

1. Enquiry is floated through E-procurement system and hence Offer has to be submitted through EPS portal only (<https://bhel.abcpurchase.com/EPROC>).

3. **Destination-** PGCIL Raigarh & Pugalur Ss
4. Bidder to comply Technical Specification given in NIT.
5. Bidder has to supply the material complying the POWERGRID equipment specification as provided by TBEM. Inspection of material will be carried out at Dealer/Trader/Manufacturer place having requisite testing facilities as per POWERGRID requirement.
6. Price bid opening of offers is subject to vendor approval from POWERGRID.
7. Make/Model offered by bidder is subject to POWERGRID approval. POWERGRID approval of make/model shall be considered as final approval.
8. Bidder is required to submit an undertaking "to address issue of warranty / after sales services of the equipment from OEM" on its letter head.
9. Project Status: Domestic. GST shall be payable as applicable. Custom Duty benefit will be available against issuance of PAC by POWERGRID.
10. **Clause-12 (Delivery Period) of GTC- shall be read as below- Delivery requirement: 31st March-2020.** Bidder shall submit best delivery plan as per enclosed activity schedule.
11. **Liquidated Damage (Clause no. 13 of GTC):** In case of delay in execution of Purchase Order beyond the contractual delivery time, an amount of 0.5% of the TOTAL PO EX-WORKS VALUE & F & I CHARGES for supply per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the TOTAL PO EX-WORKS VALUE & F & I CHARGES shall be deducted as Liquidated Damages (LD) along with applicable GST (if any) on LD. LR/GR date or Invoice date (whichever is later) shall be treated as the date of dispatch for levying LD as above. Other terms as per **General Terms and Condition** (GTC - BHEL/TBG/GTC/2016 Rev-1).
12. **Scope and Evaluation:** Supply of Battery Operated Golf kart are required at PGCIL two sub-station, i.e. at PGCIL Raigarh & Pugalur Ss. Evaluation shall be combined for all substation quantities but Purchase orders shall be placed separately for each substation, i.e. separate order for PGCIL Raigarh substation, and PGCIL Pugalur Substation.
13. **Clause No. 34 of GTC –** Not applicable.
14. **Clause No. 39 of GTC Variation of Contract Value/Quantity Variation:** Not applicable.

15. Reg. vendor approval at BHEL, TBG- Bidder to visit <https://Bidder.bhel.in/>. for online registration at TBG.

16. **Clause No. 33** for Reverse Auction of NIT shall be as follows:

“BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit ‘Process compliance form’ (to the designated service provider) as well as ‘Online sealed bid’ in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of ‘Process compliance form’ or ‘Online sealed bid’ by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with Bidders/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer.

The envelope sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.

If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with Bidders/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).”

As a reminder to the bidders, system will flash following message (in RED Color) during the course of ‘online sealed bid’: “Bidders to submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed bid already submitted to BHEL.

In addition to above RA guidelines, bidder note that

(A) In case where RA is conducted successfully Reverse auction shall be conducted as per existing procedure of BHEL. Ranking of bids shall be based on final price fed by respective bidder (including H1 bidder) in reverse auction process. If L1 bid is from a 'Local Bidder', L-1 bidder may be considered for further award of work. No other Bidder shall be invited to match price of L-1 Bidder

If L1 bid is not from a 'Local Bidder', the lowest evaluated bidder among the 'Local Bidders' based on the ranking of the price after RA, will be invited to match the L1 price provided 'Local Bidder's price is within the Margin of Purchase Preference i.e. +20% of L1 price. In case such local Bidder agrees to match the price of L-1 Bidder, such local Bidder may be considered for further award of work. In case such lowest

eligible 'Local Bidder' fails to match the L1 price, the eligible 'Local Bidder' with the next higher bid within the Margin of Purchase Preference (i.e 20% of L-1 Price) as above shall be invited to match the L1 price, and so on, and may be considered for award of work accordingly. In case none of the 'Local Bidders' within the Margin of Purchase Preference (i.e 20% of L-1 price) matches the L1 price, then the L1 bidder may be considered for award of work.

(B) In case where RA is failed

Price bid shall be opened as per reverse auction procedure of BHEL and based on the same make in India policy shall be implemented.
