Scope of work:

1. Vendor shall be required to install 02 nos. of brand new digital photocopy machines of any of the following makes: CANON, KONICA MINOLTA, TOSHIBA, XEROX, SHARP, PANASONIC, KYOCERA and MURATEC. Out of the above machines, 01 machine is to be installed in Lodhi Road office building and the other machine is to be installed in BHEL office at 5th floor, Advant Navis Business Park, Sector -142, Noida Greater Noida Expressway, Noida.

Details of the machines are given below:

45 CPM Digital Photocopy machine with Reversible automatic document feeder and Electronic Sorter, capacity up to A3 to A3 copy, reduction and enlargement facility and duplexing along with the facility of taking prints through Network printing of bulk documents. The machine shall have the provision for USB connectivity to facilitate bulk printing/ duplication directly.

Brand new machines with year of make as 2016 or later shall only be accepted. Number of machines may be increased / decreased by BHEL depending on total load of work with BHEL, however, the payment shall be made for actual no. of machines.

2. On award of contract, the bidder shall be required to install the brand new machines and other equipment at BHEL premises within 14 days along-with the documentary proof of model of the machine/equipment failing which the contract will be liable for termination and the EMD/Security Deposit shall be forfeited.
3. The space and power (220/240V 50 Hz AC) supply will be provided free of charge by BHEL.
4. Operation and maintenance of the machines shall be the complete responsibility of the vendor. All the inputs like paper, spares, repairs, consumables etc. and operation / services are to be borne by the vendor and nothing extra shall be payable for any reason whatsoever.
5. Insurance of machines, equipment, manpower (Accidental Insurance cover etc.) and other miscellaneous charges or any other charges whatsoever shall be borne by the vendor and BHEL shall not be held liable for any damage / injury to the manpower, machines/ consumables etc. of the vendor due to any reason.
6. Only mill packed 75 gsm photocopy paper of Century/ JK / Modi / Ballarpur make shall be used for photocopies. Only one brand of photocopy paper will be used in any particular job. Use of mixed variety/brand of paper will render the job liable for rejection at vendor's risk and cost.
7. Each machine has to be operated by vendor's personnel individually for ensuring output on the machines as per BHEL's requirements.
8. The vendor should maintain a minimum inventory of 4 boxes of photocopy paper of 10 reams at any point of time, i.e. 02 boxes at BHEL Lodhi Road office and 02 boxes at BHEL, Advant office, so that there is no interruption of work due to lack of photocopy paper.
9. The tentative nos. of copies will be 100000 per month. However, the payments shall be restricted as per the actual quantities accepted only.



Instructions to bidders:

1. Bidders must go through all annexures carefully before submitting the bid.
2. The offer shall be submitted as per the instructions of tender document. One set of tender document duly filled, signed and stamped on each page shall be submitted as detailed further. Tenderer should note specifically that all the pages of tender document, including the NIT page for this particular tender shall be submitted by them (after signing/ stamping on each page) as a part of their offer. In case of any clarification, bidder may contact this office.
3. The tenderer should accept all terms & conditions of the tender unconditionally. Tenders with deviations from terms and conditions shall be rejected.
4. In case any typing error/other clerical errors is noticed by the tenderer, in the tender documents, the same must be pointed out and got clarified before submission of offer, or else, BHEL's interpretation shall prevail and shall be binding on the tenderer.
5. No overwriting / correction in tender documents by tenderer shall be allowed. However, if correction is unavoidable, the same must be signed.
6. Only rate shall be quoted in price bid format and nothing else. Rates must be quoted in figures as well as in words. In case the rates in figures differ from the rates written in words, the lesser of the two will be treated as valid rate. Any other terms and conditions mentioned in the Price Bid shall make the offer liable for rejection.
7. The price must be quoted in the enclosed Price Format Only.
8. The prices quoted should be firm and no revision of prices will be entertained after the quotation is opened.
9. Tender must be submitted in a sealed envelope which has to be super-subscribed with NIT no. and due date written on the envelope and the bidder contact details.
10. Quotation shall be received up to 1030 hours on 06.11.2017, tenders received late /in open condition/ not meeting the tender condition / incomplete in any respect are likely to be rejected.
11. Validity of offer will be 60 days from the date of opening of tender.
12. BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offers without assigning any reason thereof. Also BHEL shall not entertain any correspondence from bidders in this matter.
13. A bidder may visit BHEL office on any working day from 14.10.2017 to 03.11.2017 between 0900 Hrs to 1700 Hrs. Any queries regarding this tender may be clarified from Sr. Engineer (HR-Admin) over telephone no. 011-41793305 or at email shlok@bhel.in.

