BHEL is executing 18MW power project in Maroni Comoros. BHEL intends to appoint a Contractor for arrangement of SOC containers & Pre-FOB activities for container transportation of Project cargoes to Comoros. The contractor will also have to arrange for pickup of cargo from warehouse (BHEL's CHA warehouse), local transportation till nominated CFS nearby Nhava Sheva Port and arrange for export customs clearance and further handing over to Shipping agent for onwards ocean carriage. All the cargo will have to be shipped in approx 20 (Twenty) 40FT GP/HC Shipper Owned Containers (SOC) arranged by the contractor. The cargoes is likely be arrive by 15th May 2017onwards. **The bidder must have a valid registration Certificate for Freight forwarding / Ocean carriage / Steamer agent /Multimodal Transportation agents/ Custom House agents /CFS operations from Custom / Ports of Mumbai/ Nhava Sheva or DG of Shipping.** The quantity of cargo is about 255 MT subject to a variation of +/-20% (no contractual or legal binding on BHEL regarding cargo volume. SCOPE OF WORK

Cargo Description:

The cargo comprises of about 255MTs +/-20% to be shipped in multiple lots. The contractor will have to ensure that the cargo is shipped / transported out at the earliest as per scope of work. Detail Packing list is not available however cargo dimensions will be within the stuffing range of HC and GP containers. Payment will be made only for actual no. of containers **shipped** and rate finalized as per price Bid.

The scope of work covers the following:

The scope of work covers the following:

The entire cargo of will be shipped in several lots in 17x40'GP & 3X40' HC SOC Containers arranged by contractor from Nhava Sheva /JNPT port on FOB terms. The contractor is required to go through the scope of work as detailed below. The cargo is likely to arrive at CFS from 15th May onwards tentatively.

Load Port: Nhava Sheva /JNPT Port, India

Terms of delivery: FOB

Discharge Port: Moroni, Comoros

The scope of work includes:

- Arrange for receiving and unloading of the cargo arrived through BHEL/BHEL Supplier's transporter at contractors nominated CFS.
- 2) Issue proper receipt to BHEL/BHEL Supplier's transporter for cargo received.
- 3) The contractor shall arrange for safe unloading of the cargo received at their own nominated CFS.
- 4) The contractor has to ensure the safety of cargo in his custody and keep proper package wise record of arrival and dispatch of cargo to /from the CFS and send daily updates to BHEL via email giving details of the packages/ original documents received.
- 5) Contractor to inform BHEL sufficiently in advance the input documents required for Export custom clearance.
- 6) Arrange for customs clearance of the materials at load port i.e Registration of DEEC license with customs, collection of export documents from our office, processing the multiple shipping bills (*DEEC / drawback etc as the case may be as advised by BHEL from time to time*) and providing necessary endorsed documents of export (EC copy of S/Bills, ARE-1 endorsed by customs, SDF etc.).
- 7) Take all the necessary permissions from the relevant agencies at CFS for carting of cargo. The contractor is free to choose the CFS stuffing point and no additional cost for movement of empty container or loaded container from CFS to CFS or CFS to Port will be given.
- 8) Arrange good quality suitable cargo worthy, Sea worthy SOC containers (SOC container on non returnable basis) in CFS nominated by contractor. These containers should be wind tight and water tight and have valid container safety convention (CSC). The prefix on the SOC container should be

