Scope of Work	The scope of work shall include design, manufacture, testing at vendor's work, and supply of Knife Gate Valves as per specification.

BIDDER SHALL NOTE & COMPLY WITH BELOW POINTS:

S.NO	PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA
1.0	Financial Criteria a) Bidder (the company submitting the offer, in case it is part of group of companies) should have average minimum annual turnover of INR 4,10,000/- (or) equivalent (exchange rate will be TT selling rate of State Bank of India as on date of techno-commercial bid opening), during the last 3 (three) years(FY 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17). Bidders are required to submit Audited balance sheet and profit & loss account for the financial year mentioned above. b) In case audited financial statements have not been submitted for all the 3 years as indicated above, then the applicable audited statements submitted by the bidders against the requisite 3 (three) years, will be averaged for 3 (three) years. c) If financial statements are not required to be audited statutorily, then instead of audited financial statements, financial statements are required to be certified by chartered accountant.
2.0	Technical Criteria: Bidder shall be designer and Original Equipment Manufacturer qualified as per the Pre-qualification criteria laid down hereunder. (Traders / Authorized Dealers of valve manufacturers are not allowed to bid). Non-compliance to any of the criteria listed against the respective category will lead to disqualification of bidder for the subject tender. Qualification if Bidder is an OEM: A. The bidder should be an established manufacturer having sufficient experience in manufacture, testing and supply of Knife Gate valves as per Indian Standards or equivalent International Standards. The bidder should have successfully completed manufacturing, testing and supply of Knife Gate valves. I. Min 200 NB or higher (AND) II. Ratings of PN10 (or) PN16

	B. The Bidder should have successfully executed orders worth as below in a single or multiple purchase orders, ending on the date of techno-commercial bid opening of this tender. I. 10.9 Lakhs of Knife Gate valves/Gate valves/Sluice gates in the last one Year with at least one order for Knife Gate valves satisfying clauses A above. (OR) II. 13.62 Lakhs of Knife Gate valves/Gate valves/Sluice gates in the last two years with at least one order for Knife Gate valves satisfying clauses A above. (OR) III. 16.34 Lakhs of Knife Gate valves/Gate valves/Sluice gates in the last three years with at least one order for Knife Gate valves satisfying clauses A. C. The Bidder shall submit PO copies of the jobs completed fulfilling the criteria indicated under clause B above.
	ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS
3.0	Bidder should have valid PAN number allotted by Govt. of India. Relevant supporting document shall be submitted (PAN copy).
3.1	Bidders are required to furnish the GSTIN no. of their firm along with supporting documents. HSN Codes are as under: 1. HSN Code for Knife Gate Valve: 84818010
4.0	For Foreign vendors:
4.1	In case of bidders from outside India, in addition to documents in support of above, they shall also provide Business Information Report / Credit Rating Report incorporating the rating of the company by international credit rating agencies viz Dun & Bradstreet etc along with technical offer. Such ratings reports shall not be older than 1 year from the date of submission of offer. Agency agreement needs to be submitted by foreign bidder in case of associating with an Indian entity.
4.2	The bidder should have established office in India. Indian office shall be supported either from India or from their headquarter or manufacturing centre for design, engineering, manufacturing/assembly, testing, supply, supervision of installation. Relevant supporting documents (Organization chart, Role of Indian office etc.) Illustrating the strength of Indian office & support from headquarters shall be submitted.
4.3	Foreign bidders should comply with criteria under Sl. no 1.0 & 2.0

NOTES

A	Bidder shall submit requisite documents, to comply with aforesaid criteria, properly indexed, along with offer.
B	After satisfactory fulfilment of all the above criteria/ requirement, offer shall be considered for further evaluation as per NIT and all other terms of the tender.

C	Bidder(s) already registered with BHEL other units or BHEL-PE&SD for subject package, also need to submit credentials for criteria indicated in sl. no. '1.0' '2.0' above. Also, they must submit the relevant documents as the proof of their registration with BHEL-other units for subject package.
D	Certificate of incorporation from the registrar of companies/ partnership deed/ proprietorship documents etc. as applicable.
E	Bidders should have technological capability for communication/transmit through electronic media/Reverse Auction process.
F	Mere submission of above documents does not entitle bidders for enlistment or issue of tenders and same shall be subject to BHEL scrutiny and/ or physical survey of facilities.
G	Consideration of offer will be subject to our end customer's approval of bidder.
H	The bidder should not have been under suspension for business / blacklisted by any of the BHEL units.
