

1. Enquiry is floated through E-procurement system and hence Offer has to be submitted through EPS portal only (<https://bheleps.buyjunction.in>).

4. **Proposed delivery plan- For Bipole-1: July'2018, For Bipole-2: Oct'2018 (Quantity wise break-up for bipole-1 and bipole-2 is enclosed).** However, vendor has to quote their best possible delivery plan in activity schedule to meet the tender's delivery requirement. In case, BHEL's delivery requirement is not met by vendor(s), then a chance may be given to all such vendors to review their quoted delivery schedule in line with BHEL's delivery requirement. However, if vendor fails to meet the requisite delivery plan, then BHEL reserves the right not to consider the offer of such vendor(s).
5. **PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT-**
 - A) Technical QR:** The manufacturer whose Disconnecter /Isolator are offered should have manufactured and type tested as per relevant standards and from manufacturers whose similar equipment for similar applications have been in service for at least 2 (two) years as on the original schedule date for the dead line for submission of first stage bid is 19-05-2015.
 - B) Commercial QR:** Bidder should be approved by POWERGRID. In case Bidder is not already approved, Bidder is required to obtain POWERGRID approval before technical bid is opened. The vendor will be required to take POWERGRID approval (independent from BHEL) based on the above assessment report, to be considered for further tendering process. Any cost incurred on account of a physical assessment conducted by POWERGRID, if required, will be borne by the vendor only. For information of vendors, following documents are required by Powergrid for vendor approval:
 1. Registration / License of the works
 2. Organization chart with name and qualification of key persons.
 3. List of Plant and Machinery.
 4. List of testing equipment with their calibration status.
 5. List of Raw material, bought out items with sourcing details.
 6. List of out-sourced services with sourcing details.
 7. List of supply in last three years.
 8. Third party approval, if any (viz. ISO, BIS).
 9. Pollution clearance wherever applicable.
 10. Energy Conservation and Efficiency report.
(Applicable to industries having contract load more than 100 KVA)
 11. Formats for RM, in process and acceptance testing.
 12. Type test approvals conducted in last 5 years, if applicable.
 13. Performance Certificates from Customers.
 14. Photographs of factory, plant and machinery & testing facilities.

If the Vendor is unable to get the approval from POWERGRID, they will be disqualified from the bidding process without further notice.

6. Acceptance of technically qualified vendor(s) is subject to final acceptance from Powergrid.
7. Reg. vendor approval at BHEL, TBG- Supplier to visit <https://supplier.bhel.in/>. for online registration at TBG.
8. Permissible Technical Deviations: No permissible Technical Deviation has been envisaged.
9. Bidder to give Bribery and corruption/confidentiality undertaking (format attached).
10. **Clause-2.4 of NIT-** In addition to this clause of GTC, following shall be noted-

Customs Duty:- a) Custom duty benefit will be available for Import content.

b) For availing custom duty benefit- Single project authority certificate (and its subsequent amendments) wherein the name of contractors/sub-contractors will be mentioned, shall be issued by POWERGRID. Based on such PAC, vendor has to take requisite certificate/license/document from concerned agency/authority to avail custom duty benefit.

c) Bidder to indicate import content (Yes/No) in unpriced bid. Amount of import content to be mentioned in price bid only.

Note- In case, bidder do not indicate/highlight- 'Yes' or 'No' in un-priced bid, then it shall be considered as 'Nil' import content.

11. **Clause-17 of GTC (Tender Evaluation)-** Evaluation shall be done site wise and accordingly separate order shall be placed for PGCIL Raigarh HVDC Terminal SS site and PGCIL Pugalur HVDC Terminal SS site.
12. **ANTI PROFITEERING CLAUSE:**
Bidder to provide the Anti-profiteering certificate under Sec 171 of the GST Act; "that the benefit of reduction in rate of tax and/or from input tax credit has been duly passed on to BHEL by way of commensurate reduction in prices.
13. Vendor to certify in the unpriced bid that they have quoted as per the specified price format of the tender, otherwise their offer shall be liable for rejection.
