The Bidder/ bidder's sub vendor (s) should have designed, manufactured, erected and commissioned COLTCS with ball collecting strainer having diameter of not less than 2100 mm, which should have been in successful operation in at least five (5) units for a period not less than two (2) years prior to 22.09.15 and bidder is in business of COLTCS on continuous basis.	
	2. The Bidders shall furnish following support documents for assessment of Bidder w.r.t. PQR as indicated at Sl. No. 1 above: A. Bidder's Experience list of COLTCS for last 5 years (as on the enquiry/NIT date) for assessment of bidder for supplying the COLTCS on regular basis for establishing business continuity in enclosed format- Annexure-1. Bidder shall furnish the PO copy of at least one executed Contract as indicated in the experience list. B. Bidder shall furnish satisfactory Performance feedback certificates from End Customer (Owner) (in English) for at least five (5) units of successfully executed contract(s) which have been in use for at least two (2) year indicating salient features like year of commissioning of COLTCS, rating of project, Size of COLTCS, project name etc., date of issue of certificate and name/ designation of the certificate issuer for power plant/similar application industry. The date of satisfactory performance feedback certificate should not be later than 22.09.15.	
	Notes:- N1 - Purchase order copy, supporting drgs/technical data sheets etc. are to be submitted along with the bid for which the bidder intends to furnish the performance feedbacks for reference purpose only. Any additional document required in support of above documents to establish the correlation between the above documents and the supplied item shall be provided by the bidder.	
	3. Bidder to submit all supporting documents in English, If documents submitted by bidder are in language other than English, a self-attested English translated document should also be submitted.
