- d) Participating MSEs quoting price within price band of L1+15 % shall be considered for award of complete scope of work by bringing down their price to L1 price in a situation where L1 price is from someone other than a MSE. In case of more than one such MSE, MSE with lowest price shall be given the first option to match the L1 price. However, MSEs owned by the Scheduled Caste or the Scheduled Tribe entrepreneurs shall be given the preference for matching the L1 price irrespective of their standing in comparative statement of MSE bidders within price band of L1+15 %.

(TERMS & CONDITIONS of CONTRACT)

1. General Instructions to Tenderers

1.1. DESPATCH INSTRUCTION

- i) The Terms and Conditions of Contract form part of the Tender specifications. <u>All pages of the tender documents shall be duly signed, stamped and submitted along with the offer in token of complete acceptance thereof.</u> The information furnished shall be complete by itself. The tenderer is required to furnish all the details and other documents as required in the following pages
- ii) Tenderers are advised to study all the tender documents carefully. Any submission of tender by the tenderer shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the tender documents and with the full understanding of the implications thereof. Should the tenderers have any doubt about the meaning of any portion of the Tender Specification or find discrepancies or omissions in the drawings or the tender documents issued are incomplete or shall require clarification on any of the technical aspect, the scope of work etc., he shall at once, contact the authority inviting the tender well in time (so as not to affect last date of submission) for clarification before the submission of the tender. Tenderer's request for clarifications shall be with reference to Sections and Clause numbers given in the tender documents. The specifications and terms and conditions shall be deemed to have been accepted by the tenderer in his offer. Non compliance with any of the requirements and instructions of the tender enquiry may result in the rejection of the tender.

1.2. SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

- 1.2.1 The tenderers must submit their tenders to Officer inviting tender as per instructions in the NIT
- 1.2.2 Tenders submitted by post shall be sent by 'REGISTERED **POST** ACKNOWLEDGEMENT DUE / by COURIER' and shall be posted with due allowance for any postal/courier delays. BHEL takes no responsibility for delay, loss or nonreceipt of tenders sent by post/courier. The tenders received after the specified time of their submission are treated as 'Late Tenders' and shall not be considered under any circumstances. Offers received by Fax/Email/Internet shall be considered as per terms of NIT.
- 1.2.3 Tenders shall be opened by authorised Officer of BHEL at his office at the time and date as specified in the NIT, in the presence of such of those tenderers or their authorised representatives who may be present

- 1.2.4 Tenderers whose bids are found techno commercially qualified shall be informed the date and time of opening of the Price Bids and such Tenderers may depute their representatives to witness the opening of the price bids. BHEL's decision in this regard shall be final and binding.
- 1.2.5 Before submission of Offer, the tenderers are advised to inspect the site of work and the environments and be well acquainted with the actual working and other prevalent conditions, facilities available, position of material and labour, means of transport and access to Site, accommodation, etc. No claim will be entertained later on the grounds of lack of knowledge of any of these conditions.

1.3 LANGUAGE

- 1.3.1 The tenderer shall quote the rates in English language and international numerals. These rates shall be entered in figures as well as in words. For the purpose of the tenders, the metric system of units shall be used.
- 1.3.2 All entries in the tender shall either be typed or written legibly in ink. Erasing and over-writing is not permitted and may render such tenders liable for rejection. All cancellations and insertions shall be duly attested by the tenderer.

1.4 PRICE DISCREPANCY:

Conventional (Manual) Price Bid opening: In the case of price bid opening without resorting to Reverse Auction, if there are differences between the rates given by the tenderer in words and figures or in amount worked out by him, the following procedure for evaluation and award shall be followed:

- i) When there is a difference between the rates in figures and in words, the rates which corresponds to the amounts worked out by the contractor, shall be taken as correct
- ii) When the amount of an item is not worked out by the contractor or it does not correspond with the rate written either in figure or in words, then the rate quoted by the contractor in words shall be taken as correct
- iii) When the rate quoted by the contractor in figures and words tallies but the amount is not worked out correctly, the rate quoted by the contractor shall be taken as correct and not the amount.
- iv) In case of lumpsum price, if there is any difference between the amount in figures and in words, the amount quoted by the bidder in words shall be taken as correct.
- v) In case of omission in quoting any rate for one or more items, the evaluation shall be done considering the highest quoted rate obtained against the respective items by other tenderers for the subject tender. If the tenderer becomes L-1, the notional rates for the omission items shall be the lowest rates quoted for the respective items by the other tenderers against the respective omission items for the subject job and the 'Total quoted price (loaded for omissions)' shall be arrived at. However the overall price remaining the same as quoted originally, the rates for all the items in the 'Total quoted price (loaded for omissions)' shall be reduced item wise in proportion to the ratio of 'Original' total price and the 'Total quoted price (loaded for omissions)".
- vi) The 'Final Total Amount' shall be arrived at after considering the amounts worked out in line with 'i' to 'v' above.

1.5 QUALIFICATION OF TENDERERS

i) Only tenderers who have previous experience in the work of the nature and description detailed in the Notice Inviting Tender and/or tender specification are expected to quote for this work duly detailing their experience along with offer.

- ii) Offers from tenderers who do not have proven and established experience in the field shall not be considered
- iii) Offers from tenderers who are under suspension (banned) by any Unit/Region/Division of BHEL shall not be considered.
- iv) Offers from tenderers who do not comply with the latest guidelines of Ministry/Commissions of Govt. of India shall not be considered.

1.6. EVALUATION OF BIDS

- i) Technical Bids submitted by the tenderer will be opened first and evaluated for fulfilling the Pre Qualification criteria and other conditions in NIT/Tender documents, based on documentary evidences submitted along with the offer
- ii) In case the same qualifying experience is claimed by more than one agency, then the agency who has executed the work as per documentary evidence submitted shall only be qualified. Scope of qualifying work should be totally with the agency who has executed and in case it is only labour+consumables without T&P, then the responsibility of execution is assigned to the first agency and not to the agency who has executed only as labour supply contractor. Further, BHEL reserves the right to ask for further proofs including submission of TDS certificates for the said job
- iii) In case the qualifying experience is claimed by private organizations based on Work Order and completion certificates from another private organization, BHEL reserves the right to ask for further proofs including submission of TDS certificates for the said job
- iv) Assessing Bidder Capacity for executing the current tender shall be as per Notice Inviting Tender
- v) Price Bids of shortlisted bidders shall only be opened through the conventional price bid opening.
- vi) Price Bids of unqualified bidders shall not be opened. Reasons for rejection shall be intimated in due course after issue of LOI/LOA to successful bidder and receipt of unqualified acceptance from the successful bidder

1.7. DATA TO BE ENCLOSED

Full information shall be given by the tenderer in respect of the following. Non-submission of this information may lead to rejection of the offer.

i) INCOME TAX PERMANENT ACCOUNT NUMBER

Certified copies of Permanent Account Numbers as allotted by Income Tax Department for the Company/Firm/Individual Partners, etc. shall be furnished along with tender.

ii) ORGANIZATION CHART

The organization chart of the tenderer's organization, including the names, addresses and contact information of the Directors/Partners shall be furnished along with the offer.

iii) An attested copy of the Power of Attorney, in case the tender is signed by an individual other than the sole proprietor

iv) IN CASE OF INDIVIDUAL TENDERER:

His / her full name, address and place & nature of business.

v) IN CASE OF PARTNERSHIP FIRM

The names of all the partners and their addresses, A copy of the partnership deed/instrument of partnership dully certified by the Notary Public shall be enclosed.

vi) IN CASE OF COMPANIES:

- Date and place of registration including date of commencement certificate in case of Public Companies (certified copies of Memorandum and articles of Association are also to be furnished).
- b. Nature of business carried on by the Company and the provisions of the Memorandum relating thereof.

