1. Introduction:

BHEL is the largest engineering and manufacturing enterprise in India in the energy related / infrastructure sector, today. BHEL manufactures over 180 products under 30 major product groups and caters to core sectors of the Indian Economy viz., Power Generation & Transmission, Industry, Transportation, Telecommunication, Renewable Energy, etc. The wide network of BHEL's 17 manufacturing divisions, four Power Sector regional centers, over 100 project sites, eight service centers and 18 regional offices, enables the Company to promptly serve its customers and provide them with suitable products, Systems and services. 2. Requirement:

Supply & Installation of Air Filter System at BHEL, CDT, HRDI Building, Plot No. 25, Sector 16A, Noida - 201301 U.P.

3. Eligibility Criteria:

3.1 The bidder should be either the OEM or an authorized partner of the OEM. Documentary proof to be submitted.

3.2 The bidder should be a registered company in India under Indian Companies Act 1956/2013. Documentary proof to be submitted.

3.3 The bidder should have at least one order of minimum Rs.4 lakhs for supply of Air filter during the last 7 years ending 31.10.2016.

Or

At least two orders of supply of Air filter, each of value Rs 2.5 lakhs during the last 7 years ending 31.10.2016.

Or

At least 3 orders of supply of Air filter, each of value Rs 2 lakhs during the last 7 years ending 31.10.2016.

Order copy to be submitted.

3.4 The bidder should have its own office & service centre in Delhi / NCR. Bidder needs to submit proof for the same.

5. Special Terms and Conditions

5.1 Location details:

Vendors are requested to visit above location for better understanding of scope of work before submission of technical and financial offers.

5.2 Scope of Work:

- 5.2.1 Supply & installation of the Air Filter at BHEL site as per clause 5.1.
- 5.2.2 Maintenance and repair of Air filter during the warranty and AMC period.
- 5.2.3 Replacement of any faulty spare parts with new ones during the warranty and AMC period.

5.3 Technical Specifications & Requirements:

As per Annexure-I

5.4 Warranty and Annual Maintenance Contract:

- 5.4.1 The vendor should provide OEM warranty support for a minimum period of one year from the date of acceptance at BHEL CDT Noida.
- 5.4.2 The vendor shall be providing AMC Services for the unit for 2 Years after the expiry of warranty period of one year. During AMC Period vendor will be responsible for:
 - Checking the motors and starter/contactors.
 - Checking the operation & proper functioning of controls.
 - Inspection & cleaning the air filters.
 - Attend to service call for the trouble diagnosis / break down of the unit.
 - Quarterly media sampling.
- 5.4.3 The vendor should clearly provide customer care no. and escalation matrix.

5.5 Delivery & Installation Period:

Two (2) months from date of issue of Purchase order by BHEL.

5.6 Penalty for LD:

If the successful vendor fails to complete the delivery and execution within 2 months after acceptance of order, a penalty of 0.5% per week (or part thereof) subject to maximum of 10% of the total order value for the delay will be charged. This penalty will be deducted from the amount payable to the successful vendor after completion of work.

5.7 Warranty Start Date:

The warranty shall be deemed to start from the date of successfully installation of the Air Filter. An installation report may be signed by BHEL official.

5.8 Service Level Agreement (SLA):

Response Time:

Vendor shall ensure that a complaint once registered is attended to within one business day and resolved within maximum 2 business days.

Penalty for SLA Non-Conformance:

If a complaint is not resolved within two business days, then the deduction for downtime after two business days will be Rs.100 per day. Less or equal to 6 hrs will be rounded down and more than 6 hours will be rounded up to a full day. The maximum deduction is limited to the 10% of the order value which will be deducted from the remaining payment or from the BG submitted.

5.9 Terms of Payment:

- a) 90% of purchase value on successful installation as per scope of work within 45 days of submission of invoices in triplicate.
- b) Remaining 10% of purchase value after one year or on submission of BG equivalent to 10% of purchase value with a validity of one year plus 3 months.
- c) AMC Payment shall be on quarterly deferred basis i.e. payment for AMC shall be released at the end of each quarter.

6. General Terms and Conditions

6.1 Ethical Standard:

Bidders are expected to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of this Contract. In pursuit of this policy, the Purchaser will reject a proposal for award if it finds out that the Bidder being considered for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below are defined as follows:

- a) **“Corrupt practice”** means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action in the procurement process or in Contract execution; and
- b) **“Fraudulent practice”** means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process including collusive practices designed to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels to deprive the Purchaser of the benefits of competition;

By signing the Bid Forwarding Letter, the Bidder represents that for the software it supplies, it is the owner of the Intellectual Property Rights in the software. Willful misrepresentation of these facts shall be considered a fraudulent practice without prejudice to other remedies that the Purchaser may take.

