The opinion / decision of BHEL regarding the bid shall be final and conclusive.

3.8 The company has no obligation to accept the lowest tender and have **right to re-float the tender, if L1 price is not the acceptable price to BHEL inter-alia other reasons.** Offer of the Bidder if prima-facie found not comparable with the quantum of work envisaged but an efforts to be L1, then the offer is liable to be rejected. BHEL's decision in this regard shall be final and binding.

3.9 BHEL reserves the right to award the contract to one or more bidders simultaneously as deemed fit at the initial stage or during the contract period **at the L1 price to BHEL. BHEL reserves the right to negotiate the L1 rate.**

3.10 BHEL reserves the right to cancel the contract at the initial stage or during the contract period without assigning any reason to the bidder.

### 3.18 TERMS OF PAYMENT

**3.18.1** Payment shall be made, on the Nos. of Measurement units, successfully executed, by the Bidder. The bidder shall submit their clear & legible bills (in duplicate) on Monthly basis, duly verified by concerned BHEL Executive. Each bill must be enclosed with work/ activity completion report duly signed by bidder & and BHEL representative (s).

**3.18.2** All payments shall be released through electronic-pay mode only.

**3.18.3** BHEL shall be releasing payments against the work order after deduction of income tax at source (TDS) as per requirement of income tax rules and BHEL will issue appropriate certificates in this regard. All statutory deduction as applicable, will be deducted from bills. Bidder shall inform his PAN to BHEL.

**3.18.4** GST, as applicable, shall be paid, as per Govt. rules, to the bidder against running actual, on documentary evidence. The GST shall be paid extra and over the quoted rate. The Bidder shall be required to deposit GST as applicable, before due date as per Act, if same is applicable as per rules in force from time to time. The amounts so spent can be claimed from BHEL after submitting the proof of the same.

- i. Work will be carried out on instructions of Executive of production department as per instruction/details provided by them.
- ii. The work is to be completed to full satisfaction of respective area incharge.
- iii. The routine inspection and acceptance of material shall be done by quality department at BHEL.
- iv. The insulators rejected & damaged during cutting and grinding operation to be return back to BHEL-IP and to be disposed at designated area by contractor.
- v. Scrap generated during cutting & grinding operation to be return back to BHEL-IP and to be disposed at designated area by contractor.
- vi. Appropriate care has to be taken while transporting the insulator to avoid transit damages/losses.
- vii. The terms where defects attributed to vendors transporting and grinding process are noticed will be treated as rejections attributed to vendor i.e. vender defect. The details sheet of potential defects and their acceptance norms can be obtained from New Product section, if required.
- viii. The detail of shell cost can be obtained from New Product section, if required. The following will be criteria for deduction of cutting cost & shell cost in case of rejection:-

### **BUS SUPPORT, ROOF INSULATORS, HOLLOW BUSHING, SOLID CORE AND OTHER SIMILAR ITEMS.**

- A. Up to 2% rejection in billing period - No cutting cost, No shell cost.
  - B. 2% to 8% rejection in billing period - Cutting cost will be deducted, No shell cost.
  - C. More than 8% rejection in billing period – Shell and cutting cost, both will be deducted.
- ix. If vendor notices any problem in specific lot during cutting which may result in damage of more Than stipulated percentage. He must stop the cutting and shall inform to BHEL immediately and BHEL will act accordingly.
  - x. Diamond Cutting wheels are to be provided by BHEL after approx. 150 Nos shell cutting.  
(Used/rejected cutting wheels to be return back to BHEL)
  - xi. All the required items (wooden frame, rope etc.) for shifting of shells from BHEL to contractor workshop should be arranged by contractor himself.
  - xii. Shell Cost of damaged shell during transportation will be beared by contractor. No cutting cost payment will be done by Bhel (In case of shells are damaged after cutting.)
  - xiii. **THE BIDDER QUOTING SHOULD ENSURE THAT CUTTING FACILITIES/WORKSHOP SHOULD BE WITHIN 10-15 KM DISTANCE FROM BHEL INSULATOR PLANT. BIDDER SHOULD SUBMIT DECLARATION FOR HAVING FULLY FUNCTIONING CUTTING FACILITIES WITHIN 10-15 KM DISTANCE FROM BHEL INSULATOR PLANT. THIS SHALL BE REVIEWED BY BHEL WHILE TECHNO-COMMERCIAL EVALUATION OF BIDDER.**

## 8.0 GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### 8.1 GENERAL.

8.1.1 In case the bidder has a relative employed in BHEL, the authority inviting tender shall be informed of this fact in writing at the time of submission of tender, failing which the tender may be disqualified, or if such fact comes to light subsequently, the contract may be terminated.

8.1.2 If the bidder gives wrong information in his tender or creates conditions favorable for the acceptance of his tender, BHEL, IP reserves the right to reject such tender at any stage.