1.8. AUTHORISATION AND ATTESTATION

Tenders shall be signed by a person duly authorized/empowered to do so. An attested copy of the Power of Attorney, in case the tender is signed by an individual other than the sole proprietor shall be submitted along with the tenders

1.9. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT

- 1.9.1 Every tender must be accompanied by the prescribed amount of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the manner described herein.
 - i) EMD shall be furnished before tender opening / along with the offer in full as per the amount indicated in the Special Conditions of Contract / NIT.
 - ii) The EMD is to be paid in the following forms:
 - a) Cash deposit as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act (before tender opening).
 - b) Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before tender opening).
 - c) Banker's cheque / Pay order / Demand draft, in favour of 'Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited' and payable at Regional HQ issuing the tender (along with offer).

In case total EMD amount is more than INR 20 Lakh, the amount in excess of INR 20 lakh may be accepted in the form of Bank Guarantee from scheduled bank. The Bank Guarantee in such cases shall be valid for at least six months.

- iii) No other form of EMD remittance shall be acceptable to BHEL.
- 1.9.2 EMD by the Tenderer will be forfeited as per NIT conditions, if:
 - After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.
 - ii) The Contractor fails to deposit the required Security deposit or commence the work within the period as per LOI/ LOA/ Contract.

EMD by the tenderer shall be withheld in case any action on the tenderer is envisaged under the provisions of extant "Guidelines on Suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors" and forfeited/ released based on the action as determined under these guidelines.

1.9.3 EMD shall not carry any interest.

- 1.9.4 In the case of unsuccessful bidders, the Earnest Money will be refunded to them within a reasonable time after award of work.
- 1.9.5 EMD of successful tenderer will be retained as part of Security Deposit.

1.10. SECURITY DEPOSIT

- 1.10.1 Upon acceptance of Tender, the successful Tenderer should deposit the required amount of Security Deposit towards fulfilment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract. The total amount of Security Deposit will be 5% of the contract value. EMD of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security Deposit.
- 1.10.2 The security Deposit should be furnished before start of the work by the contractor.
- 1.10.3 The balance amount to make up the required Security Deposit of 5% of the contract value may be accepted in the following forms.
 - i) Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)
 - ii) Local cheques of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL.
 - iii) Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL).
 - iv) Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The Bank Guarantee format for Security Deposit shall be in the prescribed formats.
 - v) Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Contractor, a/c BHEL).
 - vi) Security deposit can also be recovered at the rate of 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required security deposit is collected. However in such cases at least 50% of the required Security Deposit, including the EMD, should be deposited in any form as prescribed before start of the work and the balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills as described above.

(Note: In case of small value contracts not exceeding INR 20 lakhs, work can be started before the required Security Deposit is collected. However, payment can be released only after collection/ recovery of initial 50% Security Deposit).

Note: BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith.

- 1.10.4 The Security Deposit shall not carry any interest.
- 1.10.5 In case the value of work exceeds / reduces from the awarded / accepted value, the Security Deposit shall be correspondingly enhanced / reduced as given below:
 - i) The enhanced part of the Security Deposit shall be immediately deposited by the Contractor or adjusted against payments due to the Contractor.

- ii) There will be no reduction in Security Deposit value in case of variation in contract value upto the lower limit specified in Quantity variation clause. In case of reduction of contract value beyond the lower limit specified in Quantity Variation clause, then the Security Deposit shall be re adjusted in proportion.
- iii) In case of reduction, the reduced Contract value shall be certified by BHEL Construction Manager after ascertaining / freezing of BOQ / Drawings from the Design / Engineering Centre. The reduced Security Deposit value can only be considered after taking into account the adequacy of the securities held by BHEL to meet the liabilities of the contractor for the contract, and the performance of the contract in general. In such cases, the revised value of Security Deposit shall be worked out only after execution of not less than the lower limit of the revised scope of work/contract value as per quantity variation clause, and as certified by Construction Manager. This reduction in value of Security Deposit shall not entitle the contractor to any amendment of Contract and shall be operated at the discretion of BHEL.
- iv) Contract value for the purpose of operating the reduced/increased value of Security Deposit due to Quantity Variation, shall be exclusive of Price Variation Clause, Over Run Compensation and Extra works done on manday rates.
- v) The recoveries made from running bills (cash deduction towards balance SD amount) can be released against submission of equivalent Bank Guarantee in acceptable form, but only once, before completion of work, with the approval of BHEL.
- 1.10.6 The validity of Bank Guarantees towards Security Deposit shall be initially upto the completion period as stipulated in the Letter of Intent/ Award + 3 months, and the same shall be kept valid by proper renewal till the acceptance of Final Bills of the Contractor, by BHEL.
- 1.10.7 BHEL reserves the right of forfeiture of Security Deposit in addition to other claims and penalties in the event of the Contractor's failure to fulfill any of the contractual obligations or in the event of termination of contract as per terms and conditions of contract. BHEL reserves the right to set off the Security Deposit against any claims of other contracts with BHEL.

1.11. RETURN OF SECURITY DEPOSIT

Security Deposit shall be refunded/ Bank Guarantee(s) released to the Contractor along with the 'Final Bill' payment after deducting all expenses / other amounts due to BHEL under the contract / other contracts entered into with them by BHEL.

1.12. BANK GUARANTEES

Where ever Bank Guarantees are to be furnished/submitted by the contractor, the following shall be complied with

- i) Bank Guarantees shall be from Scheduled Banks / Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act.
- ii) The Bank Guarantees shall be as per prescribed formats.
- iii) It is the responsibility of the bidder to get the Bank Guarantees revalidated/extended for the required period (subject to a minimum period of six months), as per the advice of BHEL Site Engineer / Construction Manager. BHEL shall not be liable for issue of any reminders regarding expiry of the Bank Guarantees.

- iv) In case extension/further extensions of any Bank Guarantees are not required, the bidders shall ensure that the same is explicitly endorsed by the Construction Manager and submitted to the Regional HQ issuing the LOI/LOA.
- v) In case the Bank Guarantees are not extended before the expiry date, BHEL reserves the right to invoke the same by informing the concerned Bank in writing, without any advance notice/communication to the concerned bidder.
- vi) Bidders to note that any corrections to Bank Guarantees shall be done by the issuing Bank, only through an amendment in an appropriate non judicial stamp paper.
- vii) The Original Bank Guarantee shall be sent directly by the Bank to BHEL under Registered Post (Acknowledgement Due), addressed to the Subcontracting Department of the respective Region.

1.13. VALIDITY OF OFFER

The rates in the Tender shall be kept open for acceptance for a minimum period of **SIX MONTHS** from latest due date of offer submission (including extension, if any). In case BHEL (Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd) calls for negotiations, such negotiations shall not amount to cancellation or withdrawal of the original offer which shall be binding on the tenderers.

1.14. EXECUTION OF CONTRACT AGREEMENT

The successful tenderer's responsibility under this contract commences from the date of issue of the Letter of Intent/ Award by Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited. The Tenderer shall submit an unqualified acceptance to the Letter of Intent/Award within the period stipulated therein.