Pre-Qualification Requirement (PQR):

1. EMD amount of ₹ 33,400.00 needs to be deposited through NEFT. The bank account details of BHEL for NEFT are enclosed as Annexure VI. The bidder is required to enclose a copy of the acknowledgement of NEFT payment along with their bids. Bids without EMD will not be accepted and shall not be considered for further evaluation.

The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned within 7 days of award of work to the successful bidder. No interest shall be payable on EMD amount.

The EMD shall be forfeited in case of:



- i) After opening the tender, the bidder revokes his bid within the validity period or increases his earlier quoted rates.
 - ii) The successful bidder does not commence the work within the period as per LOI / contract. In case the LOI / contract is silent in this regard then within 15 days after the award of contract.
2. The bidder has to submit copies of their PAN card and GST Registration certificate.
 3. The experience of having successfully completed similar Job / services during last 7 years ending on 31.10.2017 should be either of the following:
 - i) Three similar completed jobs / services with value not less than ₹ 6.68 Lakhs each.
Or
 - ii) Two similar completed jobs / services with value not less than ₹ 8.35 Lakhs each.
Or
 - iii) One similar completed job / service with value not less than ₹ 13.36 Lakhs.

“Similar Job / service” refer to “Rate Contract for providing photocopy services”.

Only work orders and related work completion certificates from the clients shall be submitted as proof against Sl. No. 3 of PQR. For example: If you are qualifying as per Sl. No. 4 (ii), only work orders and related work completion certificates of 2 clients each costing not less than ₹ 8.35 Lakhs shall be furnished. The work completion certificate shall be specific to the work order submitted i.e. the specific contract, value of the job, duration of contract / job and declaration of satisfactory performance shall be indicated in the work completion certificate from the client. The certificates shall be issued by competent authority with his / her contact details mentioned, for verification purpose. BHEL reserves the right to verify the correctness of the certificates of the clients.

Procedure for submission of bids

The bidders must submit their duly completed offers in a sealed envelope (Envelope #1) prominently super-scribed as “Rate contract for providing photocopy services at BHEL offices” followed by tender reference and last date for submission of tender.

Inside sealed Envelope #1, two separate sealed envelopes viz. Envelope #2 and Envelope #3 are to contain two parts of the tender “Part-I: Techno-commercial Bid and Earnest Money Deposit” and “Part-II: Price Bid” respectively. Both the sealed envelopes are to be super-scribed with “Part-I” or “Part-II” whichever is applicable, tender reference and details of the bidder.

A. Part-1: Techno-commercial Bid and EMD (Envelope #2)

The techno-commercial bid shall comprise of

1. The bidder should enclose a covering letter on its letter head mentioning the required details over it.
2. Details of machines like make, model, speed, year of make etc. on bidder’s letterhead.
3. Copy of Tender Enquiry Document duly signed in blue ink and stamped on each page as token of acceptance of tender conditions.
4. A copy of price bid duly signed and stamped but without the prices.