- valid and registered with BIC (Bureau International des Conteneurs). Container to have clear and visible CSC plate.
- 9) Contractor to ensure that the empty container is fully inspected on the exterior and interior. Container must be found suitable for loading of the goods with respect to cleanliness, dryness, free of odour, free of crack, proper closing and proper rubber seals, interior/exterior paint and wooden floor being reasonably intact, no hole/potential leakages. Ensure that Lashing eyes are provided on the longitudinal beams on the floor, roof and corner posts. Contractor should arrange survey of empty containers from IICL inspector and provide Cargo Worthy certificate/ survey report for each container.
- 10) Contractor should carry out optimum stuffing of cargo in container to avoid problems such as cargo overflow or wastage of space. When packing a container or securing cargo, the Guidelines for Packing and Securing Cargoes in Containers for Transport by Land or by Sea (Container Packing Guidelines) issued by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) and International Labour Organization (ILO), must be observed. Cargo must also be secured within a container against all ship movements, such as rolling, pitching and yawing. Individual cargo parts that do not fill up the floor must be secured by being chocked and lashed.
- 11) The no. of containers intimated is tentative based on the engineering design weight and dimension of package and shall vary as per actual upto ± 20%. Hence contractor has to ensure to arrange only that much SOC container as per the actual cargo in CFS. If contractor arranges SOC container in excess of available actual cargo the same will have to be returned back by contractor at his own cost. BHEL will not pay for transportation/storage/unloading/ loading charges/CFS charges etc for such excess containers.
- 12) Contractor should provide container wise packing list after stuffing of containers or stuffing report.
- 13) Transport the loaded sealed containers to the vessel and load the containers on the vessel at JNPT. All CFS/ THC charges to be borne by the contractor.
- 14) The SOC containers shall be treated as BHEL property and cost of containers are to be included in price quoted by contractor in price Bid.
- 15) All CFS charges including storage charges, container cost on non returnable basis, stuffing cost, cargo securing cost and any other cost if any, will be to the contractor's account. Cargo shall be moved on full container load only.
- 16) The cargo shall be available from 3rd week of May 2017 onwards.
- 17) The vessel booking is being arranged by our consortium partner i.e M/s OIA (Overseas Infrastructure Alliance or his agent M/s Tiger Logistics. Contractor has to coordinate with M/s OIA or his appointed agent for booking details etc till Gate IN of all containers. M/s OIA or his agent will require 15 days advance notice of readiness of loaded FCL containers in all respect for booking on vessel. Delivery to M/s OIA or his shipping agent will be on FOB basis.
- 18) All the agency charges, shipping line charges & surcharges if any, origin charges like Shipping line THC, Liasioning charges, certificate charges, Bill of lading charges, Facilitation charges, ISPS, seal charges, SOC container surcharges are included in price bid and shall not be payable separately.
- 19) The Price offered in Price Bid should include:
 - a. Carting/ Unloading/loading at CFS, Storage in CFS nearby JNPT.
 - b. Cost of non returnable empty containers having intact valid CSC plate and suitable for export purpose.
 - c. Collection of empty container and movement till nominated CFS.
 - d. Custom clearance charges.
 - e. All the necessary charges of stuffing/lashing/securing of the cargo including all CFS operations including storage charges.

- f. All insurance costs covering risk of operations undertaken (Cargo / goods will be insured by BHEL or consignee).
- g. All Forklift/crane/labour charges/via/SSR/revalidation/SOC charges.
- h. Transportation of loaded Containers from CFS to Vessel, THC, etc
- All shipping line charges & surcharges /CFS /transportation charges/SOC surcharges etc.
 if any.
- 20) Cargo will be shipped in several lots and the contractor should make all efforts to handover the cargo on or before cutoff date of schedule vessel.
- 21) Contractor to ensure that OB/L is released on next day of ship sailing date. If issue of OB/L delayed then penalty of **Rs 1000/- per day** will be charged starting from 4th working day of ship sailing date (sailing date exclusive) irrespective of time of sailing.
- 22) The contractor will have to ensure pre shipment joint survey & measurement of cargo from third party surveyor and notify BHEL for the condition of the cargo prior to stuffing in the SOC containers and their loading on the vessel.
- 23) The contractor shall keep contact with shipping Agent for schedule of vessel and availability of empty SOC container. If the contractor fails to handover the cargo to shipping agent/line on scheduled time, all storage and shipping line charges will be borne by contractor till next scheduled vessel. No container or vessel detention charges are payable hence proper planning should be ensured by the contractor.
- 24) You will follow all local laws / acts / rules prevailing in Transit while transporting the cargo without any liability to BHEL and indemnify BHEL from any mishap / claims while undertaking the work.

