12. MSE bidders are required to declare Udyog Aadhar Memorandum (UAM)
13. **Risk and Cost Purchase:** - 5% overhead charges to be considered instead of 30% (presently in GCC Rev 06 clause no 26.2(b)).
14. In case of joint bidding, Bidders shall be required to furnish scope matrix which should be clearly defined between foreign bidder and their Indian representative along with the offer for the Main Supply and Erection commissioning.

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15. Bidders are requested to refer following clause regarding Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) - PPP-MII.

"For this procurement, Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 15.06.2017 & 28.05.2018 and subsequent orders issued by the respective Nodal Ministry shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT but before finalization of contract/PO/WO against this NIT.

In the event of any Nodal Ministry prescribing higher or lower percentage of purchase preference and / or local content in respect of this procurement, same shall be applicable.

Vendors are requested to go through the above mentioned orders and confirm the following:"

- The local supplier at the time of tender, bidding or solicitation shall be required to provide self-certification that the item offered meets the minimum local content as per above mentioned orders and shall give details of the location(s) at which the local value addition is made.

16. MSME/Start up Vendors to submit applicable documents along with their offer for availing the benefits as per GOI guidelines. Further PEM is already registered with RXIL(TReDS) Platform. You are requested to get registered with RXIL(TReDS) Platform to avail the facility as per GOI guidelines.

17. **Delivery Schedule: -**

Main Supply: Delivery shall be within six (06) months from drgs. /docs. approval in CAT-I issued by BHEL. This is subject to submission of all drawing/documents as per Annexure-VI of sub section 1A of Technical Specification No. PE-TS-434-154-A101 by vendor and revised documents submission incorporating all comments within 10 days from BHEL/NTPC comments. Any delay in submission/ resubmission by vendor shall be to vendor's account and will be reduced from delivery schedule.

Mandatory Spares: Delivery shall be Three (03) months from BHEL clearance.

18. Bidders are requested to refer Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) format & rules and adhere to it while furnishing PBG.
19. BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. The envelope sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.

If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action

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by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com)."

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS IN CASE OF REVERSE AUCTION

The Bidders has to quote the Single Price (i.e. **Total Cost to BHEL i.e. Grand total FOR site excluding GST**) in Reverse Auction. Price are to be inclusive of Packing & Forwarding charges, all the routine & type tests as per tender scope, Freight charges, Insurance charges (if applicable), Cost of withdrawal (if any), including loading (if any), De-loading (if any) shall be done in line with NIT terms

20. No CIF is available for this package.
21. Bidders have to quote freight charges in terms of percentage of their quoted total Ex-Works prices. If any bidder will quote freight as Nil/Included, Freight@ 1.833% shall be considered in BHEL estimates for evaluating offer of such bidders.
22. Bidder to note that this is a conditional Open Tender enquiry and the price bid (Part-II) opening/RA participation shall be subject to following condition:
 - A) Techno-commercial qualification/recommendation of bidder by the BHEL-PEM
 - B) Approval of bidder by End Customer
23. The bidders (who are not registered with BHEL-PEM) -Online Registration Portal is operational in BHEL. Non-registered Vendors, who wish to apply for registration with BHEL-PEM, have to apply through Online Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com → vendor section → Online Supplier Registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed and stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website and submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy of the filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed and stamped has to be submitted'

If any bidder uploads price bid in the unpriced section (techno-commercial attachment page) of the tender in e-procurement, in that case bidder(s) shall only be responsible for such mistake and any consequences thereof. Hence all bidders are requested to be more careful at the time of uploading the Unpriced and Price Bid for Part-I and Part-II respectively to avoid mismatch
26. All the above Tender Documents shall automatically become a part of the Order/Contract after its finalisation.
27. Evaluation will be done on overall L1 (Total cost to BHEL i.e. FOR site) basis with necessary loading as applicable in line with clause no. 19 of GCC Rev06. **GST shall not be considered in evaluation.**
28. Overall (%) variation in contract value due to changes in the scope is zero. This will prevail over the quantity variation clause no.6.0 indicated in the GCC rev 06.
29. The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list and also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL website <http://www.bhel.com>.
30. The Bidder along with its associate/ collaborators/ sub-contractors/ sub-vendors/ consultants/ service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL Fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website <http://www.bhel.com> and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice.
