

PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

TECHNICAL:

A. Bidder should have designed, manufactured/got manufactured, erected and commissioned at least two (2) numbers integrated coal handling system having coal conveying and crushing plant of rated capacity of 800 MTPH or above, which is in successful operation during last 7 (seven) years prior to commercial bid opening date 31 Aug 2018.

FINANCIAL:

Bidder should have average minimum annual financial turnover of INR 50 Crore or equivalent amount* during the last 3 (three) years, as of 31-03-2018 or Corresponding financial year followed by the bidder.

Bidder should submit their audited balance sheet and profit & loss account in support of the same.

In case audited balance sheet and profit & loss account has not been submitted for all 3 years as indicated above, then the applicable financial audited statements submitted by the bidders against the requisite three years, will be averaged for three years.

If financial statements are not required to be audited statutorily, then instead of audited financial statements, financial statements are required to be certified by chartered accountant or statutory auditor of the company.

The net worth of the bidder for the last financial year as of 31.03.2018 should be positive.

NOTES:

1. The bidder has to submit either of following supporting documents meeting above mentioned pre-qualifying requirement:

Copy of minimum one (1) performance certificate in English from end user specifying that the product/ equipment is running successfully for one (1) year from date of commissioning meeting the minimum pre-qualifying requirement along with copy of related purchase order (PO) or letter of intent (LOI) or letter of award (LOA) or work order (WO).
2. Bidder shall submit design documents to substantiate technical parameters specified in PQR, if the same is not mentioned in performance certificate/purchase order.
3. Bidder to note that the acceptance of the offer is subjected to the “approval from our customer, WBPDCS” and BHEL reserves the right to reject offer of any bidder based on their poor/ non-performance in past/ present projects/ orders.
4. For foreign bidder, there shall be an authorized representative in India on behalf of the System supplier for single point communication with BHEL for submission of bid/attending bid queries/ bid clarifications, follow up, submission of engineering information in time, dispatches for smooth execution of contract.
5. If the bidder is a foreign party, he shall make a collaboration/agreement with an Indian agency for erection and commissioning at site. Such bidders shall submit collaboration/ consortium agreement.

6. * Equivalent amount means that it is the converted rates of other currency to INR as per currency matrix.
7. Bidder to furnish declaration on their letter head for the following.
 - a) Bidder has not been referred to National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) /National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT) /any other similar Government agency in India for Insolvency and Bankruptcy.
 - b) Bidder is not a potentially sick company (Negative net worth) duly certified by Chartered Accountant.
 - c) that the bidder has not been expelled or black listed by any PSU or Government agency in India.
8. Non-Indian bidders to submit the Report from third party business rating agencies eg. Dun & Bradstreet / Credit Reform Agency/ Government authorized rating agencies.
9. Bid documents are to be only in English language. The bid supporting documents other than English language are to be supported with translated documents in English certified/ attested by embassy of respective country or Indian embassy as applicable. In case of Bilingual certificates, English shall also be one of the languages duly certified and translated by the Indian embassy of the country.
10. Notwithstanding anything stated above, BHEL reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the bidder to perform the contract, as per BHEL evaluation procedure, in the overall interest of Project.
