1.0	The bidder is required to meet the following qualification requirement for CHEMICAL DOSING SYSTEM: a) The bidder should have designed, supplied, fabricated at least one (1) number CHEMICAL DOSING SYSTEM for at least one thermal power plant of 500 MW/ above capacity or which has completed one year of commercial operation and the equipment supplied should have completed the contractual guarantee period or should have supplied the equipment of rating/type/size as required under this contract to any power plant of any rating. The above system should have been in successful operation for minimum one year as on 06.08.2018.
2.0	The supplier has to submit following supporting documents meeting above mentioned pre-qualifying requirement: Copy of minimum one (1) performance certificate in English from end user along with date of commissioning in support of PQR clause mentioned at S.No. 1.0 above. or Copy of despatch document to establish that the system being supplied has been duly inspected by customer/third party inspection agency along with date of commissioning in support of PQR clause mentioned at S.No. 1.0 above.
3.0	Bidder shall submit design documents to substantiate technical parameters specified in PQR, if the same is not mentioned in performance certificate/purchase order.
4.0	Minimum one (1) no. Purchase order shall be submitted which should not be more than seven (7) years old as on date of bid submission, for establishing continuity in business. This is over and above the requirement of PO mentioned at S.No. 2.0 above.
5.0	Bidder to submit all supporting documents in English. If documents submitted by bidder are in language other than English, a self-attested English translated document should also be submitted.
6.0	Notwithstanding anything stated above, BHEL reserve the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the bidder/ collaborator to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of BHEL.
7.0	Consideration of offer shall be subject to customer's approval of bidder, if applicable.
8.0	After satisfactory fulfilment of all the above criteria/ requirement, offer shall be considered for further evaluation as per NIT and all other terms of the tender.