The successful tenderer may be required to execute an agreement in the prescribed form, with BHEL, within a reasonable time after the acceptance of the Letter of Intent/Award, and in any case before releasing the first running bill. The contract agreement shall be signed by a person duly authorized/empowered by the tenderer.

1.15. REJECTION OF TENDER AND OTHER CONDITIONS

- 1.15.1 The acceptance of tender will rest with BHEL which does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender and reserves to itself full rights for the following without assigning any reasons whatsoever:-
- a. To reject any or all of the tenders.
- To split up the work amongst two or more tenderers as per NIT
- c. To award the work in part if specified in NIT
- d. In case of either of the contingencies stated in (b) and (c) above, the time for completion as stipulated in the tender shall be applicable.
- 1.15.2 Conditional tenders, unsolicited tenders, tenders which are incomplete or not in the form specified or defective or have been materially altered or not in accordance with the tender conditions, specifications etc., are liable to be rejected.
- 1.15.3 Tenders are liable to be rejected in case of unsatisfactory performance of the tenderer with BHEL, or tenderer under suspension (hold/banning /delisted) by any unit / region / division of BHEL or tenderers who do not comply with the latest guidelines of Ministry/Commissions of Govt of India. The decision of BHEL will be final in this regard.

- 1.15.4 If a tenderer who is a proprietor expires after the submission of his tender or after the acceptance of his tender, BHEL may at their discretion, cancel such tender. If a partner of a firm expires after the submission of tender or after the acceptance of the tender, BHEL may then cancel such tender at their discretion, unless the firm retains its character.
- 1.15.5 BHEL will not be bound by any Power of Attorney granted by changes in the composition of the firm made subsequent to the execution of the contract. They may, however, recognize such power of Attorney and changes after obtaining proper legal advice, the cost of which will be chargeable to the contractor concerned.
- 1.15.6 If the tenderer deliberately gives wrong information in his tender, BHEL reserves the right to reject such tender at any stage or to cancel the contract if awarded and forfeit the Earnest Money/Security Deposit/any other money due.
- 1.15.7 Canvassing in any form in connection with the tenders submitted by the Tenderer shall make his offer liable to rejection.
- 1.15.8 In case the Proprietor, Partner or Director of the Company/Firm submitting the Tender, has any relative or relation employed in BHEL, the authority inviting the Tender shall be informed of the fact as per specified format, along with the Offer. Failing to do so, BHEL may, at its sole discretion, reject the tender or cancel the contract and forfeit the Earnest Money/Security Deposit.
- 1.15.9 The successful tenderer should not sub-contract part or complete work detailed in the tender specification undertaken by him without written permission of BHEL's Construction Manager/Site Incharge. The tenderer is solely responsible to BHEL for the work awarded to him.
- 1.15.10 The Tender submitted by a techno commercially qualified tenderer shall become the property of BHEL who shall be under no obligation to return the same to the bidder. However unopened price bids and late tenders shall be returned to the bidders.
- 1.15.11 Unsolicited discount received after the due date and time of Bid Submission shall not be considered for evaluation. However, if the party who has submitted the unsolicited discount/rebate becomes the L-I party, then the awarded price i.e contract value shall be worked out after considering the discount so offered.
- 1.15.12 BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by the bidder in the preparation of the tender irrespective of whether the tender is accepted or not.

2.0 DEFINITIONS

- **2.1 <u>DEFINITION:</u>** The following terms shall have the meaning hereby assigned to them except where the context otherwise requires
- i. BHEL shall mean Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (of the respective Power Sector Region inviting the Tender), a company registered under Indian Companies Act 1956, with its Registered Office at BHEL HOUSE, SIRI FORT, NEW DELHI – 110 049, or its Power Sector Regional Offices or its Authorised Officers or its Site Engineers or other employees authorised to deal with any matters with which these persons are concerned on its behalf.
- ii. "EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR" or 'GROUP GENERAL MANAGER' or "GENERAL MANAGER (Incharge)" or "GENERAL MANAGER" shall mean the Officer in Administrative charge of the respective Power Sector Region.
- iii. "COMPETENT AUTHORITY" shall mean Executive Director or Group General Manager or General Manager (Incharge) or General Manager or BHEL Officers who are

- empowered to act on behalf of the Executive Director or General Manager (Incharge) or General Manager of BHEL.
- iv. "ENGINEER" or "ENGINEER IN CHARGE" shall mean an Officer of BHEL as may be duly appointed and authorized by BHEL to act as "Engineer" on his behalf for the purpose of the Contract, to perform the duty set forth in this Terms and Conditions of Contract and other Contract documents. The term also includes 'CONSTRUCTION MANAGER' or 'SITE INCHARGE' as well as Officers at Site or at the Headquarters of the respective Power Sector Regions.
- v. "SITE" shall mean the places or place at which the plants/equipments are to be erected and services are to be performed as per the specification of this Tender.
- vi. "CLIENT OF BHEL" or "CUSTOMER" shall mean the project authorities with whom BHEL has entered into a contract for supply of equipments or provision of services.
- vii. "CONTRACTOR" shall mean the successful Bidder/Tenderer who is awarded the Contract and shall include the Contractor's successors, heirs, executors, administrators and permitted assigns.
- viii. "CONTRACT" or "CONTRACT DOCUMENT" shall mean and include the Agreement of Work Order, the accepted appendices of Rates, Schedules, Quantities if any, Terms and Conditions of Contract, Special Conditions of Contract, Instructions to the Tenderers, Drawings, Technical Specifications, the Special Specifications if any, the Tender documents, subsequent amendments mutually agreed upon and the Letter of Intent/Award/Acceptance issued by BHEL. Any conditions or terms stipulated by the contractor in the tender documents or subsequent letters shall not form part of the contract unless, specifically accepted in writing by BHEL in the Letter of Intent/Award and incorporated in the agreement.
- ix. "TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT" shall mean the 'Instructions to Tenderers' and 'Terms and Conditions of Contract' pertaining to the work for which above tenders have been called for.
- x. "TENDER SPECIFICATION" or "TENDER" or "TENDER DOCUMENTS" shall mean Terms and Conditions of Contract, Common Conditions, Special Conditions, Price Bid, Rate Schedule, Technical Specifications, Appendices, Annexures, Corrigendums, Amendments, Forms, procedures, Site information, etc and drawings/documents pertaining to the work for which the tenderers are required to submit their offers. Individual specification number will be assigned to each Tender Specification.
- xi. "LETTER OF INTENT/ AWARD" shall mean the intimation by a Letter/Fax/email to the tenderer that the tender has been accepted in accordance with provisions contained in the letter. The responsibility of the contractor commences from the date of issue of this letter and all terms and conditions of the contract are applicable from this date.
- xii. "COMPLETION TIME" shall mean the period by 'date/month' specified in the 'Letter of Intent/Award' or date mutually agreed upon for handing over of the intended scope of work, the erected equipment/plant which are found acceptable by the Engineer, being of required standard and conforming to the specifications of the Contract.
- xiii. "PLANT" shall mean and connote the entire assembly of the plant and equipments covered by the contract.
- xiv. "EQUIPMENT" shall mean equipment, machineries, materials, structural, electricals and other components of the plant covered by the contract.
- xv. "TESTS" shall mean and include such test or tests to be carried out on the part of the contractor as are prescribed in the contract or considered necessary by BHEL, in order to ascertain the quality, workmanship, performance and efficiency of the contractor or part thereof.