### 8.2 SIGNING OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

The tenderer shall furnish following, duly enclosing documents relating thereto:-

- a) Authorized signatory shall be the person holding 'power of attorney' on behalf of the firm/company/bidder-concerned authorized/empowered to act on behalf for the specific purpose.
- b) Power of Attorney: An attested copy of the Power of Attorney, in case an individual other than the sole proprietor signs the tender shall be submitted along with the tenders.
- c) In case of an Individual, full name, address, place & nature of business and license relating to.
- d) In case of Partnership Firms: The names of all the partners and their address. A copy of the partnership deed/instrument of partnership duly certified by the Notary Public shall be enclosed. The tender must be signed by all the partners of the firm or by the managing partner who has power to do.
- e) BHEL will not be bound by any other power of attorney granted or the change in composition of the firm made after the execution of the contract agreement. They may, however, recognize such power of attorney or change in status only after legal advice.

## **8.6 SECURITY DEPOSIT**

8.6.1 Security Deposit means the security provided by the Bidder towards fulfilment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract.

8.6.2 The total amount of Security Deposit will be 5% of the contract value. EMD of the successful bidder shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security Deposit.

d) Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Bidder, a/c BHEL)

e) Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patra etc. (held in the name of Bidder furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL).

(Note: BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith.)

8.6.3 At least 50% of the required Security Deposit, including the EMD, should be deposited before start of the work. Balance of the Security Deposit can be collected by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the Bidder till the total amount of the required Security Deposit is collected.

If the value of work done at any time exceeds the contract value, the amount of Security Deposit shall be correspondingly enhanced and the additional Security Deposit shall be immediately deposited by the Bidder or recovered from payments due to the Bidder.

The recoveries made from running bills (deduction towards balance SD amount) can be released against submission of equivalent Bank Guarantee in acceptable form, but only once, before completion of work, with the approval of the authority competent to award the work.

Security Deposit shall be released to the Bidder upon fulfilment of contractual obligations as per terms of the contract. The Security Deposit shall not carry any interest.

8.6.4 Failure to pay the security deposit shall be treated as failure to discharge the duties under the contract and shall result in cancellation of the offer of the contract and the bidder shall be liable to

compensate the losses if any incurred by BHEL on this account. The security deposit shall be refunded within a reasonable time after the date of expiry of the contract period subject to the bidder carrying out all obligations and operations as required under the contract.

8.6.5 BHEL reserves the right to appropriate the whole or any part of the amount of the security deposit without prejudice to other claims against the bidder for losses suffered by BHEL due to failures on the part of the bidder or due to termination of contract or bidder becoming disqualified because of liquidation. Such losses, damages, charges, expenses or cost, as assumed by BHEL shall be final and binding the bidder and shall not be called into question.

8.6.6 Whenever any sum of money is found to be recoverable from the bidder, the same will be deducted from any sum that may due or which at any time there after becomes due to the bidder under this contract or under any other contract or from his security deposit. In case the recoveries are not complete even after such deduction, the bidder shall pay the same or the balance thereof from the security deposit. The bidder shall immediately thereafter pay such further sums as may be required to replenish the shortage caused by such recoveries in the amount of security deposit.

8.6.7 Security deposit money of bidder will be refunded only after successful completion of the contract. In case any dues are claimed by the statutory Authorities related to contract, the same shall be recovered/ borne/ settled by bidder.

## 8.7 FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH CONTRACT/ TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

8.7.1 Notwithstanding anything contained in any other clause, BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract due to any failure on the part of the Bidder in discharging his obligations under the contract or in the event of his becoming insolvent or going into liquidation. The decision of the BHEL about the failure on the part of the Bidder shall be final and binding on the bidder. In case of any damage to the existing building, structures, materials, tools, furniture and fixtures, machines etc., caused from bidder's end, the cost of its repairs or replacement will be recovered from the bidder. If there is any stoppage of production in any area of the plant due to the fault of the bidder, the bidder is liable to compensate the same.

8.7.2 In the event of any failure on the part of the bidder, BHEL shall have the right without prejudice to any other right or remedies, to get the work done through any other agency and the Bidder shall be liable to compensate BHEL for any losses on this account. The additional cost, loss, if any incurred by BHEL will be recovered from the bills, security deposits, other dues as well as directly from the Bidder.

8.7.3 The cancellation of contract may be either whole or part of the contract at BHEL's option. However the bidder shall continue to operate that part of contract which has not been terminated.

8.7.4 The bidder shall ensure and maintain uninterrupted progress of the work in accordance with instructions given to him on behalf of BHEL from time to time.

8.7.5 In case the bidder makes default in commencing the work within the time specified by BHEL without any reasonable cause, disputes any of the terms and conditions of the contract or refuses to execute the contract or any part thereof at any stage, the contract shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedies available to BHEL IP, be liable to be canceled / terminated in part or in whole. In the event of cancellation / termination of contract, the bidder shall be liable, to compensate BHEL for all losses incurred by BHEL including the loss suffered on account of having the work executed

through any other bidder or department as may be convenient to BHEL, in accordance with the exigencies of the work.