6.2 Integrity Pact: (Not Applicable)

The bidder shall sign an Integrity Pact, to comply with the requirements of the Transparency International Limited (TIL) and the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) guidelines to ensure an ethical and corruption-free business environment.

6.3 Non-Disclosure Agreement:

The bidder shall sign a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) with BHEL. By signing the NDA, the bidder agrees not to disclose any confidential information, business or proprietary, as covered by the agreement. The proforma for the Non-Disclosure Agreement is attached as **Annexure-V**.

6.4 Cost of Bidding:

The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and the Purchaser will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs.

6.5 Procedure for Submission & Opening of Bids:

Bids shall be accepted by the official inviting the tenders, in two parts, as described below, on or before the due date & time indicated in the Tender Notice.

Part-I : Techno-Commercial Bid

This part shall consist of the following:

- 1) Bounded volume of:

Technical offer/details including literature/leaflets with page no. marked on all pages. The bidder can offer only as per technical specifications of the equipment. BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject the technical offer. Price bids of only techno-commercially short listed vendors will be opened.

- i. Enclosures as defined in checklist of enclosures.
- ii. Make & mode offered as per format enclosed as Annexure-II.
- iii. Checklist of PRICE BID (Unpriced Copy) as per format enclosed as Annexure-III.
- iv. No Deviation Certificate as per format enclosed as Annexure-IV.
- v. A copy of complete RFP where each page is signed & stamped by the bidder.

Part-II : Price Bid

Price bid containing PRICES only is to be submitted (in the Price Schedule format enclosed as Annexure-III only). Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only. Bidder shall give details of Direct Applicable Taxes (between Bidder & BHEL as asked in the Price Bid Format) clearly. Any changes in these Direct Applicable Tax rates during the complete contract period will only be payable as per actuals, subject to submission of

documentary evidence. Any other taxes, duties, levies and charges assessed on the bidder by local, national or any statutory authorities will not be payable by BHEL.

Price Bid should not contain any technical details and/or Commercial Terms & Conditions as the same are supposed to be contained in PART-I only, so that the same can be evaluated before opening of Price Bid(s).

6.6 Marking On Envelope

Part-I and Part-II offers shall be submitted in two separate sealed envelopes with bidder's distinctive SEAL and super-scribed as follows:

Part-I : 1. Tender Enquiry No. and Its Description

2. Due Date of Opening

3. "Techno-Commercial Bid".

Part-II : 1. Tender Enquiry No. and Its Description

2. Due Date of Opening

3. "Price Bid" as per enclosed Format.

Un-sealed envelopes or envelopes not super-scribed as above may not be accepted/considered.

6.7 Bid Submission

6.7.2 Bids can also be delivered in person in the tender box placed at CDT, Noida.

6.7.3 Bids submitted by post shall be sent by "REGISTERED POST" only and shall be posted with due allowance for any postal delay.

6.8 Bid Opening

6.8.1 PART-I (Techno-commercial Bid) may be opened on the due date and time as specified in the Enquiry Letter, in the presence of bidders who may like to attend. Part-II (Price Bid) shall be opened subsequently. However, Purchaser reserves the right to open both the parts simultaneously i.e. Part-I and Part-II together.

6.8.2 In case of public opening, date and time of Price Bid (Part-II) opening shall be intimated to the technically and commercially acceptable bidders only.

6.8.3 Purchaser also reserves the right to open the earlier i.e. superseded price bids, if any, submitted by the bidder(s), if required.

- 6.8.4 No correspondence shall be entertained from the bidders after the opening of Price Bid(s).
- 6.8.5 Standard pre-printed conditions of the bidders attached to the offer will not be accepted and only those mentioned in the body of his offer will be considered.
- 6.8.6 Unsolicited bids shall not be entertained. Unsolicited revised Price Bids also, shall not be entertained at any stage of the tendering process and will lead to automatic disqualification of the party's bid.
- 6.8.7 No Literature, Pamphlets other than what is specified is to be enclosed. All such enclosures shall be considered as unread and also will not be considered as part of the quotation.
- 6.8.8 Manufacturer's name, trade Mark or Patent No., if any, should be specified.
- 6.8.9 Purchaser reserves the right to negotiate the tender, if required.

6.9 Validity of Offer

Offer shall be kept valid for FOUR months from the due date of tender opening (Part-I) for Purchaser acceptance.

6.10 Deviations

Bids shall be submitted strictly in accordance with the requirements and terms & conditions of the Tender Enquiry. Vendors have to submit a "No Deviation Certificate" in Part-I of the offer as per **Annexure-IV**.

Technical & Commercial - No deviation is acceptable.