- xvi. "APPROVED", "DIRECTED" or "INSTRUCTED" shall mean approved, directed or instructed by BHEL.
- xvii. "WORK or CONTRACT WORK" shall mean and include hiring of vehicles/services to the entire satisfaction of BHEL as per the terms & conditions of contract.
- xviii. "SINGULAR AND PLURALS ETC" words carrying singular number shall also include plural and vice versa, where the context so requires. Words imparting the masculine Gender shall be taken to include the feminine Gender and words imparting persons shall include any Company or Associations or Body of Individuals, whether incorporated or not.
- xix. "HEADING" The heading in these General Conditions are solely for the purpose of facilitating reference and shall not be deemed to be part thereof or be taken as instructions thereof or of the contract.
- xx. "MONTH" shall mean calendar month unless otherwise specified in the Tender.
- xxi. Day' or 'Days' unless herein otherwise expressly defined shall mean calendar day or days of twenty four (24) hours each. A week shall mean continuous period of seven (7) days.
- xxii. "COMMISSIONING" shall mean the synchronisation testing and achieving functional operation of the Equipment with associated system after all initial adjustments, trials, cleaning, re-assembly required at site if any, have been completed and Equipment with associated system is ready for taking into service.
- xxiii. "WRITING" shall include any manuscript type written or hand written or printed statement or electronically transmitted messages, under the signature or seal or transmittal of BHEL.
- xxiv. "TEMPORARY WORK" shall mean all temporary works for every kind required in or for the execution, completion, maintenance of the work.
- xxv. 'CONTRACT PRICE' or 'CONTRACT VALUE' shall mean the sum mentioned in the LOI/LOA/Contract Agreement subject to such additions thereto or deductions there from as may be made under provisions hereinafter contained
- xxvi. "COMMENCEMENT DATE" or "START DATE" shall mean the commencement/start of work at Site as per terms defined in the Tender
- xxvii. "SHORT CLOSING" or "FORE CLOSING" of Contract shall mean the premature closing of Contract, for reasons not attributable to the contractor and mutually agreed between BHEL and the contractor
- xxviii. "TERMINATION" of Contract shall mean the pre mature closing of contract due to reasons as mentioned in the contract
- xxix. "DE MOBILISATION" shall mean the temporary winding up of Site establishment by Contractor leading to suspension of works temporarily for reasons not attributable to the contractor
- xxx. "RE MOBILISATION" shall mean the resumption of work with all resources required for the work after demobilization

2.2 LAW GOVERNING THE CONTRACT AND COURT JURISDICTION

The contract shall be governed by the Law for the time being in force in the Republic of India. Subject to clause 2.13.1 or 2.13.2 of this contract, the Civil Court having original Civil Jurisdiction at Delhi for PSNR, at Kolkata for PSER, at Nagpur for PSWR and at Chennai for PSSR, shall alone have exclusive jurisdiction in regard to all matters in respect of the Contract.

2.3 ISSUE OF NOTICE

2.3.1 Service of notice on contractor

Any notice to be given to the Contractor under the terms of the contract shall be served by sending the same by Registered Post / Speed Post to or leaving the same at the Contractor's last known address of the principal place of business (or in the event of the contractor being a company, to or at its Registered Office). In case of change of address, the notice shall be served at changed address as notified in writing by the Contractor to BHEL. Such posting or leaving of the notice shall be deemed to be good service of such notice and the time mentioned to the condition for doing any act after notice shall be reckoned from the date so mentioned in such notice.

2.3.2 Service of notice on BHEL

Any notice to be given to BHEL in-charge/Region under the terms of the Contract shall be served by sending the same by post to or leaving the same at BHEL address or changed address as notified in writing by BHEL to the Contractor.

2.4 USE OF LAND

No land belonging to BHEL or their Customer under temporary possession of BHEL shall be occupied by the contractor without written permission of BHEL.

2.5 COMMENCEMENT OF WORK

- **2.5.1** The contractor is required to commence the work within seven days from the date of issue of LOA unless BHEL decides to fix any other date.
- 2.5.2 If the contractor fails to start the work within stipulated time as per LOI/ LOA or as intimated by BHEL, then BHEL at its sole discretion will have the right to cancel the contract. The Earnest Money and/or Security Deposit with BHEL will stand forfeited without any further reference to him without prejudice to any and all of BHEL's other rights and remedies in this regard.
- **2.5.3** All the work shall be carried out under the direction and to the satisfaction of BHEL.

2.6 MEASUREMENT OF WORK AND MODE OF PAYMENT:

- **2.6.1** All payments due to the contractors shall be made by e mode only, unless otherwise found operationally difficult for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- **2.6.2** For progress running bill payments: The Contractor shall present detailed measurement sheets/log book, duly indicating all relevant details based on technical documents in line with terms of payment as per contract.
- **2.6.3** Payments shall be made by BHEL after effecting the recoveries due from the contractor.
- **2.6.4** Passing of bills covered by such measurements does not amount to acceptance of the completion of the work measured.

2.7 RIGHTS OF BHEL

BHEL reserves the following rights in respect of this contract during the original contract period or its extensions if any, as per the provisions of the contract, without entitling the contractor for any compensation.

- **2.7.1** To withdraw any portion of work and/or to restrict/alter quantum of work as indicated in the contract during the progress of work and get it done through other agencies to suit BHEL's changed requirements w.r.t. time or scope.
- 2.7.2 To terminate the contract or get any part of the work done through other agency or deploy BHEL's own/hired/otherwise arranged resources, at the risk and cost of the contractor after due notice of a period of seven days by BHEL, in the event of:
 - i) Contractor's continued poor progress
 - ii) Withdrawal from or abandonment of the work before completion of the work
 - iii) Contractor's inability to progress the work for completion as stipulated in the contract
 - iv) Poor quality of work/services
 - v) Corrupt act of Contractor
 - vi) Insolvency of the Contractor
 - vii) Persistent disregard to the instructions of BHEL
 - viii) Assignment, transfer, sub-letting of contract without BHEL's written permission
 - ix) Non fulfillment of any contractual obligations
 - x) In the opinion of BHEL, the contractor is overloaded and is not in a position to execute the job as per required schedule
- **2.7.3** To meet the expenses including BHEL overheads on the differential cost at 5%, over and above the Liquidated damages/penalties arising out of "Risk & Cost" as explained above under sl. no. 2.7.2. BHEL shall recover the amount from any money due from Contractor, or any other contract of BHEL or by any other means or any combination thereof.
- **2.7.4** To effect recovery from any amounts due to the contractor under this or any other contract or in any other form, the moneys BHEL is statutorily forced to pay to anybody, due to contractor's failure to fulfill any of his obligations. BHEL shall levy overheads of 5% on all such payments along with interest as defined elsewhere in the terms and conditions.
- **2.7.5** While every endeavour will be made by BHEL to this end, they cannot guarantee uninterrupted work due to conditions beyond their control. The Contractor will not be normally entitled for any compensation/extra payment on this account unless otherwise specified elsewhere in the contract.

2.7.6 PENALTY /LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Penalty @ Rs. 400/- shall be enforced in the event of refusal by the contractor to provide the required vehicle on each refusal. Penalty of Rs 250 per incidence can also be imposed on any lapses of agency/his agent/driver like misbehaving, consumption of liquor/chewing or smoking tobacco on duty, refusal to provide service, non-working of AC etc.

