01.00.00 TECHNICAL CRITERIA:

The bid is open for participation to those bidders who satisfy the following technical requirements: -

01.01.01 The bidder should be a supplier of ash handling system and should have executed Ash Handling system involving design, engineering, manufacture / procurement, supply, erection & commissioning/ supervision of erection & commissioning, comprising the following system:

Pneumatic fly ash handling system (first stage) for conveying fly ash from ESP hoppers by vacuum conveying system designed for minimum **30 TPH** capacity (on dry ash basis) per stream.

The reference ash handling system should have been in successful operation in at least one (1) plant for at least (1) year as on date of submission of the bid.

For reference fly ash handling systems, the design capacity of conveying from ESPs to buffer hoppers/silos will be the capacity which the client (of the reference plant against which the Bidder/its sub-vendor is seeking qualification) must have specified in its contract documents.

The activity of design and engineering for above system should have been carried out by the bidder and not through any external design agency/agencies.

Note

- 1) Bidder shall submit the following documents along with bid for pre-qualification requirement. Non-submission of below mentioned documents along with bid is liable for rejection. Hence all bidder(s) shall adhere to submission of following documents for meeting Pre-qualification requirement.
 - a. List of experience for the system described above, in the format given below.
 - b. Manufacturing facilities, equipment, manpower details duly signed by bidder shall be furnished.
 - c. Bidder shall provide documentary evidence in support of his claim for having experience in design, manufacture, testing and supply, E&C, performance of AHP meeting the requirements mentioned in sl. Nos. 01.01.01 for Ash Handling Plants which are in operation as on date of submission of the bid. Following documentary evidence (as given below) for supply of item as mentioned in clause no. 01.01.01 shall be submitted along with bid:
 - i. Letter of Award (Purchase order copies)
 - ii. End-user's address and contact details (ph.no, emails) to be furnished.
 - iii. Performance Certificate from End-user.
 - iv. Approved flow schemes, P&ID, Design memorandum/Design basis reports, Sizing Calculations.
- 2) All bid documents are to be only in English language. The bid supporting documents other than English language are to be supported with translated documents in English certified/ attested by embassy of respective country or Indian embassy as applicable. Bilingual certificates if any shall also be vetted by embassy.

B. PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT: (FINANCIAL)

1. Average annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31st March 2019, should not be less than Rs. 10 crores (Rupees Ten Crores Only).
2. Bidders should submit financial accounts (audited, if applicable comprising of Audit report, Balance Sheet, Profit & Loss A/c Statement for FY 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19

3. Other Income shall not be considered for arriving at Annual Turnover/Sales

C. IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. The word "executed" means bidder should have achieved the criteria specified in the above QR even if the total contract is not completed/closed.
2. BHEL will provide format for Bank guarantee to the successful bidder.
3. Bidder has to submit all credentials/ details, required by the end-user for seeking approval of end-user. In case end-user does not approve the credentials of the bidder, the bidder's offer will be rejected.
4. **Bidder shall submit the point wise confirmation to the PQR clauses, properly indexed along with the offer.**
5. BHEL reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the Bidder to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the Employer.
6. Canvassing i.e. soliciting favor, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
7. BHEL reserves the right to:

 - ii. Postpone the scheduled date without assigning any reason whatsoever.
 - iii. May ask for further qualification during techno commercial scrutiny of bids received and bidder will comply.
 - iv. Evaluation of bidder at their works.
