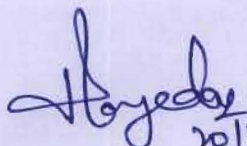
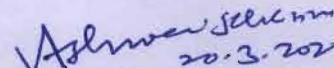

1.0	The bidder is required to meet the provenness criteria and / or qualification requirement for Fuel Oil Handling System as per criteria stipulated below: a) The bidder should have designed, supplied, erected, tested and commissioned at least one (1) number fuel oil handling and storage installation for Power plant / other industry consisting of: (i) Fuel oil decanting facilities for road tankers / railway wagons / oil transfer from existing facilities (i.e. Tank). (ii) One (1) number Fuel oil storage tank of capacity not less than 500 cubic meters. The experience at (i) and (ii) above in separate installations is also permissible. The above system should have been in successful operation for minimum one year as on 06.08.2018.
2.0	The supplier has to submit following supporting documents meeting above mentioned pre-qualifying requirement Copy of minimum one (1) performance certificate in English from end user along with copy of related Purchase Order (PO) or letter of intent (LOI) or letter of award (LOA) or work order (WO) in support of PQR clause mentioned at S. No. 1.0 above.
3.0	Bidder shall submit design documents to substantiate technical parameters specified in PQR, if the same is not mentioned in performance certificate/purchase order.
4.0	Minimum one (1) no. Purchase order shall be submitted which should not be more than seven (7) years old as on date of bid submission, for establishing continuity in business. This is over and above the requirement of PO mentioned at S. No. 2.0 above.
5.0	Bidder to submit all supporting documents in English. If documents submitted by bidder are in language other than English, a self-attested English translated document should also be submitted.
6.0	Notwithstanding anything stated above, BHEL reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the bidder/ collaborator to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of BHEL.
7.0	Consideration of offer shall be subject to customer's approval of bidder, if applicable.
8.0	After satisfactory fulfilment of all the above criteria/ requirement, offer shall be considered for further evaluation as per NIT and all other terms of the tender.
