



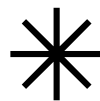

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (SCC) FOR TRANSPORTATION OF CONSIGNMENTS BY TRUCKS (OUTGOING FROM BHEL-BHOPAL TO ANYWHERE IN INDIA)

S-1.0 SCOPE OF WORK AND PQRC

This transportation contract will cover transportation of outgoing consignments of electrical equipment, plant & machinery and any other items (Goods upto 15 MT including ODC Consignments where dimensions of height & width are greater than as categories defined in Clause S-2.0)) by trucks such as LCV (Light Commercial Vehicle; old name MINI) , HCV (Heavy Commercial Vehicle ; old name SUPER MINI) , TRUCK (old name NORMAL), MAV (Multi-Axle Vehicle ; old name TAURUS), OBT (Open Body Truck) etc. from BHEL-Bhopal to various destinations located anywhere in India . Heavy trucks under scope of this contract would cover non-articulated type trucks having 3 or more axles.

- The scope includes Transportation of goods from BHEL- Bhopal to other manufacturing units of BHEL / service stations / Vendor Works / subcontractors / Airports / Sea Ports / clearing go-downs / various sites / North –Eastern states / all hilly / mountaineous areas etc. within India by Road .
- Jobs against specific project based contract, or contracts to be awarded on a different class of trucks transportation for development / establishment of new parties are excluded from the scope.

S-1.1 PRE – QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS & ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (PQR & EC)

All tenderers shall ensure to comply with the PQR & EC Check -List as per **ANNEXURE-I** to the full extent.

- a) **IBA** : Valid IBA (Indian Banker’s Association) recommendation certificate as on the date of tender opening.
- b) **VEHICLE** : Ownership of a fleet of **minimum twenty (20) trucks registered exclusively in the transporter’s name** duly substantiated by supporting documents for registration and other particulars . In case of Rate Contract , it will be the transporter’s responsibility to deploy proper vehicles to transport consignments covered under the scope of work suiting the weight and dimensions ensuring the load bearing capacity as per Motor Vehicle Act / Rules stipulated by Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRTH).
- c) **FINANCIAL HEALTH** : A minimum of average annual turnover (business from transportation work) of **Rs.41.56 Lakhs** for the last 3 years ending 2017-18. At least 1 year profit during last 3 years and overall positive net worth as on 31.03.2018. The statement as per Annexure-I is to be substantiated with copy of Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Accounts statement for each year .
- d) **BRANCHES** : A minimum of **75 (seventy-five) operative branches / authorised franchise offices** for delivery / collection of consignments, covering **atleast 10 (ten) states in India**. The branch / authorised franchise details shall be a printed booklet giving the address, contact person and phone numbers of these branches / authorised franchise.



S-2.0 VEHICLES CATEGORIZATION :

Standard (Non-ODC) consignments having dimensions (maximum) and / or weight (maximum) shall be categorized as follows :

- 2.1 For classifying a truck as Open-body, dismantling of both sides of the truck body will be essential, justifying the width of the consignment.
- 2.2 Width is the main criteria for open-body truck irrespective of the weight of consignment to be despatched and the same will be considered as full truck load (FTL).
- 2.3 In no case freight charges for lower category vehicle will be more than FTL freight charges for the next higher category of vehicle. Prior permission of BHEL will be required (with recorded reason) in case a higher category vehicle is to be engaged.
- 2.4 The “Smalls / Part-load” will be treated upto 1000 Kg (if not qualifying for Full Truck Load volumetrically)
- 2.5 If due to exceptional circumstances, the actual weight carried by a vehicle is more than the normal weight permitted for that type of vehicle, pro-rata payment of freight shall be made depending upon the actual weight or size of the consignment.
- 2.6 Models like Tata 1109 or Eischer 1110 or equivalent will also be classified under Normal Category.

S-3.0 Full Truck Load (FTL) Certification for all category

For the purpose of determining full truck load for any category of vehicle of the consignment due to reasons other than weight / volume (eg. urgency etc.) authorization by representative of Logistics or concerned product commercial department / BHEL Sister unit justifying the reason shall be required.

In case, such consignment are not delivered within the normal transit time as mentioned in the clause 14 & 15 of GCC (Part-II) plus 2(two) day's grace period, the freight bills of such dispatches will attract penalty of 2 % for the first week, 3% for the second week and 5% for subsequent weeks-delay subject to maximum of 25% (1 week = 7 days).

S-4.0 SMALLS CONSIGNMENTS

- 4.1 Consignments upto a weight of 1000 Kg.(if not qualifying for FTL volumetrically).
- 4.2 Door delivery charges shall be paid @ Rs.1000/- per MT or part thereof.
- 4.3 Minimum charges for smalls consignment shall be Rs.200/-
- 4.4 Transporters should ensure quick delivery at least upto their own go-down.

S-5.0 MINIMUM CHARGEABLE DISTANCE shall be 100Km.



S-6.0 OVER DIMENSION CONSIGNMENT (ODC) CHARGES

Consignment having dimensions exceeding the standard length, width or height mentioned at S-2.0 shall be treated as ODC consignment. In respect of such consignments ODC charges on proportional basis over the standard length and height will be payable on pro-rata basis. However, ODC charges shall be permitted in one dimension only, whichever is having higher value.

S-7.0 HILLY / MOUNTAINOUS REGION CHARGES

For journey to / from / via / through hilly regions (destinations beyond Pathankot for Jammu & Kashmir , Rishikesh / Kashipur / Mohand in Uttarakhand and Parwanoo / Kiratpur in Himachal Pradesh) or any hilly regions in any part of the country as identified on case to case basis with the approval of BHEL, an additional 15% freight shall be paid over & above the applicable freight for the total journey.