- 1.3 "CONTRACT" or "CONTRACT DOCUMENT" shall mean and include the agreement, the work order, LOI, the accepted appendices of rates, Schedules of Quantities (if any), General Terms and Conditions of Contract, Special Conditions of Contract, Instructions to Bidder, the drawings, the Technical Specifications and the Special Specifications (if any).
- 1.4 Any conditions or terms stipulated by the bidder in the tender documents or subsequent letters shall not form part of the Contract unless specifically accepted in writing by BHEL and incorporated in the Agreement.
- 1.5 "TENDER SPECIFICATIONS" shall mean the Scope of Work, Special Instructions/ Conditions, Technical specifications / requirement, Appendices, Site Information and drawings pertaining to the work and any other relevant reference in the Tender Document for which the Bidder are required to submit their offer.
- 1.6 "APPROVED" "DIRECTED" or "INSTRUCTED" shall mean approved, directed or instructed by BHEL.
- 1.7 "SINGULAR AND PLURAL" etc. words carrying singular number shall also include plural and vice versa, where the context so requires. Words imparting masculine gender shall be taken to include the feminine gender and words imparting persons shall include any Company or Association or Body or Individuals, whether incorporated or not.
- 1.8 "VALIDITY OF THE CONTRACT" The contract will remain valid till all the activities specified therein are completed in all respects to the satisfaction of BHEL.
- 1.9 "COMPLETION OF THE CONTRACT" The contract will be treated as complete on full and final settlement of all Bills / invoices raised under the contract with no claim on either side.

2.0 ISSUE OF NOTICE:

2.1 The Contractor shall furnish the name, designation and addresses of his authorized agents/associates at Mumbai (India), at the Load Port and at the discharge Port. All complaints, notices, communications and references shall be deemed to have been duly given to the Contractor, if delivered to the Contractor or his authorized agent/representative.

3.0 COMMENCEMENT OF WORK:

3.1 The Contractor shall commence the work on specific intimation from BHEL in writing or the time indicated in the LOI and shall proceed with the same with due expedition without delay. If the contractor fails to commence the work as per the terms of Order/Contract, BHEL, at its sole discretion will have the right to cancel the Order/Contract. His Earnest Money and/or Security Deposit will stand forfeited without prejudice to any and all of BHEL's other rights and remedies in this regards.

4.0 INVOICES AND PAYMENTS

- 4.1 The Operator will be required to raise the Invoice for the services rendered. The Invoices will have to be raised according to the explicitly agreed rates and payment terms of the contract.
- 4.2 Even if the prices offered are inclusive of Taxes, the contractor will have to produce invoices showing the tax elements separately.
- 4.3 In case the, TDS is not to be made, the Airline/Operator will have to produce the exemption letter from the relevant authorities to this effect.
 - 4.4 In case of any revision in the Service Tax rates the same shall be considered

5.0 RISK PURCHASE:

BHEL reserves to itself the following rights in respect of this Contract without entitling the Contractor for any compensation.

- 5.1 If at any time during the currency of the contract, the contractor fails to render all or any of the services required under the scope of work of the contract satisfactorily in the opinion of BHEL, whose decision shall be final and binding on the contractor, BHEL reserves the right to get the work done by other parties or departmentally at the cost and risk of the contractor and also forfeit the Security deposit.
- 5.2 The Company reserves the right to terminate the contract of any contractor at any time, without assigning any reasons thereof, by giving one month's notice of their intention to do so in writing to the contractor who shall not be entitled for any compensation by reason of such termination
- 5.3 To recover any moneys due from the Contractor, from any moneys due to the Contractor under this or any other contract or from the Security Deposit.
- 5.4 To claim compensation for losses sustained including BHEL's supervision charges & overheads in case of termination of Contract.

6.0 OBSERVANCE OF LOCAL LAWS:

- 6.1 The Contractor shall comply with all Laws, Statutory Rules, Regulations etc. The Contractor shall obtain all necessary permits/approval from the local Governing Body, Police and other concerned Authorities as may be required under law.
- 6.2
- The Contractor shall pay all taxes, fees, license charges, deposits, duties, tolls, royalty, commissions or other charges that may be Leviable on account of any of the operations connected with the execution of this contract.
- 6.3 The Contractor shall be responsible for the proper behavior and observance of all regulations by the staff employed.

