Sealed Tenders (Under two part bid system) are invited from competent Transmission line contractors for subject works. Only those who are technically and financially capable to execute the subject Job and who fulfil the Pre-Qualifying Requirements [PQR] given under are eligible to quote against the above NIT. Tenderers should submit their offer in a sealed envelope as per the procedure specified in tender documents. The PQR of contractor for tender submission shall be as under:

Sl. No.	Criteria	Description
A	Turn Over	Vendor should have a minimum average annual turnover of Rs. 862,00,093/- for last three fin. Years 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19 OR 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20) and should submit audited balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account Sheet of these years. In case audited balance sheet is not available due to turnover being less than statutory requirement of audit, bidder should furnish self-certified copies of Balance Sheet, Profit & Loss account along with income tax returns.
B	Profit	Vendor should have earned profit in at least one year during last three financial years as mentioned in A above.
C	Similar Work	Vendor should have successfully executed and commissioned 110kV or above voltage class Over Head Transmission Line on Turnkey basis as a prime contractor or single point responsibility basis within last seven (7) years ending on 31.10.2020 and the same should be in satisfactory operation for at least one year from the date of its commissioning and should be either of the following:- i. Three similar jobs executed costing (except service tax/GST) not less than Rs. 1149,33,458/- each. OR ii. Two similar jobs executed costing (except service tax/GST) not less than Rs. 1436,66,822/- each. OR iii. One similar job executed costing (except service tax/GST) not less than Rs. 2298,66,915/-
D	Additional Requirement	The following must be complied by the bidder in addition to the requirement mentioned at Point no. C. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Transmission Line work/project should have been executed for any Central/State Power Utilities, PSUs, Pvt. Utilities within India. • The bidder should have experience of Route Survey, Tower Spotting, erection and stringing, construction and settlement of ROW etc.

		<p>The bidder shall submit self-attested detailed order copies & Performance certificate for satisfactory operation of transmission line issued by the Utility(ies) in the name of participating bidder, indicating date of commencement of work and it's commissioning along with technical bid in support of qualification.</p> <p>The word "Commissioning" here means of energization of Transmission line duly certified by concerned power utility/PSU.</p>
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Note:

1. The word 'executed' means the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified in the PQR even if the total contract has not been completed or closed.
2. In order to technically qualify in this tender, bidder should meet all criteria i.e. A, B , C & D mentioned above.
3. If the job is executed in the last seven years period, as specified above, even if it has been started earlier, the same will also be considered meeting the qualifying requirements.
4. Consortium/ JV bidding is not allowed.
5. BHEL reserves the right to:
 - (a) Accept or reject any bid received at its discretion without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
 - (b) Postpone the above mentioned date, split and distribute the work among more than one bidder without assigning any reason whatsoever.
 - (c) May ask for further qualification during techno commercial scrutiny of bids received.
 - (d) May ask for further proofs including TDS certificates/ Form 26AS/ Final bill/ payment detail for the said job for cross- verification.
6. BHEL shall not be responsible for any delay, loss, damage for bids sent by post.
7. BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by bidder in preparation of bid irrespective of whether it is accepted or not.
8. Quotations received from bidders who do not fulfil the PQR shall be summarily rejected without any further evaluation and information to bidders.
9. Canvassing i.e. soliciting favour, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
10. If the bidder deliberately gives any wrong information in his tender to create in circumstances for the acceptance to his bid, BHEL reserves the right to reject such application.
11. Bidder's selection is subject to approval of BHEL's customer (M/s SECI) for this work.