5. Acknowledgement of deposit of EMD of ₹ 33,400/- (Rupees Thirty Three Thousand Four Hundred only) by way of NEFT in favour of BHEL, New Delhi, must be enclosed in Part-I envelope.
6. Copy of PAN and GST Registration Certificate duly signed and stamped by the bidder.
7. Copy of acknowledgements of IT return of last three financial years i.e. FY 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17. In case of unavailability of documents for financial year 2016-17, documents pertaining to FY 2013-14 shall be furnished.
8. Copies of Work Orders indicating the duration of contract, Quantum of business done along with certificates of successful completion in support of proof of experience for the jobs/ services executed by the bidders during last 7 years ending on 31.10.2017 as against Sl. No. 3 of Pre-Qualification Criteria. BHEL reserves the right to verify the correctness of the documents submitted against fulfilling the PQR criteria.

All the documents in this envelope should be self-attested by the bidder with required stamp. This envelope should be super-scribed as “Part-I: Ref. ID/ HRM/ A041/ Photocopy_ENQ” followed by **bidder contact details** like address, mobile no., email etc.

The prices **should not be** mentioned in the price format in this envelope.

B. Part-II: Price Bid (Envelope #3)

The duly filled price bid in the enclosed “Price Bid Format” (Annexure-V) needs to be in sealed envelope #3. This envelope should be super-scribed as “Part-II: Ref. ID/ HRM/ A041/ Photocopy_ENQ” followed by bidder details.


The offers received on or before 1030 hours of 06.11.2017 shall be considered for opening of Techno-commercial bid scheduled at 1030 hours on 06.11.2017 in presence of the bidders who may like to be present. Offers received after specified time of submission shall be liable for rejection.

After techno-commercial evaluation of the offers, price bid of the bidders who qualify techno-commercial evaluation shall be opened on a later date in presence of the bidders who may like to be present. The date of opening of price bid shall be intimated to the qualified bidders through email.

Quotations not received in line with above format are liable to be rejected.

Evaluation criteria:

1. On the date of opening of tender, only technical bid shall be opened in presence of the bidders who would like to be present.
2. The techno-commercial bids i.e. Part-I submitted by all the bidders will be evaluated first. After techno-commercial evaluation, only the price bids of the bidders who qualify the



techno-commercial evaluation will be opened on a subsequent date. The date of opening of price bids shall be intimated to the concerned bidders through email.

3. In the price bid, the bidders are required to quote item wise rate for each item mentioned in Price Format (Annexure V) in the space provided.
4. The evaluation of price bid shall be done as per the following formula:

5. If the total evaluated prices of two Bidders are equal, then the Bidder with lower evaluated price (A +B) will be awarded the order.
6. If the total evaluated price (A+B) is also same, then the total evaluated price (A+B+E) will be considered.
7. If the values are still equal, then the Committee will decide and its decision will be the final.
8. Work will be awarded to the L1 bidder and final decision of BHEL on evaluation of bidders shall be binding on all the bidders.

Note:

1. BHEL reserves the right to split up the tender and place orders with more than one tenderer.
2. BHEL reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of photocopy machines to be installed under the contract.
3. BHEL reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
4. Tender/ Offer should be valid for a period of 60 days from the due date of submission of tender or extended due date.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Validity:** The validity of contract will be for 2 years from the date of start of work.
2. **Subletting:** The Vendor shall not sublet, transfer or assign the full work or any part thereof to any other person/company/organization.
3. **Quantity:** The quantities provided in tender enquiry document are tentative in nature which may vary as per requirement, however, the payment shall be made on actual basis.
4. **Payment Terms:**
 - a) Payment shall be made after successful completion of services during every month.
 - b) Quoted prices shall remain firm during the contract period and nothing extra shall be payable for any reason whatsoever.
 - c) No advance payment or the payment for mobilization of work will be made to the vendor.
 - d) Tax invoice raised by the vendor shall be certified by the official in-charge of BHEL and the 100% payment will be made within 15 days by NEFT/RTGS from the date of receipt of in discrepant bill.
 - e) All payment will be subject to deduction of taxes at source as per rules.
5. The vendor shall not be entitled to any interest with respect to any money which may be due to him from BHEL.
6. **Security deposit (SD)** amount equal to EMD amount shall be deposited by the successful bidder through NEFT either within seven days from the date of award of work or before start of contract whichever is earlier. SD can also be recovered at the rate of 10% from the running bills. However, in such case at least 50% of the SD shall be deposited within specified time and balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills.
If the successful bidder requests BHEL in writing to adjust EMD amount towards SD then EMD shall be retained as SD. SD, without interest, shall be refunded after successful completion of contract period.
7. On award of rate contract, the vendor shall be required to install 02 nos. brand new Digital Photocopy machines of any of makes (Make CANON, KONICA MINOLTA, TOSHIBA, XEROX, SHARP, PANASONIC, KYOCERA and MURATEC). Out of the above, 01 machine is to be installed in Lodhi Road office building and 01 machine is to be installed in our office at 5th floor, Advant Building, Sector -142, Noida.