- 8.7.6 Officer In-charge shall have the right to stop the work at any stage or at any time by giving the bidder the seven days' notice in writing and the measurement of the work shall be made by the officer or his authorized representative at any time after due notice at the time of measurement to the bidder. When the payment is made to the bidder based on such measurement, whether or not the bidder or his agent was present at the time of measurement, he shall have no further claim against BHEL.
- 8.7.7 Officer In-charge shall have the right to terminate the contract, forfeit the Security Deposit and recover the loss sustained in getting the balance work done through other agencies at bidder's risk & cost in addition to liquidated damages in the event of Bidder's continued poor performance, withdrawal from or abandonment of the work before completion of the work after giving a show cause with notice period of 15 days.

## 8.8 LAWS GOVERNING THE CONTRACT

8.8.1 The contract will be governed by the Laws of India for the time being in force and as amended or made from time to time.

8.8.2 All disputes shall be settled in accordance with the Laws of India for the time being in force and as amended from time to time.

8.8.3 The decision of BHEL regarding interpretation of any terms and conditions set forth in tender document and the agreement shall be final and binding on the bidder.

8.8.4 SUB-CONTRACTING: The bidder shall not sub-contract or transfer or assign the contract in full or in part or any part thereof to any other person or firm or company.

## 8.9 SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

- i) Except as otherwise specifically provided in the contract all disputes concerning questions of fact arising under the contract shall be decided by the engineer subject to a written appeal by the bidder to the engineer, whose decision shall be final to the parties hereto.
- ii) Any disputes or differences including those considered as such by only one of the parties arising out of or in connection with the contract shall be to the extent possible settled amicably between the parties.
- iii) If amicable settlement cannot be reached then all disputed issues shall be settled by arbitration as provided in relevant clause.

## 8.10 LEGAL JURISDICTION

In respect of all matters arising out of or pertaining to the contract, the cause of action thereof shall be deemed to have arisen only at JAGDISHPUR, where BHEL-IP is situated. All legal proceedings pertaining to the above matters or dispute shall be instituted only in courts having territorial jurisdiction over the place where BHEL-IP is situated and no other court shall have the jurisdiction.

## 8.11 ARBITRATION

- (i) All disputes between the parties to the Contract arising out of or in relation to the Contract, other than those for which the decision of the authority in the Contract or any other person is expressed

## 8.12 DEFAULT/BREACH OF CONTRACT, INSOLVENCY AND RISK PURCHASE

a) If the Service Provider / Bidder fails to provide the required services as per the Contract on time / fails to deliver the goods or materials or any installment thereof within the period(s) fixed for such delivery or delivers goods or materials not of the contracted quality and failing to adhere to the contract specifications or at any time repudiates or otherwise abandons the contract before expiry of such period or refuses or is unable to supply / provide goods / services or materials covered by the Order/Contract either in whole or in part or otherwise fails to perform the Order/Contract or commits any breach of the Order/Contract not herein specifically provided for or in the event of the death or insanity or if the Seller/Bidder being an individual or if a firm on a partnership thereof, shall at any time, be adjudged insolvent or shall have a receiving order for administration of his estate made against him or shall take any proceeding for composition under any Insolvency Act for the time being in force or make any assignment of the Order/Contract or enter into any arrangement or composition with his creditors or suspend payment or if the firm dissolved under the Partnership Act or if the Seller/Bidder (Service Provider) being a company is wound up voluntarily or by order of a Court or a Receiver, Liquidator or Manager on behalf of the debenture holders and creditors is appointed or circumstances shall have arisen which entitles the Court of debenture holder and creditors to appoint a receiver, liquidator or manager, the purchaser without prejudice to his right to recover any expenses, losses or damages to which the purchaser may be put to incur or sustain by reason of the Seller/Bidder's default or breach of Order/Contract shall be entitled to cancel the Order/Contract either in whole or portion thereof without compensation to the Seller/Bidder (Service Provider) and if the purchaser so desires, he may procure upon such terms and in such manner as he deems appropriate, stores not so delivered or others of a similar description where stores exactly complying with particulars are not, in the opinion of the purchaser, which shall be final, readily procurable, at the risk and cost of the Seller/Bidder (Service Provider) and the Seller/Bidder (Service Provider) shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs provided that the Seller/Bidder (Service Provider) shall continue the performance of the Order/Contract to the extent not cancelled under the provisions of this clause. The Seller/Bidder (Service Provider) shall on no account be entitled to any gain on such repurchases.

Bidder shall pay all claims / compensation / damages / penalty / fine or any amount payable to the individual/ authorities payable due to accident / injury to the person employed by the Bidder as per ESI Act.

The details of different type of default/misconducts are available in guidelines.

**8.18 PAYMENT TO THE BIDDER:** The periodicity of payment to the Bidder shall be on monthly basis. The Bidder shall raise the bill for payment as per contractual terms and conditions mentioned in the Contract, which should be duly certified by the BHEL official in charge of the contracted work.

## 9.0 Guidelines for dealing with “discrepancy in words & figures – quoted in price bid”.(Annexure-XII)
