

PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS

SUB: TENDER FOR EXECUTION AND HANDING OVER OF SUPPLY, CIVIL, ERECTION, TESTING AND COMMISSIONING WORK OF 220KV TRANSMISSION LINE AT NORTH KARANPURA IN JHARKHAND.

Pre-Qualifying Requirements of bidder for subject work shall be as under:

A. Turnover:

Bidder should have a minimum average annual turnover of **Rs. 504 lacs** for last three fin. years (2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14 OR 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2014-15) and should submit audited balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account Sheet of these years.

B. Similar work executed:

Bidder should have successfully executed similar job (ref note below) during last seven years ending 31.01.16 and should be either of the following:

1.1 Three similar jobs executed costing (except service tax) not less than **Rs. 672 lacs each.**

OR

1.2 Two similar jobs executed costing (except service tax) not less than **Rs. 840 lacs each.**

OR

1.3 One similar job executed costing (except service tax) not less than **Rs. 1344 lacs.**

C. Bidder (standalone/ both consortium partners) should have earned profit in at least one year during the last three financial years for which turnover has been considered in 'A' above.

D. Bidder should submit solvency certificate (not older than 12 months from date of tender notification) issued by any scheduled bank. The Standalone/ Prime bidder of consortium partner should be solvent with a solvency of minimum Rs. 4 Crs.

Note:

1. For Standalone bidder

1.1 Similar job shall mean: The bidder should have successfully executed complete work (Supply, Civil, & erection) of transmission line of 220kV rating or above voltage class.

1.2 Cost of similar works for fulfilling financial criteria shall mean sum total of executed value of:

(i) Civil and erection portion of work order/ purchase order of a particular project.
and

(ii) Supply portion (lattice type tower and other supply component of transmission line) of work order/ purchase order of a particular project.

2. For Consortium Bidder

2.1 Similar job shall mean: The bidder should have:

2.1.1 Successfully executed civil & erection work of transmission line towers of 220 kV rating or above voltage class.

OR

2.1.2 Fabricated/ supplied at least 400MT lattice type towers for a particular project.

AND

- 2.1.3 Should have consortium with another bidder/supplier having requisite credential (as per 2.1.1 or 2.1.2 above) to meet the value of similar jobs mentioned in Sl. No. B above. In this case executed value of supply/ civil & erection portion of purchase order/ work order of both consortium partners shall be considered for meeting the turn over and value of similar job mentioned at sl. A and B respectively.
- 2.2 Consortium bidder should specify the Prime bidder of consortium in their bid, else the bidder who has the major share of work shall be considered as prime bidder.
- 2.3 Both partners of consortium bidder should submit audited balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account Sheet of last three fin. years (2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14 OR 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2014-15).

Other Important Notes:

1. The word 'executed' means the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified in the PQR even if the total contract has not been completed or closed.
2. If the qualifying work is executed in the last seven years period, as specified above, even if it has been started earlier, the same will also be considered meeting the qualifying requirements.
3. The bidder shall submit the Contract Agreement/ Work Order/LOI and performance/ completion/ execution certificate issued by Customer/ Contractor along with technical bid.
4. Standalone bidder:-The bidder who fulfils all the PQR stipulated above for standalone bidder on their own without any consortium partner.
5. Bidders not satisfying the conditions above for standalone bidder can have consortium for supply/ Civil & erection work of transmission line.
6. Consortium bidder: - The bidder who enters into a consortium agreement with another bidder in order to fulfill the PQR.
7. Prime Bidder and Consortium Partner are required to enter into a consortium agreement with a validity period of six months initially. In case the consortium is awarded the contract, then the Consortium Agreement between the Prime Bidder and Consortium Partner or partners shall be extended till contractual completion period including extension periods if any applicable.
8. Stand alone' bidder cannot become a 'Prime Bidder' or a 'Consortium bidder' in consortium bidding. Prime bidder shall neither be a consortium partner to other prime bidder nor take any other consortium partners. However, consortium partner may enter into consortium agreement with other prime bidders. In case of non compliance, consortium bids of such Prime bidders will be rejected.
9. Number of partners including prime bidder shall not be more than 2 (Two).
10. In case customer approval is required, then Prime Bidder and Consortium Partner shall have to be individually approved by Customer for being considered for the tender.
11. Prime Bidder shall be responsible for the overall execution of the contract.

12. The consortium partner shall submit SD equivalent to 2% of the total contract value in addition to the SD to be submitted by the prime Bidder for the total contract value.
13. In case the Consortium partner back out, their SD shall be encashed by BHEL. In such a case, other consortium partner meeting the PQR have to be engaged by the Prime Bidder, and if not, the respective work will be withdrawn and executed on risk and cost basis of the Prime Bidder. The new consortium partner shall submit fresh SD as applicable.
14. In case the prime bidder withdraws, the whole contract shall be considered cancelled and balance work will be executed at risk & cost of bidders (Prime bidder + Consortium partner)
15. BHEL reserves the right to:
 - (a) Accept or reject any bid received at its discretion without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
 - (b) Postpone the above mentioned date, split and distribute the work among more than one bidder without assigning any reason whatsoever.
 - (c) May ask for further qualification during techno commercial scrutiny of bids received.
 - (d) May ask for further proofs including TDS certificates/ Form 26AS/ Final bill/ payment detail for the said job for cross- verification.
16. BHEL shall not be responsible for any delay, loss, damage for bids sent by post.
17. BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by bidder in preparation of bid irrespective of whether it is accepted or not.
18. Quotations received from bidders who do not fulfil the PQR shall be summarily rejected without any further evaluation and information to bidders.
19. Canvassing i.e. soliciting favour, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
20. If the bidder deliberately gives any wrong information in his tender to create in circumstances for the acceptance to his bid, BHEL reserves the right to reject such application.
21. Bidder's selection is subject to approval of BHEL's customer for this work.
