any tender or part of any tender without assigning any reasons thereof irrespective of the fact whether the accepted tender is the lowest or not.
- 29. The contract once finalized will be valid for time period mentioned/ as agreed from the date of awardal. BHEL has the right to cancel the contract in case of poor or bad service. The contract may also be extended based on requirement of BHEL management with same rates terms and conditions.
- 30. In case of any suit or other legal proceedings arising out of and relating to the contract to be entered into, the courts at Hyderabad / Secunderabad and Sangareddy in Medak District only shall have the jurisdiction.
- 31. Tax will be deducted at source from the running bills as per applicable income tax rules and other statutory requirements.
- 32. Any dispute arising out of this contract should be referred to the sole arbitration of General Manager/CMM/LOGISTICS/C&PR of BHEL. R.C.Puram, Hyderabad-32 or his authorized representative and whose decision shall be final and binding on both the particles.

Penalties:-

BHEL, R.C.Puram will impose penalty for not completing the job work within mutually agreed time period. Consultant/Contractor shall use his expertise in completion of Job work assigned in operation otherwise penalty as mentioned will be levied.

General Instructions to bidders:-

- 1. Bidders are required to go through instructions carefully and complete all the formalities as required. In event of furnishing false or incorrect information, the offers shall be rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- 2. Bidders are required to submit the offer in two parts. (i) Techno-commercial bid and (ii) Price bid. 'Each bid shall be kept in separate envelope, which should be properly sealed'. Both envelopes shall be put together in the large envelope and shall be submitted to concerned official at vendor complex/CMM-Stores department(36/11Annexe) as per the tender date and time.