2.8 <u>RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTRACTOR IN RESPECT OF LOCAL LAWS, EMPLOYMENT OF WORKERS ETC.</u>

The following are the responsibilities of the contractor in respect of observance of local laws, employment of personnel, payment of taxes etc. The subcontractor shall fully indemnify BHEL against any claims of whatsoever nature arising due to the failure of the contractor in discharging any of his responsibilities hereunder:

2.8.1 The contractor shall comply with all applicable State and Central Laws, Statutory Rules, Regulations, Notifications, etc. such as Payment of Wages Act, Minimum Wages Act, Workmen Compensation Act, Employer's Liability Act, Industrial Disputes Act, Employers Provident Act, Employees State Insurance Scheme, Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970, Payment of Bonus & Gratuity Act, Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996, The Building and

Other Construction Workers' Welfare Cess Act, 1996 and other Acts, Rules, and Regulations for labour/workers as applicable and as may be enacted by the State Government and Central Govt. during the tenure of the Contract and having force or jurisdiction at Site. The Contractor shall also comply with provisions of and give all such notices to the local Governing Body, Police and other relevant Authorities as may be required by the Law.

- **2.8.2** The contractor shall pay and bear all taxes, fees, license charges, Cess, duties, deposits, royalties, commission or other charges which may be leviable on account of his operations in executing the contract.
- **2.8.3** The contractor shall be responsible for the proper behavior and observance of all regulations by the staff employed by him.
- **2.8.4** The contractor shall ensure that no damage is caused to any person/property of other parties/employees working at site/office or on duty. If any such damage is caused, it is responsibility of the contractor to make good the losses or compensate for the same.
- 2.8.5 In case the contractor is required to undertake any work outside the scope of this contract, the rates payable shall be those mutually agreed upon if the item rates are not mentioned in existing contract

2.9 QUANTITY VARIATION

The quantities given in the contract are tentative and may change to any extent (both in plus side and minus side). The quoted rates for individual items shall remain firm irrespective of any variations in the individual quantities. No compensation becomes payable in case of variation in the final executed contract values.

2.10 PRICE VARIATION COMPENSATION

In order to take variation in cost of execution of work, the hiring-charges shall be subject to price adjustment/price variation due to increase /decrease in the prices of fuel (normal diesel as available in the Petrol Pumps in Noida) shall be effective from the date of variation in the price of diesel as per formula given below:

In case of award of contract, the hiring charges shall be subject to price adjustment/ price variation due to increase/ decrease in the prices of fuel (normal diesel as available in the Petrol Pumps in Noida) shall be effective from the date of variation in the price of diesel as per formula given below:

For Petrol/Diesel/CNG Vehicles:

(Revised rate of diesel as applicable in Noida on the 1st date of Each Quarter - Rate of diesel as applicable in Noida on the due date of tender submission) x 0.60 x 100

Price Variation will be calculated on the applicable rates of Hiring of Taxies as per the awarded rates in LOA.

Price Variation clause is only applicable for rate of Hiring of taxis as given on SI. No. A.1.1

and A.1.2 of Rate Schedule (Annexure-I) and on per km rate SI. No. A.1.3 of Rate Schedule (Annexure-I) and shall not be applicable for other items i.e. Extra Charges per Hour and Night Halt Charges per Night, etc.

PV clause will remain the same, whether taxi provided is Petrol, Diesel or CNG. The applicable rates as per above will be decided on 1st day of each quarter and will remain fixed for the whole quarter irrespective of variation of diesel prices within the quarter period.

2.11 INSURANCE

BHEL shall not entertain any claim arising out of mishap, if any, that may take place. The Service Provider shall be fully responsible for any loss or damage to the vehicles or occupants and shall be liable to pay full compensation for any injury or any other loss to the passengers or third party. The following insurance shall be maintained by the Service Provider at his cost.

The vehicles provided to BHEL must be fully and comprehensively insured. Insurance should be covering all risks as per applicable laws. This insurance shall protect the Service Provider and BHEL against all risks, claims for loss, injuries, disability, etc due to any act of omission or commission on the part of Service Provider, his agent/representative & sub-Service Providers. This insurance shall also cover all the liability of Service Provider arising out of the clause entitled 'Defence of Suits' below.

The above are only an illustrative list of insurance covers normally required and it will be the sole responsibility of Service Provider to maintain all necessary insurance coverage to the extent both in time and amount to take care of all his liabilities either direct or indirect in pursuance to the contract.

2.12 **FORCE MAJEURE**

- 2.12.1 "Force Majeure" shall mean any event beyond the reasonable control of the parties including but not limited to fire, flood, earthquake or other acts of God, war, riots, civil war and restraints of Governing States, as the case may be, and which is unavoidable notwithstanding the reasonable care of the party affected. The following events are explicitly excluded from Force Majeure and are solely the responsibilities of the non-performing party:

 a) any strike, work-to-rule action, go-slow or similar labour difficulty (b) late delivery of equipment or material (unless caused by Force Majeure event) and (c) economic hardship.
- 2.12.2 If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances thereof within 15 (fifteen) days after the occurrence of such event.
- 2.12.3 The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed. The Time for Completion shall be extended by a period of time equal to period of delay caused due to such Force Majeure event.
- **2.12.4** Delay or non-performance by either party hereto caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Majeure shall not
 - Constitute a default or breach of the Contract.

 Give rise to any claim for damages or additional cost or expense occasioned thereby, if and to the extent that such delay or non-performance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure.

2.13 ARBITRATION

2.13.1 Except as provided elsewhere in this Contract, in case amicable settlement is not reached between the Parties, in respect of any dispute or difference; arising out of the formation, breach, termination, validity or execution of the Contract; or, the respective rights and liabilities of the Parties; or, in relation to interpretation of any provision of the Contract; or, in any manner touching upon the Contract, then, either Party may, by a notice in writing to the other Party refer such dispute or difference to the arbitration of the sole arbitrator appointed by Head of the BHEL Power Sector Region issuing the Contract. It shall not be open to the Contractor to object to such arbitrator only on the ground that such arbitrator is an employee/ ex-employee of BHEL or has dealt with or has expressed any opinion on any issue touching upon the Contract.

The Arbitrator shall pass a reasoned award and the award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the Parties.

Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The seat of arbitration shall be New Delhi/ Delhi.

2.13.2 In case of Contract with Public Sector Enterprise (PSE) or a Government Department, the following shall be applicable-:

In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the Contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred by either Party for arbitration to the sole arbitrator in the Department of Public Enterprises to be nominated by the Secretary to the Government of India in-charge of the Department of Public Enterprises. The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall not be applicable to arbitration under this clause. The award of the arbitrator shall be binding upon the Parties to the dispute, provided, however, any Party aggrieved by such award may make further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law Secretary, Department of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary or Additional Secretary when so authorized by the Law Secretary, whose decision shall bind the Parties hereto finally and conclusively.

- 2.13.3 The cost of arbitration shall be borne equally by the Parties.
- 2.13.4 Notwithstanding the existence or any dispute or differences and / or reference for the arbitration, the Contractor shall proceed with and continue without hindrance the performance of its obligations under this Contract with due diligence and expedition in a professional manner.

2.14 TERMS OF PAYMENTS:

In case of award of work, 100% payment will generally be made on a monthly basis within 30 days after receipt of the computerized/manual bill in duplicate & verification within BHEL by actual user & certification by Officer-in-Charge for satisfactory completion of work. No advance money will be paid under any circumstances. Also no interest will be paid under any circumstances. Also no interest will be paid due to delay in making the payment.

