PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS

Name of Work: Route survey and geo-technical investigation for Transmission Line projects at Unchahar, Balaghat, Badnawar and Nabinagar

Sealed Tenders (Under two part bid system) are invited for route survey and geo-technical investigation for Transmission Line projects at Unchahar, Balaghat, Badnawar and Nabinagar. Only those who are technically and financially capable to execute the Job and who fulfill the Pre-Qualifying Requirements [PQR] given under are eligible to quote against the above NIT. Tenderers should submit their offer in a sealed envelope as per the procedure specified in tender documents. The PQR of contractor for tender submission shall be as under:

FINANCIAL

1. Bidder should have a minimum average annual turnover of. Rs. 2 Lakhs and should submit audited balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account for last three years (2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14 or 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2014-15). In case audited balance sheet is not available due to turnover being less than statutory requirement of audit, bidder should furnish self certified copies of Balance Sheet, Profit & Loss account along with income tax returns of these years.
2. Bidder should have successfully executed similar (refer note a & b below) job during last seven years ending 30.04.2015. Bidder should produce certification/proof in support of execution of similar package from user/end user and should be either of the following:

One similar work executed costing (except service tax) not less than Rs. 5.2 Lakhs

OR

Two similar works executed costing (except service tax) not less than Rs. 3.3 Lakhs each

OR

Three similar works executed costing (except service tax) not less than Rs. 2.6 Lakhs each

3. Bidder should have earned profit in at least one year during last three financial years (2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14 or 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2014-15).

Notes:

- a) Similar Works: Similar works shall mean successfully executed Route Survey, Tower Spotting and profiling work of 220kV or above rating transmission line.
- b) The word 'executed' means the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified above even if the total contract has not been completed or closed.

TECHNICAL

1. Bidder should have route surveyed and done tower spotting and profiling work for at least 3 projects of 220kV or higher kV transmission lines in last 7 years and out of these at least one project should be of 400 kV. The minimum line length of the projects undertaken must be 5km for at least one of above projects.
2. The bidder should have successfully executed geo-tech. investigation work.

Important Notes

1. If the qualifying work is executed in the last seven years period, as specified above, even if it has been started earlier, the same will also be considered meeting the qualifying requirements.
2. The bidder shall submit the work order/LOI, BOQ and performance/ completion/ execution certificate issued by Customer/ Contractor along with technical bid.
3. Consortium/ JV bidding is not allowed.
4. BHEL reserves the right to:
 - (a) Accept or reject any bid received at its discretion without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
 - (b) Postpone the above mentioned date, split and distribute the work among more than one bidder without assigning any reason whatsoever.
 - (c) May ask for further qualification during techno commercial scrutiny of bids received.
 - (d) May ask for further proofs including TDS certificates/ Final bill/ payment detail for the said job for cross- verification.
5. BHEL shall not be responsible for any delay, loss, damage for bids sent by post.
6. BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by bidder in preparation of bid irrespective of whether it is accepted or not.
7. Quotations received from bidders who do not fulfil the PQR shall be summarily rejected without any further evaluation and information to bidders.
8. Canvassing i.e. soliciting favour, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
9. If the bidder deliberately gives any wrong information in his tender to create in circumstances for the acceptance to his bid, BHEL reserves the right to reject such application.
10. Bidder's selection is subject to approval of BHEL's customer for this work.
11. All corrigenda, addenda, amendments and clarifications to this Tender will be hosted in web page, www.bhel.com and not in the newspaper. Bidders shall keep themselves updated with all such amendments.
