General Conditions and Tender Process.

1. Earnest Money Deposit as mentioned in the Tender can be paid by either cash in our Cash Office or a Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque drawn in favour of "BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED, Ramachandrapuram, Hyderabad" payable at Hyderabad from any Nationalised Bank/Govt. Bank shall be enclosed to the tender technical bid. **No other means of payment shall be accepted.**
2. Tenders received without Earnest Money Deposit along with Technical Bid will be **rejected.**
3. The following documents are to be enclosed along with the Technical Bid.

(1) Registration Number and relevant documents if any (2) Copy of Valid Labour License, ESI Code No. latest remittance slip (3) P.F. Code No. Copies of form – 6A and Form-23 for the latest period as a token of proof (4) PAN Number & Latest income tax clearance (5) APVAT Registration under Works Contract.
4. B.H.E.L. reserves the right to split the work into convenient portions and award them to different contractors.
5. The undersigned reserves the right to reject any or all tenders or part thereof, if any of the above requirements is not complied with in technical bid.

 14. First only technical bids will be opened and evaluated on the date notified in the Tender notification. After scrutiny and acceptance of the technical bids, price bids of accepted parties only be opened on the date mentioned in the Tender notification.
 15. The technical bid consists of technical schedule requiring documentary proof. In case the agency has not satisfied all the conditions along with documentary proof, the tender will be rejected.
 16. Technical and price bids must be in separate covers and super scribed as "Technical bid " and " Price bid " separately clearly written on the covers.
 17. Tenders received combined (both price and technical bids together) will be rejected.
 18. Every page of the tender document shall be signed by the tenderer at the bottom of the page.
 19. In case of tender application and tender documents downloaded from the web tenderers shall pay the cost of tender documents and EMD for item of work he is tendering, separately by means of two separate DDs (in favour of BHEL, Ramachandrapuram, Hyderabad 502 032) one towards cost of tender documents and second towards EMD. Both DD's shall be enclosed along with the Technical bid.
 20. Bids with out DD's for EMD and cost of Tender Documents will be rejected.
 21. Contractor should quote the rate per day of operation as asked in the price bid in the rate per day column.
 22. Average Annual Turnover of the contractor during the last three years shall be 40% of the estimated cost of the tender value.
 23. Contractor shall have the experience of having successful completion of similar works during last 7 years as follows:
 - a) For three similar completed works – costing Rs. 11.00 lakhs each, or
 - b) For two similar completed works – costing Rs. 13.75 lakhs each, or
 - c) For one similar completed works – costing Rs. 22.00 lakhs.