BHEL shall settle the bills after deducting all liabilities of Contractor towards BHEL.

a) PAYMENTS:

The bills in duplicate along with log sheets/duty slips duly signed by the user of the vehicle or his representative should be sent to BHEL for its payment. It should be ensured that there is no overwriting in the log sheet/duty slip. Log sheet/duty slip without signature of the user at the specified places shall not be accepted for payment.

The maintenance cost, charges of fuel, road tax, insurance, challans, salary of the driver, the overtime of driver etc. are the responsibility of the contractor and will be borne by the contractor. BHEL will, however, reimburse toll taxes, state levies/ taxes for outstation journeys at actual on submission of receipts in original receipt along with the bill.

Parking charges, Toll Tax, Service Tax and DND payments (without service tax), as applicable from time to time shall be extra and borne as per actual by BHEL on submission of original receipt along with the bill. In case of hiring of commercial vehicles for use in NCR on daily basis, state entry taxes/levies (without service tax) shall also be payable at actual against production of original receipt along with the bill.

The last bill of the contractor after completion of works/services as per completion schedule/amendments (if any), will be treated as the Final Bill. Contractor shall submit the Indemnity bond (in the prescribed format) along with the final bill.

b) PAYMENT TO DRIVER:

Contractor shall be solely responsible for payment of wages/ salaries and allowances to his personnel that might become applicable under any act or order of Govt. from time to time during the validity of contract. BHEL shall have no liability whatsoever on this account (i.e. Statutory compliance with regard to vehicle and also the driver deployed including the wages, allowances, insurance and overtime charges etc. of the driver deployed).

c) PAYMENTS FOR LOCAL JOURNEYS:

The payment for local journeys will be regulated on the following basis:

Vehicle shall be hired either for Half Day (40 KMs 4 Hrs) or for Full Day (80 KMs 8 Hrs) as per the requirement and as per the instruction given at the time of booking.

- i. <u>For journeys upto 40 KMs & 4 hrs (Half Day)</u>: In case the usage is under 40 KMs & 4 HRs, the payment will be regulated as per A.1.2 of the Price Bid.
- ii. For journeys over and above 40 KMs & 4 hrs (Half Day) but less than 80 kms & 8 Hrs: For journeys beyond 40 KMs and upto 80 KMs & beyond 4 HRs & upto 8 HRs, the payment for the journeys will be regulated on the itemized rates finalised for item no. A.1.2 of the price Bid, along with additional amount payable for extra KM charges (Item No. A.1.3 of Price Bid) & extra hour charges (Item No. A.1.4 of Price Bid) as per actual subject to the overall amount as per Sr. No. A.1.1.
- iii. For journeys 80 KMs 8 hrs (Full Day) & beyond: For the journeys 80 KMs 8 Hrs. the payment will be regulated on the itemized rates finalized of the Price Bid A.1.1. For

journeys over & above 80 KMs 8 Hrs, Extra KMs or Extra Hrs or both shall be payable as per price bid itemized rates A.1.3 & A.1.4.

d) PAYMENT FOR OUTSTATION JOURNEYS:

For outstation journeys payment will be made as per actual KM travelled or 200 KMs per day whichever is higher. The per KM rate & night halt charges finalized in the Price Bid will also be applicable for the payment of outstation journeys.

Night halt charges will be made for daily as well as outstation journeys. NCR (Noida, Gurgaon, Delhi, Faridabad, Ghaziabad, Bawana, Jhajjar and other adjoining towns) will not be considered as "outstations".

3 **GENERAL**:

BHEL-PSNR has requirement of Registered AC Taxis (Petrol/Diesel/ CNG) of **three different segments**

- 1) Tata Indigo or Swift
- 2) Swift Dzire or Toyota Etios or Hyundai X-Cent or Honda Amaze
- 3) Innova

for company employees, Sr. Executives, Guests and VIP's including occasional requirement of taxis for local & outstation journeys on **DAILY** rate contract basis. BHEL-PSNR, therefore, intends to empanel reputed Taxi Operator/ Contractor on daily rate contract basis for a period of two years. The contractor is required to commence the work within seven days from the date of issue of LOA unless BHEL decides to fix any other date. All the work shall be carried out under the direction and to the satisfaction of BHEL.

4. SCOPE OF WORK:

- 4.1 The Contractor shall provide Registered AC Taxis of three different segments
 - 1) Tata Indigo or Swift
 - 2) Swift Dzire or Toyota Etios or Hyundai X-Cent or Honda Amaze
 - 3) Innova

of Petrol/diesel/CNG model not more than 24 months old (Date of Registration not before 01st January 2015). The cars shall be provided at our office premises at BHEL-PSNR (HQ) building, Plot No. 25, Sector-16A, Film city, Noida or at Advant, Sector-142, Noida Extension or at any other place intimated to the Contractor for travel within or outside Delhi. In case diesel taxis are not allowed in Delhi/NCR the vendor will provide Petrol/CNG taxis at the same applicable rates. The rates paid will be the same for Petrol, CNG or diesel taxi. In case of urgency, BHEL may accept non-commercial taxis.

4.2 The contractor shall provide taxies on **DAILY** rate contract basis 'as and when required'.

The anticipated business volume during the contract period of two years towards hiring of taxis shall be as per letter of award in respect of Hiring of Taxis for BHEL-PSNR Office.

The above figure will be indicative for this tender only & does not guarantee the business volume for the contract period of two years. This may increase or decrease depending upon BHEL-PSNR actual requirements.

4.3 The contractor shall provide drivers with adequate knowledge of reading, writing and speaking English/Hindi and in proper uniform having knowledge of different routes as well as minor repair of cars and holding valid driving license. The drivers deputed for duty should be polite and must

possess positive attitude in discharging their duty. The reporting time, place, address etc. should be strictly followed by Contractor.

- 4.4 The vehicles provided by the contractor must be in excellent condition and must have proper and complete documents such as RC book/ Insurance/ Road Tax Receipt/ Border Tax in original. The vehicles should comply strictly with the provision of pollution control in line with the directions of Supreme Court regarding pollution norms and regulations from time to time and should also comply with statutory regulations issued by State Transport Authorities/ Central Government. BHEL shall in no way be responsible for any liability arising due to non-compliance of statutory requirements/ regulations w.r.t. the vehicle as well as the driver. The contractor must also provide a mobile phone to the driver of the vehicle sent for duty.
- 4.5 The contractor should be capable of providing taxis round the clock even at the short notice of half an hour. However, in general sufficient time will be given, but in quite often incidences taxis should have to be provided at a notice of half an hour.
 - In case of non-availability of requisitioned car, it will be the responsibility of the Contractor to provide higher segment cars [not more than 24 months old (Date of Registration not before 01.01.2015)] at the same rate.
 - In case vehicle is not provided within the stipulated time period as above, BHEL may hire the taxies from other sources at the risk and cost of the contractor.
- 4.6 The contractor shall maintain the log sheet/ duty slip as per Performa (to be provided) for every trip/ requisition. The log sheet/ duty slip should be got signed by the driver from the user at the end of each journey which would indicate the opening and the closing meter reading with point of starting/ ending of the journey by the user.
- 4.7 In case of breakdown/ servicing/ repair, the contractor shall provide alternate vehicle of the same make & model within one hour, failing which the vehicle shall be hired from other sources at the risk and cost of the contractor.
- 4.8 Charges on the principle of "Garage-to-Garage" basis as per actual distance will be permissible in respect of the journeys starting from places other than BHEL-PSNR building at Noida, Sector 16A and at Advant, Sec-142, Noida Extension.