S-8.0 DIFFICULT TERRAIN (NORTH-EASTERN, ODISHA & CHHATTISGARH STATE) CHARGES

For journey to / from / via / through North-Eastern states (destinations beyond Siliguri in North Eastern Sector) , an additional 60% freight over & above the basic freight for the total journey shall be paid.

For journey to / from / via / through Odisha State (Entire districts) and Chhattisgarh State (only Kanker , Bastar & Surajpur districts) an additional 20% freight over & above the basic freight for the total journey shall be paid .

However, no additional hilly region charges are payable in such cases.

S-9.0 CHARGES FOR SPECIAL DESTINATIONS:

In case , transporters are required to deliver the material within 500 Km. range from BHEL Bhopal to Anywhere and there is a change of State in between , an additional 25% freight charges over & above the basic freight for the total journey will be paid.

S-10.0 INCENTIVE

If the consignments are delivered in good condition before the normal transit time as mentioned in Cl.No.14.0 & 15.0 of GCC (Part-II) , a lumpsum amount shall be paid @ Rs.1000/- per day saved in transit subject to maximum 10% of freight bill.

S-11.0 SCHEDULE OF RATES:

The tenderer shall quote rates in the “**Schedule of Rates (Annexure-II)**” for the freight for **all categories / slabs**, for transportation to destinations “**upto 500 Km (Group-1)**” and “**above 500 Km (Group-2)**”. Tenderers are required to quote rates for all variants given in the Rate Schedule.

S-11.1 Failure to strictly adhere to above would result in rejection of the bid.

S-11.2 In case of failure to ensure compliance of any or all of the GCC and SCC, BHEL reserves the right to make alternative arrangements for hiring vehicles at transporter’s risk & cost, besides suspending/reducing/stopping further business.

S-12.0 BUSINESS VOLUME:

12.1 The Estimated Volume of Consignments, expected to be dispatched during the one year (12 months) period of operation of the rate contract , will be tentatively as per the details given in Annexure-II (in terms of Business Quantity) and may vary by +/- 15%.



- 12.2 The transporters shall lay no claim whatsoever on BHEL if no fixed volume of work is given to them during the currency of the contract.

S-13.0 EVALUATION & BUSINESS DISTRIBUTION:

- 13.1 The Business Quantity (BQ) is given in schedule of rates (Annexure-II) for Group-1 & Group-2 separately.
- 13.2 Transporters are required to quote for all categories groupwise , otherwise their tender will not be considered.
- 13.3 “ Total quoted business value” of all categories shall be calculated by multiplication of rates and BQ of all categories, followed by summation of such value for all categories of that group, which will be the basis for overall unique position of bidders, low to high L1, L2, L3 onwards in that group. Picked-up L1 rates for each category groupwise, shall be offered to all transporters for acceptance in that particular category.
- 13.4 Business award shall be done at equated rates only based on picked up L1 rates.
- 13.5 Business is proposed to be distributed on maximum 08 (Eight) parties for both slab of transportation i.e. distance “upto 500 Km” (Group-1) & “above 500 Km” (Group -2) subject to acceptance of the L1 rates. The business percentage distribution shall be as per Cl. No. 10.0 of GCC (Part-II).
- 13.6 However, in case of a tie in the position / ranking of two or more parties, their relative position would be decided on the basis of their average audited turnover of last 3 (three) years. (In such case transporter will be asked to submit the same).
- 13.7 In an eventuality , the rate contract being finalized on less than the required number of transporter, the balance volume of business would be distributed on pro-rata basis among eligible transporters. BHEL may reschedule the volume of business and performance security deposit amount accordingly to eligible transporters on pro-rata basis.

S-14.0 ESCORT / TRACKING OF VEHICLE

- 14.1 If BHEL intends to depute an escort for certain important consignment, the transporter should allow him to travel in the same vehicle upto the destination free of cost.
- 14.2 Transporter shall install / permit installation of vehicle tracking system (VTS) on the transport vehicle and enable it (allow connecting with vehicle battery). In case the device is owned by BHEL, transporter will be responsible for its safe custody during his possession. In case of any loss on account of damage to the device, cost of device will be recovered from the transporter.
- 14.3 As and when requested by BHEL, transporter will provide mobile phone in working condition with trucks in order to have communication with the vehicle driver and shall e-mail/phone for the status of urgent and critical items to BHEL on daily basis.

S-15.0 PERFORMANCE REVIEW:

- 15.1 The Performance of transporters shall be reviewed periodically. Allotment of workload and continuance in contract will be related to performance.



15.2 In case the performance is not found upto the mark, BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract without any further reference.

S-16.0 In Case of failure to ensure compliance of any or all of the preceding clauses, BHEL reserves the right to make alternative arrangements for hiring vehicles from open market, at transporter's risk & cost.

S-17.0 INTEGRITY PACT : As per GCC Clause No.34.0

All bidders must submit duly signed integrity pact in the document attached as **Annexure-C (Ref:AA:SSP:IP Dted 16.07.2018) as part of Tender Documents .**

Integrity Pact (IP)

(a) IP is a tool to ensure that activities and transactions between the Company and its Bidders/ Contractors are handled in a fair, transparent and corruption free manner. Following Independent External Monitors (IEMs) on the present panel have been appointed by BHEL with the approval of CVC to oversee implementation of IP in BHEL.

Only those bidders who have entered into such an IP with BHEL would be competent to participate in the bidding. In other words, entering into this Pact would be a preliminary qualification.

(c) Please refer Section-8 of IP (Annexure-C) for Role and Responsibilities of IEMs. In case of any complaint arising out of the tendering process, the matter may be referred to any of the above IEMs . All correspondence with the IEMs shall be done through email only.