7.0 SAFETY OF MEN, EQUIPMENT, MATERIAL & ENVIRONMENT:

7.1 All safety rules, codes applied by BHEL/its customer at site shall be observed by the Contractor and his workmen without exception. The Contractor shall be responsible for the safety of the equipment/materials and work to be performed by him.

8.0 INSURANCE:

- 8.1 BHEL shall arrange for insuring the project materials/properties of BHEL covering the risks during transit and material handling at port(s).
- 8.2 The Contractor shall during the performance of the contract take a suitable insurance to cover against bodily injury, death or damage to property of the Contractor or his employees.
- 8.3 The Contractor shall during the performance of the contract take out a Third Party insurance cover against bodily injury or death suffered by any third party/parties or damage to property occurring during the course of execution of this contract in accordance with appropriate statutory requirements.

8.4 If due to Contractor's carelessness, negligence, non-observance of safety precautions, improper security arrangements or due to non-compliance of paper work needed for lodging insurance claim, damage to BHEL/its Customer's property, and if BHEL is unable to recover its claim from the Insurance Company, the deficit will be recovered from the Contractor.

9.0 FORCE MAJEURE:

- 9.1 Acts of God, Act of any Government, war, blockades, Sabotage, riots, civil Commotion, insurrection, terrorist acts, acts of Public enemy, Flood, Storms, Washouts, Fire, Explosion, landslides, lightning, Cyclone, Earthquake, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, arrest and restraints of the government, necessity for compliance with any court order, law ordinance or regulations promulgated by any governmental authority having jurisdiction, either federal /state /civil or military, strikes or other industrial disturbances, lockouts and other similar causes / events over which the Contractor has no control.
- 9.2 If the Contractor suffers delay in the due execution of the contract, due to delays caused by force majeure conditions, as defined above, the agreed time of completion of the work covered by this contract may be extended by a reasonable period of time provided notice of the happening of any such cause / event is given by the contractor to BHEL within 14 days from the date of occurrence thereof.
- 9.3 The Contractor by the reason of such events shall neither be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall have any claim for damages against BHEL in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist, and the decision of BHEL as to whether the deliveries have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive.
- 9.4 Force Majeure conditions will apply on both sides.

10.0 ARBITRATION:

- 10.1 If Except where otherwise provided for in the contract, all questions and disputes relating to the meaning of the words, terms, specifications, operations, and instructions, mentioned in this contract and as to the quality of workmanship or performance of handling and/or transportation, any other question, claim, right, matter or thing whatsoever in any way arising out of or relating to the contract, specifications, operating instructions, orders or these conditions; or otherwise concerning the transport and handling operations, the execution or failure to execute the same whether arising during the progress of the work or after the completion or abandonment thereof, shall be referred to a sole arbitrator i.e. HEAD ROD, BHEL, Mumbai or nominee appointed by him in writing. There will be no objection if the arbitrator so appointed is an employee of BHEL. The arbitration shall be conducted in line with the provisions Indian ARBITRATION AND CONCILIATION ACT, 1996. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties
- 10.2 If the Arbitrator, to whom the matter is originally referred, is transferred or vacates his office or is unable to act for any reason, BHEL, shall appoint another person to act as Arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the contract. Such person shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage, at which it was left by his predecessor.
- 10.3 The Arbitrator shall have power to call for such evidence by way of affidavits or otherwise as the Arbitrator shall think proper and it shall be the duty of the parties hereto to do or cause to be done all such things as may be necessary to enable the Arbitrator to make the award without any delay.
- 10.4 The arbitration shall be conducted in line with the provisions Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof, and the rules made there under, and for the time being in force
- 10.5 It is a term of the contract that the party invoking arbitration shall specify the disputes to be referred to arbitration under this clause together with the amount or amounts claimed in respect of each

- dispute. The Arbitrator may, with consent of the parties, fix and/or enlarge the time for making and publishing the award as situation warrants.
- 10.6 The contract shall continue to be operated during the arbitration proceedings unless otherwise directed in writing by BHEL or unless the matter is such that the contract cannot be operated till the decision of the arbitrator is received.
- 10.7 The award of the Arbitrator shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties to the contract.
- 10.8 The place of Arbitration will be BHEL, ROD office, Mumbai.
- 10.9 In case of PSU, the office Memorandum no 4(1)/2011_DPE(PMA)-GI dated 12/06/2013 of DPE will be applicable

11.0 LAWS GOVERNING THE CONTRACT:

11.1 The contract shall be governed by the Indian Laws for the time being in force and only courts in Mumbai, India shall have jurisdiction over this contract.