Details of machines are given below:

45 cpm Digital Photocopy machine with Reversible automatic document feeder & Electronic Sorter, capacity up to A3 to A3 copy, reduction and enlargement facility and duplexing along with the facility of taking prints through Network printing of bulk documents. The machine shall have the provision of USB connectivity from which directly the machine should be capable of bulk printing/ duplication.

Brand new machine of year of make 2016 or later shall only be accepted.

Nos. of machine shall be increased /decreased by BHEL depending on total load of work with BHEL.



8. On award of contract, the bidder shall be required to install the Brand New Machines and other equipments at our premises within 14 days along-with the documentary proof of newness of the machines/equipments failing which the contract will be liable for termination and the EMD/Security Deposit shall be forfeited.
9. The space and power (220/240V 50 Hz AC) supply will be provided free of charge by BHEL.
10. Operation and maintenance of the machines shall be the complete responsibility of the vendor. All the inputs like paper, spares, repairs, consumables etc and operation services are to be borne by the vendor and nothing extra shall be payable for any reason whatsoever. In case of non-functioning of the main machines, standby machine will be provided immediately at no extra cost.
11. Insurance of machines, equipments, manpower (Accidental Insurance cover etc.) and other miscellaneous charges or any other charges whatsoever shall be borne by the Vendor and BHEL shall not be held liable for any damage / injury to the manpower, machines/consumables etc. of the vendor due to any reason.
12. The rates quoted for each copy and Spico/Spiral binding will be firm for two years inclusive of all taxes and no upward revision whatsoever shall be entertained under any circumstances w.e.f. the installation date of machines.
13. The rates quoted shall be inclusive for free collection, set making, compilation spico / spiral binding etc. and delivery of materials at the indenter's seat at BHEL office.
14. The rates quoted shall be on all inclusive basis with mill packed photocopy paper 75 gsm, Century/ JK / Modi / Ballarpur payable for actual quantities accepted. Rates shall be firm for the entire period of contract and no upwards revision will be allowed. Wastage, if any, shall be to vendor account.
15. Only one brand of photocopy paper will be used in any particular job. Use of mixed variety/brand of paper will render the job liable for rejection at vendor's risk and cost.
16. Each machine has to be operated by vendor's personnel individually for ensuring output on the machines as per BHEL's requirements.
17. Vendor shall not be allowed to carry out any photocopy job for other customers on machine installed by them in BHEL premises. Further the vendor shall ensure total secrecy of the documents to be photocopied and information shall not be shared with any person/agency under any circumstances. However, vendor shall be allowed to get the bulk job done outside BHEL with permission from the indenter.
18. The machine along with the operator shall be in use daily from 0845 hours to 1800 hours on normal days. In case the indenter desires the operator may have to continue to work in late night hours and on holidays observed by BHEL without any extra cost or financial burden to BHEL.
19. Vendor will not have any right or claim on the premises provided for installation of the machines.
20. Vendor shall indemnify BHEL against any loss, damage, injury etc. to their machines, equipment installed, stationery, consumables, etc. or the manpower deployed in BHEL for the entire period of the contract.
21. You or your work force will not be entitled for any compensation for any loss/damage suffered by your work force deployed to execute the work under this contract. BHEL shall remain indemnified against any compensation that may arise out of any injury or death to any person deputed by you under this contract.


