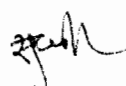

1.0	The bidder is required to meet the following qualification requirements for Ozone Generation Plant: OPTION A The bidder should have executed during last 10 years contract for design, supply, erection and commissioning (or supervision of erection and commissioning) of at least one number ozone generation plant (Ozonisation system) with total capacity not less than 8 kg/hr. comprising of ozone generator and associated system. The above executed ozonisation plant should be for a power plant of 500 MW or above capacity which has completed one year of commercial operation and the Ozonisation system supplied should have completed the contractual guarantee period. OPTION B The bidder should have executed during last 10 years contract for design, supply, erection and commissioning (or supervision of erection and commissioning) of at least one number ozone generation plant (Ozonisation system) with total capacity not less than 16 kg/hr. comprising of ozone generator and associated system. The above executed ozonisation plant should be for any power plant of any rating which has completed one year of commercial operation and the Ozonisation system supplied should have completed the contractual guarantee period. OPTION C The bidder should have executed during last 10 years contract for design, supply, erection and commissioning (or supervision of erection and commissioning) of at least one number ozone generation plant (Ozonisation system) with total capacity not less than 16 kg/hr. comprising of ozone generator and associated system. The above executed ozonisation plant should be for any industry/system which has completed one year of commercial operation and the Ozonisation system supplied should have completed the contractual guarantee period. For all the above options (i.e. OPTION A, OPTION B, OPTION C) the Ozonisation system supplied should have been in successful operation for minimum one year as on 06.08.2018.
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2.0	In case bidder is not meeting the above (Sr no 1.0) prequalification requirements on its own strength, in that case the bidder can submit the offer as per following criteria. Offers of the JV companies/ Joint Bidders/ bidders having collaboration/ licensing agreement/ MOU/ Indian subsidiaries shall be evaluated as follows: a. If bidder happens to be an Indian subsidiaries of foreign OEM, then the credentials of the foreign OEM can also be considered for meeting PQR. b. If bidder happens to be the Joint Venture Company, then the credentials of any of JV partners can be also considered for meeting PQR. c. If bidder happens to bid jointly with their partner, then credentials of both the partners will be considered for meeting PQR as per distribution of the work. In all such cases, lead bidder as specified in bid documents shall be responsible for overall execution of the contract and all guarantee/ warranty. d. If bidder happens to be the having valid collaboration agreement/ MOU/ licensing agreement with some other company, then the credentials of collaborator/ MOU partner/ licensing company can also be considered for meeting PQR. Note: If bidder(s) qualifies on the basis of credentials of his principal/ JV partner/ Collaborator/ joint bidder etc., then the principal/ JV partner/ Collaborator/ MOU partner/ joint bidder shall be responsible for overall design vetting and warranty/ guarantee of the package. The scope matrix clearly defining their respective roles including design vetting, manufacturing of critical component, E&C etc. etc. and warranty/ guarantee shall be submitted along with the offer.
3.0	The supplier has to submit following supporting documents meeting above mentioned pre-qualifying requirements: (as per Sr no 1.0 above) Copy of minimum one (1) performance certificate (in English) from end user along with copy of related Purchase Order (PO) or Letter of intent (LOI) or Letter of Award (LOA) or Work Order (WO) in support of PQR above.
4.0	Bidder shall submit design documents to substantiate technical parameters specified in PQR, if the same is not mentioned in performance certificate/purchase order.
5.0	Bidder to submit all supporting documents in English. If documents submitted by bidder are in language other than English, a translation of its pertinent passages in English language in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the bid, the translation shall govern. The English Translation of the documents shall be carried out by professional translators and the translator shall certify that he is proficient in both languages in order to translate the document and that the translation is complete and accurate. Further, translation shall be authenticated by the Indian Consulate located in the Country where the documents have been issued or the Embassy of that Country in India.
6.0	Notwithstanding anything stated above, BHEL/MAHAGENCO reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the bidder to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of BHEL/MAHAGENCO.

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7.0	After satisfactory fulfilment of all the above criteria/ requirement, offer shall be considered for further evaluation as per NIT and all the other terms of the tender.
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Note-1: Please note that PQR indicated under OPTION A and OPTION B is the requirement of BHEL's end customer (M/s MahaGenco) with respect to application in Power plant and to be considered by M/s MahaGenco while approving the bidder.

Note-2: Regarding OPTION C BHEL has taken up with M/s MahaGenco for relaxation with respect to alternative process application (i.e. non power plant application) as indicated in OPTION C.

Note-3: Bidders are advised to furnish the PQR documents in line with OPTION A or OPTION B (as applicable). However, in case the bidder feels that they are not meeting the requirement of OPTION A or OPTION B, but can meet the requirement of OPTION C, then they are advised to submit the bids along with PQR documents meeting the OPTION C requirement. The bids meeting the requirement of OPTION C shall be technically recommended by BHEL and shall be forwarded to end customer for acceptance of any relaxation with respect to OPTION C and shall be subject to approval of bidder (s) by M/s MAHAGENCO.

Note-4: In case M/s MAHAGENCO does not consider any relaxation, with respect to **OPTION C**, the bids and bidder's approval shall be governed with respect to **OPTION A** or **OPTION B** of PQR and bidder will not have any claim with respect to **OPTION C**.