However, the journeys starting from and up to BHEL-PSNR (HQ) building at Noida, sector 16A and Advant Office at Sec-142, Noida, garage-to-garage KMs for each side would be restricted to maximum of 10 KMs or the actual distance between BHEL-PSNR building at Noida/ Advant Office at Sec-142, Noida and the garage of the contractor, whichever is lower.

- 4.9 Details of payment on account of extra hours & extra usage charges are given in the price bid format.
- 4.10 BHEL reserves the right to verify the correctness of any of the document like Service Tax Registration no., Vehicle Registration Certificate, etc. submitted by the bidder and also the fleet.

5. **VALIDITY OF CONTRACT**:

The contract will be valid for a period of <u>two years</u>. The same may however be extended further for a period of **two/three years** or part thereof with mutual agreement, in writing, on the same rate and terms & conditions based on the performance of contractor.

6. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:

Notwithstanding anything contained in any other clause, should the agency in any manner fail to perform the obligations under the agreement or its performance in the opinion of BHEL is unsatisfactory then in that case, BHEL may without prejudice to its other rights and remedies terminate this agreement forthwith without assigning any reason whatsoever, by giving 7 days' notice in writing. The notice will be deemed to have been served as and when sent to the address given in the offer.

On the expiry of the agreement or earlier termination of it, the agency shall deliver to BHEL all materials, paper etc. and all other things belonging to or entrusted by BHEL to the agency.

7. TAXES, DUTIES, and LEVIES

7.1 The contractor shall pay all (save the specific exclusions as enumerated in this contract) taxes, fees, license charges, deposits, duties, tools, royalty, ommissions or other charges which may be levied on the input goods & services consumed and output goods & services delivered in course of his operations in executing the contract. In case BHEL is forced to pay any of such taxes, BHEL shall have the right to recover the same from his bills or otherwise as deemed fit. However, provisions regarding Service Tax on output service on goods shall be as per following clauses.

7.2 Service Tax, Swachh Bharat Cess and Krishi Kalyan Cess

- 7.2.1 Service Tax, Swachh Bharat Cess and Krishi Kalyan Cess as applicable on output Services are excluded from contractor's scope; therefore contractor's price/rates shall be **exclusive** of Service Tax, Swachh Bharat Cess and Krishi Kalyan Cess.
- 7.2.2 Contractor shall obtain prior written consent of BHEL before billing the amount towards such taxes. Where the Service Tax Act permit more than one option or methodology for discharging the liability of tax/levy/duty, BHEL will have the right to adopt the appropriate one considering the amount of tax liability on BHEL/Client as well as procedural simplicity with regard to assessment of the liability. The option chosen by BHEL shall be binding on the Contractor for discharging the obligation of BHEL in respect of the tax liability to the Contractor. Contractor shall submit to BHEL documentary evidence of Service Tax registration certificate specifying name of services covered under this contract.

7.2.3 For the purpose of claiming any Service Tax, Swachh Bharat Cess and Krishi Kalyan Cess from BHEL, the following procedure shall be adopted:

- 7.2.3.1 Contractor shall submit serially numbered Service Tax, Swachh Bharat Cess and Krishi Kalyan Cess Invoices, signed by him or a person authorized by him in respect of taxable service provided, and shall contain the following, namely:
- 7.2.3.1.1 The name, address and registration number of the contractor
- 7.2.3.1.2 The name and address of the party receiving taxable service (BHEL)
- 7.2.3.1.3 Description, classification and value of taxable service provided and
- 7.2.3.1.4 The Service Tax, Swachh Bharat Cess and Krishi Kalyan Cess payable thereon.
- 7.2.3.1.5 The service invoice for output services provided should show service tax, the SBC and Krishi Kalyan Cess amount separately.
- 7.2.4 All the five conditions shall be fulfilled in the invoice for payment of Service Tax, Swachh Bharat Cess and Krishi Kalyan Cess by BHEL. Where more than one nature of Service as

per Service Tax act is involved in the execution of contract, the invoice mentioned above shall contain the breakup of values for each nature of Service.

- 7.2.5 Name and address of the Contractor should be same in the service tax invoice and monthly bill as it is in the service tax registration certificate. Any change in the name and address should be supported by documentary evidence duly certified by the authorized signatory.
- 7.2.6 Purpose of above requirements, inter-alia, is to enable availment of Cenvat credit by BHEL. As per recent amendments, Time restrictions for taking Cenvat credit is one year from date of invoice. Hence subcontractor must submit its invoice within 30 days from the date of completion of service. Wherever Cenvat credit could not be availed by BHEL within statutory time limit of 12 months due to delay in submission of invoices or for any other reasons attributable to contractors, Liability towards loss of such Cenvat credit shall be passed on to sub-contractors.
- 7.2.7 The documentary evidence of deposition of service tax, Swachh Bharat Cess and Krishi Kalyan Cess is to be submitted at the earliest opportunity.
- 7.2.8 The payment of service tax, Swachh Bharat Cess and Krishi Kalyan Cess as per clause no 7.2 is restricted to the direct transactions between BHEL & its sub-contractor only.

7.3 Modalities of Tax Incidence on BHEL

7.3.1 Wherever the relevant tax laws permit more than one option or methodology for discharging the liability of tax/levy/duty, BHEL will have the right to adopt the appropriate one considering the amount of tax liability on BHEL/Client as well as procedural simplicity with regard to assessment of the liability. The option chosen by BHEL shall be binding on the Contractor for discharging the obligation of BHEL in respect of the tax liability to the Contractor.

7.4 New Taxes/Levies

- 7.4.1 In case the Government imposes any new levy/tax on the output service/ goods/work after award of the contract, the same shall be reimbursed by BHEL at actual. The reimbursement under this clause is restricted to the direct transaction between BHEL and its subcontractor only.
- 7.4.2 In case any new tax/levy/duty etc. becomes applicable after the date of Bidder's offer, the Bidder/Contractor must convey its impact on his price duly substantiated by documentary evidence in support of the same before opening of Price Bid. Claim for any such impact after opening the Price Bid will not be considered by BHEL for reimbursement of tax or reassessment of offer.

8. **DEVIATION**:

The contractor must comply with the tender specification and all terms and conditions of contract. No deviation shall normally be entertained. BHEL reserves the right to reject any or all quotations without assigning any reason whatsoever.

9. **EVALUATION CRITERIA:**

- a) BHEL's "Schedule of Hiring Rates" for different model cars is enclosed (Reference Annexure-I).
- b) Bidders shall quote the rates (in percentage) as per Price Bid Performa (Annexure-I).
- c) The bidders are required to fill % Above OR Below OR same in the box provided in the Format. Bidders may please note that they have to fill only one % figure, i.e. either for %

Above OR Below OR Zero which will be applicable for all model cars required in DAILY basis.

- d) Technical Bids submitted by the tenderer will be opened first and evaluated for fulfilling the Pre-Qualification Criteria and other conditions in NIT/ Tender documents, based on documentary evidences submitted along with the offer.
- e) Price Bids of shortlisted bidders shall only be opened through the conventional price bid opening at the discretion of BHEL.
- f) Price Bids of unqualified bidders shall not be opened. Reasons for rejection shall be intimated in due course after issue of LOI/LOA to successful bidder and receipt of unconditional acceptance from the successful bidder.