12.0 INDEMNITY:

12.1 The Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified BHEL all losses, claims etc. arising out of any of his acts or out of the acts of his agents or associates or servants during the currency of the contract.

13.0 SECURTY DEPOSIT:

- 13.1 Successful bidder shall submit 5% of the total contract value as security deposit within Three days of issue of LOI for the contract.EMD of the successful Bidder shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security Deposit
- 13.2 Security deposit may be made in any of the following ways:
 - a. Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act).
 - b. Local cheques of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL.
 - c. Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The Bank Guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL.
 - d. Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Contractor, a/c BHEL).
 - e. Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL).

Note: BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith)

- 13.3 If the value of work done at any time exceeds the contract value, the amount of Security Deposit shall be correspondingly enhanced and the additional Security Deposit shall be immediately deposited by the Contractor or recovered from payment/s due to the Contractor.
- 13.4 The security deposit shall not carry any interest.
- (Note: Acceptance of Security Deposit against SI. No. (d) and (e) above will be subject to hypothecation or endorsement on the documents in favour of BHEL. However, BHEL will not be

liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith). Securities / BG's shall be released after three (1) months of successful execution, completion of the contract and upon fulfillment of contractual obligations as per terms of the contract

14.0 REQUIREMENTS OF PERFORMANCE:

- 14.1 All permissions / Clearances or any other relevant authorization from competent authority shall be obtained by the Contractor at his own cost. Any contingency arising in this respect shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. Also the Contractor shall be responsible for any mishap, accident en route and consequences therefore including legal complications, if any.
- 14.2 The contract as entered into between BHEL and the contractor shall in no way, nullify, reduce, mitigate or absolve the parties of any responsibility, obligation or liability that may devolve upon them under the acts or laws governing such activity.
- 14.3 The Contractor shall take all due care for protecting the consignments from rains and be responsible for their safe and sound condition during his possession and the vehicles carrying such consignments shall be suitably equipped for the same. The contractor shall take all due care of consignments while loading / unloading. During transshipment he shall provide all packing, fastening and lashing at his own cost.
- 14.4 All the safety precautions required in transportation such as lashing, fastening and securing the consignments, providing security escorts enroute shall be the responsibility of the Contractor at his own cost.
- 14.5 In the event of contractor backing out/not performing as per the contract, suitable action will be taken by BHEL as per contract. Additionally, future business of such de-faulting Agents will be suspended with BHEL as per company policy.
- 14.6 Whenever asked by company, all documents including bill of lading, delivery orders, payment invoices etc will be returned by contractor immediately not later than three working days, failing which appropriate action as deemed fit and recovery of the losses by the company will be done.
- 14.7 In the event of the contractor going into liquidation or winding up business or making arrangements with a third party, the Company shall have the right to terminate the contract forthwith. In case any of the contractor's company becomes insolvent the contract shall automatically stand terminated.

15.0 SHORT- LANDED OR DAMAGED GOODS:

- 15.1 It shall be the responsibility of Contractor to give notice of loss (damages or short landing of cargo) as per the relevant rules to the Carriers, Port authorities and Underwriters for non-delivery/short delivery/losses/damages. Under no circumstances, the intimation be time barred. In case of time barred cases, the loss sustained by BHEL shall be to the account of the Contractor.
- 15.2 In case of goods specified by BHEL and in case of apparent damages, the Contractor will apply for survey by Carriers, Port authorities, Underwriters etc. (including Insurance survey) within 48 hours of landing of goods. If any loss or damage is apparent, the Contractor shall lodge claim with the appropriate authorities.

This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders have to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the *tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/contractors (as available on www.bhel.com)*.

