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- A.** Mill reject handling system offered by the Bidder shall be only from such manufacturer who has previous experience of manufacturing and supplying pneumatic type coal mill rejects handling systems of capacity 5 MTPH or higher which are in successful operation in at least one (1) plant for a period not less than one (1) year prior to **02.11.2015**.
- B.** In case the Bidder is not a manufacturer of proven equipments as per clause (A) above but is a manufacturer of pneumatic conveying systems and has manufactured and supplied pressure type pneumatic conveying systems of capacity 5 MTPH or higher for any material which are in successful operation in at least one (1) plant for a period not less than one (1) year prior to **02.11.2015**, the Bidder can manufacture such equipments for mill rejects handling also provided he has valid collaboration or licensing agreement for design, engineering, manufacture, and supply of such equipments in India with a manufacturer who meets the requirements of clause (A) above.
- In such a case, the Bidder shall be required to furnish a Deed of Joint Undertaking (DJU) jointly executed by the BHEL, bidder and its' Collaborator/ Associate and each executant of DJU shall be jointly and severally liable to the Owner for successful performance of the system, as per the format enclosed with the NIT. The Deed of Joint Undertaking (DJU) should be submitted at the time of placement of order on successful bidder. In such a case, the Collaborator/ Associate shall be required to furnish an on demand bank guarantee for INR 1.6 Million (Rupees One Million and six hundred thousand) at the time of placement of order.

NOTES

- Bidder has to submit performance certificate in English from end user along with copy of Purchase Order or Letter of Intent (LOI) or Letter of Award (LOA) or Work order in support of PQR clause at Sl. No. A above.
- Bidder shall submit design documents to substantiate technical parameters specified in PQR, if the same is not mentioned in performance certificate/purchase order. The bidder shall provide all necessary data such as type, design, make, capacity, duty conditions, date of commissioning/ operation etc.
- Minimum one (1) no. Purchase order shall be submitted which should not be more than seven (7) years old as on date of bid submission, for establishing continuity in business. This is over and above the requirement of PO mentioned at note (1) above.
- Bidder to submit all supporting documents in English. If documents submitted by bidder are in language other than English, a self-attested English translated document should also be submitted.
- Signed and stamped copy of the **duly filled format** of Deed of Joint Undertaking (if applicable) shall be submitted along with the bid as a token of acceptance of same.
- At the time of placement of order, **duly filled** Deed of Joint Undertaking (DJU) and demand bank guarantee as stipulated in **clause B** above (if applicable) shall be required to be submitted. The instruments such as

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Letter of Undertakings, Joint Deed of undertakings etc. which are presently specified to be furnished on non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate/requisite value, shall be stamped as per Indian Stamp Act.

7. Notwithstanding anything stated above, BHEL/UPRVUNL or its consultant reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the Bidder/its Collaborators/ licensor/ its sub-contractors to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of BHEL/UPRVUNL.
8. After satisfactory fulfilment of all the above criteria/ requirement, offer shall be considered for further evaluation as per NIT and all the other terms of the tender.
9. Final acceptance of the bidder is subject to approval from end customer.