10. <u>DEFENCE SUITS:</u>

If any action in court is brought by third party against BHEL or an officer or agent of BHEL for the failure or neglect on the part of Service Provider to perform any acts, matter, covenants or things under the contract or for any damage or injury caused by the alleged omission' or negligence on the part of Service Provider, his agent/representative or his sub Service Providers, or drivers, the Service Provider shall in all such case be responsible and indemnify and keep BHEL and/or its representative harmless from all losses, damages, expenses or decrees arising out of such action

11. LABOUR REGULATIONS/REGISTRATION AND DOCUMENTS:

- a) Service Provider shall abide by and follow the State and Central Government labour Laws/legislation, rules and regulations, statutory notifications, local self Government/ Municipal requirements and shall solely be responsible for any breach thereof. Service Provider shall completely indemnify BHEL, its officers / employees against any penalties/ prosecutions consequent to the violation (deliberate or inadvertent) of such statutory provisions that are in force.
- b) The Service Provider shall obtain at his own cost, necessary permits, license, etc., as required under various laws from time to time for rendering the necessary services and the BHEL does not take any liability whatsoever on that account.
- c) The Service Providers shall at its own cost comply with the provisions of all laws, Rules, Orders and Regulations and Notifications whether central or state or local as applicable to him or to this contract from time to time. These Acts/Rules include, without limitation, the following:
 - 1) Minimum Wages Act, 1948 and Rules & order and Notifications issued there under from time to time.
 - 2) Contract labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act-1970 with rules, orders and notifications made there under from time to time.
 - 3) Industrial Dispute Act-1947 with rules, orders and notifications issued there under from time to time.
 - 4) The Workmen's Compensation Act 1923 with rules, orders and notifications issued there under from time to time.

- 5) Motor Transport Workers Act 1961 with rules, order and notifications issued there under from time to time.
- 6) Payment of Gratuity Act 1972 with rules, order and notifications issued there under from time to time.
- 7) Service Provider shall obtain a certificate from ALC (C) regarding Labour License.
- 8) Payment of Bonus Act 1965 with rules, order and notifications issued there under from time to time.
- 9) Payment of Wages Act 1936 with rules, order and notifications issued there under from time to time.
- 10) Employees Provident Fund & Misc. Provisions Act 1952 with rules, order and notifications issued there under from time to time.
- 11) ESI Act with rules, order and notifications issued there under from time to time.
- 12) Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and the central/state rules as applicable.
- 13) All other Acts/Rules/Regulations, Bye-laws, other notifications etc. as applicable to the Service Provider or to this contract from time to time shall be applicable. Orders Notifications etc. presents or future as applicable to the Service Provider or to this contract from time to time, for providing necessary service/performing the aforesaid jobs.

All employees/personal deployed by Service Provider shall be the employees of the Service Provider.

BHEL will not have any liability to absorb them at any point of time nor can they claim any right for employment in BHEL. The Service Providers shall be responsible for any/all disputes arising between him and his personnel and keep BHEL indemnified by all loses, damages and claims arising thereof.

12. ACCIDENTS/DAMAGES/CLAIMS LIABILITIES

- a) In event of any accident or damages while vehicle(s) is on BHEL's duty, BHEL shall be completely free from any liability of any nature connected with the accident/ damage(s). Service Provider himself will be fully and exclusively responsible for any damage to vehicle(s) or any personal injury to driver or any other person in employment of Service Provider, occupants of vehicle(s) or any person(s) or damage to any property or person. This includes any third party claims. However, if damage or loss is incurred to BHEL and/or its employees, as a result of any accident or any other reason involving failure of vehicle(s) /driver, sustain any damage, Service Provider shall reimburse on demand and without any demur the compensation/damages to BHEL and/or BHEL employee(s).
- b) BHEL shall not be responsible for any claim/compensation that arises due to damages/ injuries/ pilferage to the Service Provider's vehicle(s)/property, under any circumstances while the vehicle(s) is engaged for BHEL's duty.
- c) Service Provider may safeguard his interest through insurance at his own cost. However, BHEL's claim cannot be linked with payment by any such insurance(s) and Service Provider shall directly be liable to pay BHEL's claim. BHEL's claim can also not be linked with the outcome of the verdict of any tribunal or judicial authority, where the case might be pending.

- d) It is the responsibility of Service Provider to inform the user of vehicle as well as transport coordinator, the occurrence of any accident involving his vehicle(s), as early as possible to avoid any disruption of BHEL's operation, and provide substitute and submit a detailed report to transport coordinator within 24 hours for record of BHEL. The vehicle/site of accident may have to be inspected by representatives of BHEL in such an eventuality. Any information of accident to the statutory authorities as per rules will also be the responsibility of the contractor.
- e) Absence of vehicle due to accident may not be entitled for any exemptions from liabilities of contract, whatsoever. Arrangement of alternative/substitute is responsibility of Service Provider unless otherwise exempted for reasons beyond Service Provider's control.

13. SUSPENSION OF BUSINESS DEALINGS

BHEL reserves the right to take action against Contractors who either fail to perform or Tenderers/Contractor who indulge in malpractices, by suspending business dealings with them in line with BHEL guidelines issued from time to time.

14. DEFAULT/BREACH OFCONTRACT. INSOLVENCY AND RISK PURCHASE

a) If the Service Provider / Contractor fails to provide the required services as per the Contract / fails to deliver the services or goods or materials or any instalment thereof (as per contract) within the period(s) fixed for such delivery or delivers goods or materials not of the contracted quality and failing to adhere to the contract specifications or at any time repudiates or otherwise abandons the contract before expiry of such period or refuses or is unable to supply / provide goods / services or materials covered by the Order/Contract either in whole or in part or otherwise fails to perform the Order/Contract or commits any breach of the Order/Contract not herein specifically provided for or in the event of the death or insanity or if the Seller/Contractor being an individual or if a firm on a partnership thereof, shall at any time, be adjudged insolvent or shall have a receiving order for administration of his estate made against him or shall take any proceeding for composition under any Insolvency Act for the time being in force or make any assignment of the Order/Contract or enter into any arrangement or composition with his creditors or suspend payment or if the firm dissolved under the Partnership Act or if the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) being a company is wound up voluntarily or by order of a Court or a Receiver. Liquidator or Manager on behalf of the debenture holders and creditors is appointed or circumstances shall have arisen which entitles the Court of debenture holder and creditors to appoint a receiver, liquidator or manager, the purchaser without prejudice to his right to recover any expenses, losses or damages to which the purchaser may be put to incur or sustain by reason of the Seller/Contractor's default or breach of Order/Contract shall be entitled to cancel the Order/Contract either in whole or portion thereof without compensation to the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) and if the purchaser so desires, he may procure upon such terms and in such manner as he deems appropriate, stores / services not so delivered or others of a similar description where stores / services exactly complying with particulars are not, in the opinion of the purchaser, which shall be final, readily procurable, at the risk and cost of the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) and the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) shall be liable to the purchaser for any excess costs provided that the Seller/Contractor

(Service Provider] shall continue the performance of the Order/Contract to the extent not cancelled under the provisions of this clause. The Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) shall on no account be entitled to any gain on such repurchases.

b) Cost of the purchases made or services taken by the Purchaser at the risk and cost of the seller/contractor (Service Provider) shall be worked out after levying applicable overheads as departmental charges on the cost of materials / services so purchased/hired.
