**SUB: TENDER FOR “RECEIPT OF EQUIPMENT/MATERIAL AT SITE, UNLOADING, RECONCILIATION, INSPECTION, VERIFICATION, STORAGE, UP-KEEPING DURING STORAGE, ERECTION, TESTING, COMMISSIONING AND HANDING OVER OF 400/220/132KV GIS SUBSTATION AT RASRA, BALLIA IN UTTAR PRADESH”.**

Only those bidders who are technically and financially capable to execute the subject Job and who fulfil the Pre-Qualifying Requirements [PQR] given under are eligible to quote against the above NIT. Tenderers should submit their offer along with credentials in a sealed envelope as per the procedure specified in tender documents.

The PQR for subject tender shall be as under:

Sl. No.	Criteria	Description
A	Turn Over	Vendors should have a minimum average annual turnover of <b>Rs. 82,26,625/-</b> for last three fin. Years (2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18 OR 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19) and should submit audited balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account Sheet of these years. In case audited balance sheet is not available due to turnover being less than statutory requirement of audit, bidder should furnish self-certified copies of Balance Sheet, Profit & Loss account along with income tax returns and form 26AS of these years.
B	Profit	Vendor should have earned profit in at least one year during last three financial years as mentioned in A above
C	Similar Job	Vendor should have successfully executed similar* job (ref note below) during last seven years ending 31.10.2019 and should be either of the following:  i. <b>Three similar jobs executed costing (except service tax/GST) not less than Rs. 109,68,834/- each.</b> OR ii. <b>Two similar jobs executed costing (except service tax/GST) not less than Rs. 137,11,042/- each.</b> OR iii. <b>One similar job executed costing (except service tax/ GST) not less than Rs. 219,37,668/-.</b>

**NOTE:**

1. **Similar\* job shall mean:**

The Bidder should have successfully executed

- i) ETC\* work of 220 kV or above voltage rating AIS/GIS Substations

**OR**

- ii) Electrical works comprising of ETC\* works of transformer (at least 50 MVA) / reactor (at least 50MVAR), structural work, erection of HV/LV panels in Power Plant

**Note: - \* ETC means successful erection, testing and commissioning /Pre-commissioning**

2. Documents for compliance of above requirement shall be as follows:-
  - i) Contract Agreement/ Work Order/LOI along with BOQ
  - ii) performance/ completion/ execution certificate issued by Customer/ Contractor

The bidder shall submit the above documents along with their technical bid in support of qualification.

3. The word 'executed' means the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified in the PQR even if the total contract has not been completed or closed. Executed value of erection portion of work order shall be considered for evaluation against PQR.
4. In order to technically qualify in this tender, bidder should meet all criteria i.e. a, b & c mentioned above.
5. If the job is executed in the last seven years period, as specified above (job mentioned at Sl. No. c), even if it has been started earlier, the same will also be considered meeting the qualifying requirements.

**Note:**

**1. For Standalone bidder**

**1.1 Similar job shall mean:**

The Bidder should have successfully executed

- i) ETC\* work of 220 kV or above voltage rating AIS/GIS Substations

OR

- ii) Electrical works comprising of ETC\* works of transformer (at least 50 MVA) / reactor (at least 50MVAR), structural work, erection of HV/LV panels in Power Plant

**Note: - \* ETC means successful erection, testing and commissioning /Pre-commissioning**

**2. For Consortium Bidder**

Consortium bidding is allowed for subject tender.

- 2.1 If a bidder is not qualified on standalone basis, then the Prime bidder can have a consortium with another bidder to meet the PQR.

**Meaning of Consortium bidding**

- (i) In case the prime bidder has experience of erection work and no experience of testing and commissioning work. Then the prime bidder having experience of erection work can form a consortium with another bidder having experience of testing and commissioning work.
- (ii) In case the prime bidder has experience of erection & testing and no experience of commissioning work. Then the prime bidder having experience of erection & testing work can form a consortium with another bidder having experience of commissioning work.
- (iii) In case of consortium bidding, sum of executed value of erection, Testing & Commissioning portion of work order of both consortium partners shall be considered for meeting the value of similar job at Sl. No. "c" and the combined Turn Over of both consortium partners shall be considered for minimum average annual turnover mentioned at Sl. No. "a"

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- (iv) For the purpose of meeting the criteria mentioned at Sl. No. "b" is considered for Prime bidder only.
- 2.2 Consortium bidder should specify the Prime bidder of consortium in their bid, else the bidder who has the major share of work shall be considered as prime bidder.
- 2.3 Both partners of consortium bidder should submit audited balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account Sheet of last three fin. Years (2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18 OR 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19).
- 6. In order to technically qualify in this tender, bidder/consortium should meet all criteria i.e. a, b & c mentioned above.
- 7. Standalone bidder:-The bidder who fulfils all the PQR stipulated above standalone on their own without any consortium partner.
- 8. Consortium bidder: - The bidder who enters into a consortium agreement with another bidder in order to fulfill the PQR.
  - 8.1 Prime Bidder and Consortium Partner are required to enter into a consortium agreement with a validity period of six months initially. In case the consortium is awarded the contract, then the Consortium Agreement between the Prime Bidder and Consortium Partner or partners shall be extended till contractual completion period including extension periods if any applicable.
- 9. Standalone bidder cannot become a 'Prime Bidder' or a 'Consortium bidder' in consortium bidding. Prime bidder shall neither be a consortium partner to other prime bidder nor take any other consortium partners. However, consortium partner may enter into consortium agreement with other prime bidders. In case of non-compliance, consortium bids of such Prime bidders will be rejected.
- 10. Number of partners including prime bidder shall not be more than 2 (Two).
- 11. In case customer approval is required, then customer approval of Prime bidder shall be taken from Customer and regarding the consortium bidder information shall be given to customer.
- 12. Prime Bidder shall be responsible for the overall execution of the contract.
- 13. In case the Consortium partner back out, other consortium partner meeting the PQR have to be engaged by the Prime Bidder, and if not, the respective work will be withdrawn and executed on risk and cost basis of the Prime Bidder.
- 14. In case the prime bidder withdraws, the whole contract shall be considered cancelled and balance work will be executed at risk & cost of Prime bidder.