22. The vendor should maintain a minimum inventory of 4 boxes of photocopy paper of 10 reams at any point of time, i.e. 02 boxes at BHEL Lodhi Road office and 02 boxes at BHEL, Advant office, so that there is no interruption of work due to lack of photocopy paper.
23. The tentative nos. of copies will be 100000 per month. However, the payments shall be restricted as per the actual quantities accepted only.
24. In case the vendor for any reason is not able to execute the job as per time schedule / required quality, BHEL reserves the right to get the same done at the risk and cost of the vendor and impose the following pre-agreed damages:

These damages shall be over and above the additional cost to be incurred by BHEL for getting the work done from outside.

25. **Risk Clause:** In case the vendor does not accept the work awarded to him or does not turn up after the award of work, BHEL shall have the right without any prejudice to get the work done through any other alternate agency at the risk and cost of Vendor. The additional cost including loss, if any incurred by BHEL will be recovered from the Vendor.
26. No excuses like hindrance because of extreme weather conditions, non-availability of labour and material etc. will be entertained for not providing services on time.
27. **Termination of contract:** If at any time the vendor defaults in performance of the work with due diligence and continues to do so or commit any default in complying any of the tender terms and condition even after the notice in writing is given, BHEL may, without prejudice to any other right to remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue thereafter to BHEL, terminate the contract by giving 15 days' notice in writing. The notice will be deemed to have served as and when sent to the address given in the tender. In such a case, the Security Deposit shall be forfeited.
28. If any documents found to be incorrect after placement of order, the Security Deposit shall be forfeited.
29. **Confidentiality and Nondisclosure:** BHEL has engaged vendor and vendor have accepted this engagement for the purpose of activities to be carried out as per the contract subject to confidentiality obligations set forth below.

As used herein, Confidential Information shall mean and include information now or hereafter owned by, or otherwise within the possession or control of BHEL including,



without limitation, patented and unpatented inventions, business and trade secrets, know-how, techniques, data, specifications, blueprints, flow sheets, designs, engineering information, operation criteria and other tangible and intangible information related to the equipment / material. vendor agrees that they will not use the Confidential Information of the BHEL for any purpose other than the contract.

Except for employees of each described below, Vendor will not at any time without the prior written consent of BHEL publish, disclose or otherwise disseminate, duplicate or use, directly or indirectly, confidential information to or for the benefit of any third party whether or not it relates to a process, product, equipment or apparatus embodied therein.

30. **Indemnification by Vendor:** The Vendor shall indemnify the BHEL against all actions, claims, demands, costs, charges and expenses arising from or incurred by reason of any infringement or alleged infringement of any kind including infringement of patent, registered design, copyright, or trade mark or trade name protected in any country by the use or possession of any or materials / equipment supplied by the Vendor by any one directly or indirectly employed by him or any damage to life or property of an employee of BHEL or Vendor or any third party.

31. **Arbitration:** In the event of any dispute or difference arising out of the execution of the Order/Contract or the respective rights and liabilities of the parties or in relation to interpretation of any provision between BHEL & Service provider in any manner touching upon the Order/Contract, such dispute or difference shall (except as to any matters, the decision of which is specifically provided for therein) be referred to the arbitration of the person appointed by the competent authority of BHEL.

Subject to as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The venue of arbitration shall be at New Delhi.

32. **Jurisdiction of court:** Courts at Delhi/New Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide the dispute, if any, arising out of or in respect of the contract (s) to which these conditions are applicable.