6.11 Language of the Bid & Corrections

- 6.11.1 The bidder shall quote the rates in Hindi/English language and international numerals only. The metric system of units shall be used, for the purpose of tender.
- 6.11.2 Bidder shall fill the tender documents as per formats enclosed in this tender enquiry. All entries and signatures in the bid shall be in BLUE/BLACK INK only. Each page of the bid shall be signed and stamped using official seal of the company by the bidder.
- 6.11.3 All entries shall be filled in neat and legible handwriting. No over-writings, erasures and corrections are permitted and may render such bids liable for rejection.
- 6.11.4 However, if any cancellations, corrections and insertions are in the bid, the same shall be duly attested by the bidder.

6.12 Rejection of Bid and Other Conditions

- 6.12.1 Any format not properly filled, partially filled or not filled will make the bid liable for rejection. Bidders are requested to note that all columns, rows and spaces provided to fill up the data must be filled with relevant data without fail. In case any bidder

fails to do so or fills up irrelevant data, BHEL is not bound to seek clarifications on such items and will be free to reject the tender summarily.

6.12.2 No change in specifications, clauses of contract, Terms and Conditions, etc. shall be entertained by BHEL under any circumstances.

6.12.3 Canvassing in any way concerning this tender, wrong declaration, incorrect information, misleading or incorrect certifications, etc. shall make the Bidder debarred to participate in this tender and also for a further period of 3 years in any tender of any of the BHEL units.

6.12.4 The acceptance of bid will rest with the Purchaser and does not bind him to accept the lowest or any bid. The Purchaser reserves to itself, full rights for the following without assigning any reasons, whatsoever:

a) to reject any or all the bids.

b) to increase or decrease the quantities.

6.12.5 Late Bids: Any proposal received by BHEL after the deadline for submission of proposal shall be summarily rejected and returned unopened to the bidder.

6.12.6 The offer is liable to be rejected, if it is found after the Price Bid Opening that the Checklist of Price Bid submitted by the bidder, as a part of Part-I offer, is different from the actual Price Bid.

6.12.7 If the bidder deliberately gives wrong information in his bid, Purchaser reserves the right to reject such a bid at any stage or to cancel the Order/Contract, if awarded and forfeit the EMD/ security deposit/ Performance Bank Guarantee, if any.

6.12.8 If the Prices/Rates of one or more of the enquired equipment have not been quoted, the offer is liable to be rejected.

6.12.9 Non-compliance with any of the requirements and instructions of the Tender Enquiry may result in the rejection of the bid.

6.13 Clarification on Bidding Documents:

The Bidder is expected to carefully go through this Tender Document and understand the functional requirements thoroughly before submitting their offer. All legitimate queries and clarifications regarding this tender must be submitted in writing to the undersigned and to the authorized representatives (shivali@bhel.in/ ajay@bhel.in) by **16.11.2016**. BHEL will not entertain or respond to bidders' queries received after **16.11.2016**.

6.14 Amendment of Bidding Documents:

The Purchaser may at its sole discretion amend the Bidding Documents at any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids. However, in case of such amendment, the bid submission date may be extended at the discretion of the purchaser.

Amendments made prior to submission of bid will be provided in the form of Addenda / Corrigendum to the Bidding Documents and will be posted on the BHEL website

(<http://www.bhel.com>) in Tender Notification section under the original tender enquiry number.

6.15 Evaluation and Comparison of Bids:

- 6.15.1 Total / Gross Total of Prices should be indicated both in words as well as in figures. If there is a difference between price quoted in words and figures or if there is any other price discrepancy, higher value(s) will be considered for evaluation and lower values will be considered for ordering.
- 6.15.2 Though offer of higher warranty/configuration/rating, than what is required as per tender specifications, may be accepted, no extra weightage or preference will be given for the same.
- 6.15.3 Prices of optional items, if any, shall also be considered for Price evaluation and comparison, unless stated otherwise.
- 6.15.4 Purchase preference would be extended to Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSE's). Accordingly, where all things being equal, purchase preference will be granted to the CPSE's at the lowest valid price bid (L1). This preference would be available to CPSE's provided there is valid Office memorandum to this effect from the concerned Ministry.
- 6.15.5 After finalizing the techno-commercial offers, BHEL may adopt Reverse Auction process for arriving at the lowest price offer. BHEL will also claim depreciation as per provisions of the Income Tax Act.
- 6.15.6 The Purchaser will evaluate and compare the bids that have been determined to be substantially responsive. The bidding evaluation is based on L1 criteria. Further the tender is NOT divisible. The evaluation of responsive bids shall be done in 3 stages:

Stage-I: Evaluation of Response To Eligibility Criteria:

These are mandatory requirements to be met by the Bidder. Only those Bidders who meet all the requirements as per eligibility criteria shall be considered for stage II evaluation.

Stage-II: Evaluation of Technical & Commercial Bids:

This shall be the second stage of the evaluation by the Purchaser. Only those Bidders who adhere to the purchaser's technical and commercial requirements shall be considered for next stage of evaluation.

