PREAMBLE OF PRICE BID

1.0 This Price Bid consists of Three Schedule:

1.1 Schedule A

Schedule A consists of One Annexure:

Total price of the package consisting of **Annexure I** to be quoted by the bidders which shall form the basis for comparison for deciding lowest bid. For further processing and award, total quoted amount by the L1 (lowest) bidder for the package shall be used for deriving individual item rate by BHEL based on % (percentage) weightage specified at Annexure I of Price Schedule.

1.2 Schedule B

It consists of details of free issue materials by BHEL.

1.3 Schedule C

It consists of details of tools & tackles provided by BHEL either on higher basis or on free of cost basis which are mentioned in price bid.

2.0 The work to be carried out under the contract shall, except as otherwise provided in tender conditions, include all labour, materials, tools, plant, equipment, and transport which may be required in preparation of and for full & entire execution and completion of the Works. The descriptions given in the Schedule of Quantities shall, unless otherwise stated, be held to include waste on materials, carriage and cartage, carrying in return of empties, hoisting, setting, fitting and fixing in position and all other labours necessary in and for the full and entire execution and completion as aforesaid in accordance with good practice and recognized principles as laid down in Technical Specification & elsewhere in Tender Specification.

3.0 The price bid should not contain any condition. Conditional price Bids shall be summarily rejected.

4.0 The bidder should not leave any column blank in Price Schedules.

5.0 Price Quoted shall include all taxes, & duties except **GST**.

6.0 Unless otherwise specified in the items involving cement, reinforcement steel or structural steel, these items shall be issued free of cost by BHEL.

Note:-1 Contractor shall ensure payment of minimum wages prescribed by BHEL (which is inclusive of statutory minimum wages of MP govt. and additional wages of BHEL) as applicable from time to time (vide Annexure-"X" attached herewith) in the presence of authorized representative of BHEL and maintain proper records of their timely disbursement. These records need to be preserved for a period of at least 3 years and should be made available even after the contract is over for any verification by the statutory authorities/BHEL authorities.

2 Special care shall be taken in such contract of 'housekeeping and disposal of scrap/ waste materials ' for avoidance of duplicity of measurements in view of other such contemporary contracts run by various manufacturing blocks and other departments of BHEL, Bhopal.

3 The contractor shall ensure that the drivers that are deployed in the work are medically fit and holder of valid driving licence to operate these machines/vehicles. The vehicles engaged in the work shall have all valid RTO papers such as registration, insurance etc.

Price Schedule A - Annexure: II

Penalty / Recovery Clause

Name of work : Hiring of loading auto for disposal of scrap/waste materials from various locations inside factory area..

- 1 The loading auto shall have the container with minimum inner dimensions as L=1.50 m, W=1.40 m, H=1.20 m) The loading auto shall be reported to the site of work/ engineer- in-charge by 8.30 AM every day failing which a penalty for reporting late shall be imposed on the contractor in proportionate hourly basis.
- 2 All repair work to the loading auto shall be in the contractor's scope. To minimise the down time, the contractor shall keep in his custody sufficient spares/components. If the services are not restored within 2 hours, penalty for excess break-down period beyond 2 hours shall be imposed on the contractor in proportionate hourly basis @ 1.50 times the awarded rate provided the work also suffers due to the afore-said excess down time.
It is preferable that the contractor deploys a replacement vehicle immediately to minimise the down time so that the disposal activity does not suffer.
- 3 The loading auto shall perform trips every day as per the instructions of engineer-in-charge. If the vehicle remains idle unnecessarily and contrary to the instruction of Engineer-in-charge, causing the work to suffer, penalty for such idle time shall be imposed on the contractor in proportionate hourly basis @ 1.50 times the awarded rate as per the discretion of Engineer-in charge.
- 4 Minimum 05 number of loading auto is envisaged to be deployed by the contractor under this works contract. Short fall in deployment of loading auto (Less than 05 Nos per day) as envisaged shall attract penalty for each shortfall @ 1.25 times the hire charges of one loading auto including associated manpower per day as per contract, provided the work suffers on this count as certified by the Engineer-in-charge. However, such penalty shall not be levied if the work does not suffer on account of shortfall in deployment of loading auto per day as certified by Engineer-in-charge and payment for such shortfall shall not be made.
- 5 If helper is not provided with loading auto as specified and the department still allows engagement of loading auto at work, deductions for each shortfall in number of helper shall be effected/done @ 1.25 time the prevalent rate. BHEL's prescribed daily wages rate for USW inclusive of statutory provisions like PF , ESI & Bonus and 05 % profit charges on the basic rate per day of one Unskilled Worker.
- 6 Loading auto without driver shall not be considered for deployment under any circumstance by the department.

Scope of work

Name of work: - Hiring of loading auto for disposal of scrap/waste materials from various locations inside factory area.

The scope of work shall broadly, include but not be limited to the following activities. :-

- 1 Deployment of loading auto(s) with manpower for collection and segregation of scrap/waste materials from various locations inside factory area.
- 2 Disposal of segregated scrap/ waste materials to designated locations/scrap yard within factory area including loading, unloading and stacking as instructed by Engineer-in-charge.

The scope shall include all associated & enabling works including the cost of labour, tools & tackles except for those to be provided by BHEL free of cost or on chargeable basis as mentioned in the schedule.
