The bidder should have designed, manufactured, tested, inspected & supplied the Steam Conditioning Valve and associated spray control valve (for applications like Auxiliary PRDS, Turbine bypass, etc.), for a Thermal Power plant,</p> <p>a) which have been successfully in use for at least one year in at least one unit of Thermal Power plant of capacity 600 MW or more and is in business on continuous basis</p> <p>or</p> <p>b) which have been successfully in use for at least two years in at least two units of Thermal Power plant of capacity 500 MW or more and is in business on continuous basis within last 7 years as on the date of submission of bid document</p> <p>1.1 In case bidder is not OEM, the offer shall be evaluated as per below (1.1 (a) & (b))</p> <p>a) Offers of the JV companies/ Joint Bidders/ bidders having collaboration/ licensing agreement/ MOU/ Indian subsidiaries shall be evaluated as follows:</p> <p>(i) All such Vendors should have a technology sharing license agreement for the Steam Conditioning Valve with a collaborator who is a regular manufacturer of such Steam Conditioning Valves at least for the duty specified / required for this project and meets the criteria as specified in Sl. No. 1 above.</p> <p>(ii) Bidder/Associate partner in the bid either himself or his group company shall also be eligible to supply the Auxiliary PRDS system if its Parent Company/Subsidiary Company/Group Company/JV Company (equity participation not less than 25%) meets the Criteria fulfilment mentioned against Sl. No.1 above for Steam Conditioning Valve in consideration above.</p> <p>Necessary end user credentials meeting the Qualification intent in favour of those entities in whose strength Bidder/Associate partner have selected, supporting documents for the proveness must be submitted to the owner for approval along with the declaration of Legal relationship with such entities.</p> <p>Note: If bidder(s) qualifies on the basis of credentials of his principal/ JV partner/ Collaborator/ joint bidder etc., then the principal/ JV partner/ Collaborator/ MOU partner/ joint bidder shall be responsible for overall design vetting and warranty/ guarantee of the package. The scope matrix (duly certified by JV companies/ Joint Bidders/ bidders having collaboration/ licensing agreement/ MOU/ Indian subsidiaries) clearly defining their respective roles including design vetting, manufacturing of critical component, E&C etc. and warranty/ guarantee shall be submitted along with the offer.</p> <p>b) Bidder to note that the arrangement of bidding (joint bid partners/ collaborator/ MOU partner/ licensing company etc.) once offered to BHEL as a part of bidding documents cannot be changed till the execution of the project.</p>		
<p>2. The Bidder shall furnish following support documents for assessment of Bidder w.r.t. PQR as indicated at S.no.1 above.</p> <p>A. Bidder's Experience list of Steam Conditioning Valve for last 5 years to establish continuity in business (for assessment of bidder for supplying the Steam Conditioning Valve / Auxiliary PRDS) in enclosed format- Annexure-1.</p> <p>Bidder shall furnish the PO copy/ support documents/ Dispatch details of at least one/two Contract as indicated in the experience list.</p> <p>B. Bidder shall furnish Satisfactory Performance feedback certificates from End Customer (Owner) (in English) for at least one/ two successfully executed contract (meeting PQR requirement at Sl.no 1 (a) or (b) above) indicating salient features like year of commissioning, duty parameters (Flow, Size), project name etc., date of issue of certificate and name/ designation of the certificate issuer), in support of successful performance of Steam Conditioning Valve.</p> <p>Note: - Purchase order copy, supporting drgs. /technical data sheets etc. are to be submitted along with the bid, for which the bidder intends to furnish the performance feedbacks for reference purpose only.</p> <p>3. Bidder to submit all supporting documents in English. If documents submitted by bidder are in language other than English, a self-attested English translated document should also be submitted.</p> <p>4. Notwithstanding anything stated above, BHEL reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the bidder /collaborators to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of BHEL.</p> <p>5. After satisfactory fulfilment of all the above criteria/ requirement, offer shall be considered for further evaluation as per NIT and all the other terms of the tender.</p>