Commercial and Technical bid of the vendor shall be opened and evaluated for acceptability of commercial terms, deviations and technical suitability. The Bidders should meet the commercial conditions as defined in the bidding documents.

After the evaluation of commercial conditions, the technical bids submitted by the bidders will be evaluated. During the Technical Evaluation of the bid, the purchaser may ask for additional information / resources to validate the bid. These may include technical documents / white papers from OEM or third party, references,

demonstration of a proof of concept or solution, visit to supplier's lab or their clients reference site, etc.

Stage –III: Evaluation of the Price Bid:

The price bids of only those bidders will be opened who will have qualified in the Techno-Commercial evaluation. The order will be placed on L1 bidder considering following:

- i. Total cash outflow including duties, taxes, warranty & support for the entire contract period.
- ii. The bid having the least total cash outflow will be considered L1 bidder. Evaluation of L1 ranking will be based on net of CENVAT/VAT basis, if any. The L1 Bidder shall be eligible for award of contract.

6.16 Security Deposit

6.16.1 The security Deposit should be submitted before the start of AMC period. The total amount of Security Deposit will be 5% of the total AMC value for 2 years.

6.16.2 Security Deposit may be furnished in any one of the following forms:

6.16.2.1 Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)

6.16.2.2 Local cheques of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand

6.16.2.3 Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL

6.16.2.4 Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The Bank Guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL

6.16.2.5 Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Contractor, a/c BHEL)

6.16.2.6 Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL)

(Note: BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith)

6.16.3 At least 50% of the required Security Deposit, including the EMD, would be collected before start of the work. Balance of the Security Deposit can be collected by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the Contractor till the total amount of the required Security Deposit is collected.

If the value of work done at any time exceeds the contract value, the amount of Security Deposit shall be correspondingly enhanced and the additional Security Deposit shall be immediately deposited by the Contractor or recovered from payment/s due to the Contractor.

The recoveries made from running bills (cash deduction towards balance SD amount) can be released against submission of equivalent Bank Guarantee in acceptable form, but only once, before completion of work, with the approval of the authority competent to award the work.

6.16.4 The Security Deposit shall not carry any interest.

6.16.5 The validity of Bank Guarantees towards Security Deposit shall be initially up to the complete AMC period + 3 months, and the same shall be kept valid by proper renewal till the acceptance of Final Bills of the Contractor, by BHEL.

6.16.6 BHEL reserves the right of forfeiture of Security Deposit in addition to other claims and penalties in the event of the Contractor's failure to fulfil any of the contractual obligations or in the event of termination of contract as per terms and conditions of contract. BHEL reserves the right to set off the Security Deposit against any claims of other contracts with BHEL.

6.17 Return Of Security Deposit

Security Deposit shall be refunded/Bank Guarantee(s) released to the Contractor along with the „Final Bill“ after deducting all expenses / other amounts due to BHEL under the contract / other contracts entered into with them by BHEL.

6.18 Bank Guarantees

Where ever Bank Guarantees are to be furnished / submitted by the contractor, the following shall be complied with

6.18.1 Bank Guarantees shall be from Scheduled Banks / Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act.

6.18.2 The Bank Guarantees shall be as per prescribed formats.

6.18.3 It is the responsibility of the bidder to get the Bank Guarantees revalidated/extended for the required period (subject to a minimum period of six months), as per the advice of BHEL executive. BHEL shall not be liable for issue of any reminders regarding expiry of the Bank Guarantees.

6.18.4 In case extension / further extensions of any Bank Guarantees are not required, the bidders shall ensure that the same is explicitly endorsed by the BHEL executive and submitted to the issuing official of the LOI/LOA.

6.18.5 In case the Bank Guarantees are not extended before the expiry date, BHEL reserves the right to invoke the same by informing the concerned Bank in writing, without any advance notice/communication to the concerned bidder.

6.18.6 Bidders to note that any corrections to Bank Guarantees shall be done by the issuing Bank, only through an amendment in an appropriate non judicial stamp paper.

6.18.7 The Original Bank Guarantee shall be sent directly by the Bank to BHEL under Registered Post Acknowledgement Due), addressed to the Subcontracting Department of the respective Region.

6.19 Taxes:

6.20 Purchaser's Right to accept or Reject any or all Bids:

6.21 Exclusions:

In the event of any such claims being made against the Purchaser, Purchaser will inform the Vendor who shall at his own cost either settle any such dispute or conduct any litigation that may arise there from.

6.30 Merger & Acquisition:

In case of merger / acquisition of the bidder / OEM during the contract period, all commitments and liabilities with respect to this contract will pass on to the acquiring entity.

6.31 Sub-Contracting:

Order / contract or any part thereof shall not be sub-contracted, assigned or otherwise transferred to any third party without prior written consent of the Purchaser.