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. The envelope Sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.

If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com)."

19.0 Discrepancy In Words & Figures: Quoted In Offer

- 19.1 If, in the price structure quoted for the required goods/ services/ works, there is discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (which is obtained by multiplying the unit price by the quantity), the unit price shall prevail and the total price corrected accordingly, unless in the opinion of the purchaser there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price corrected accordingly.
- 19.2 If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- 19.3 If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject of 20.1 and 20.2 above.
- 19.4 If there is such discrepancy in an offer, the same shall be conveyed to the bidder with target date up to which the bidder has to send his acceptance on the above lines and if the bidder does not agree to the decision of the purchaser, the bid is liable to be ignored.
- 20.0 **BHEL FRAUD PREVENTION POLICY:** Bidder along with its associate/collaborators/sub-contractors/ sub-vendors/consultants/service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL fraud prevention policy displayed on BHEL web site http://www.bhel.com and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice.
- 21.0 CANCELLATION OF THE CONTRACT: BHEL shall have the right to cancel the contract for unsatisfactory performance i.e. repeated failure for arranging trailers/vessels and delivery of the cargo within transit time. BHEL shall have the right to forfeit the security for poor performance of CONTRACTOR leading to cancellation of contract.

If the CONTRACTOR fails or neglects or refuses to observe / perform any of the terms and conditions / obligation of or under the contract BHEL may without prejudice to any other rights terminate the contract by giving one month's notice in writing and recover from the Contractor any damage suffered by on account of the failure, negligence, refusal, violation or breach of contract or any part thereof including the amount by which the cost of completion of the work done by any other agency shall exceed the amount payable to the CONTRACTOR under the contract.

BHEL reserves the right to either short close the contract or terminate the contract at its discretion without assigning any reason by giving one month's notice by registered post acknowledgement due or in person under delivery.

22.0 Integrity commitment, performance of the contract and punitive action thereof:

- 22.1. Commitment by BHEL: BHEL commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption in connection with the tender process and execution of the contract. BHEL will during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) in a transparent and fair manner, and with equity.
- 22.2. Commitment by Bidder/ Supplier/ Contractor:
- 22.2.1. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor commit to take all measures to prevent corruption and will not directly or indirectly influence any decision or benefit which he is not legally entitled to nor will act or omit in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India.
- 22.2.2. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries

in connection with the award of the contract and shall adhere to relevant guidelines issued from time to time by Govt. of India/ BHEL.

22.2.3. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasonable cause, which causes loss of business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL.

If any bidder/ supplier/ contractor during pre-tendering/ tendering/ post tendering/ award/ execution/ post-execution stage indulges in mal-practices, cheating, bribery, fraud or and other misconduct or formation of cartel so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price or acts or omits in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India, then, action may be taken against such bidder/ supplier/ contractor as per extant guidelines of the company available on www. bhel.com and/or under applicable legal provisions".

23.0 **MSE suppliers** can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (2 years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with attested copy of CA certificate (format enclosed as per Annexure I where deemed validity of EM II certificate of 2 years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the date of bid opening (Part I incase of 2 part bid). Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bids at par with other bidders. No benefits shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents are not submitted before price bid opening. If the tender is to be submitted through e-Procurement Portal, then the above required documents are to be uploaded on the portal. Documents should be notarized or attested by Gazetted officer.

24.0 License/Permission/Registration

Wherever any Licence/Permission from or Registration with Local or State or Central authorities is required under the above Acts/Law or any other Laws Governing the work contracted for, the contractor shall at his own cost arrange for such Licence/ Permission/ Registration. Contractor shall also be liable for producing for inspection such certificates and licenses as may be required by the Local/State/Central Authorities or BHEL as and when required. The contractor shall pay all levies, fees, taxes and charges etc. to appropriate authorities and other bodies as required by them under their rules for, vehicles / trailers, employees or workers engaged by him. These charges shall be borne by the contractor. However, if any new tax is levied, subsequent to the signing of the contract, reimbursement of the same may be considered by the Competent Authority on the basis of written proof regarding imposition of new tax. The vehicle/trailer shall not carry load in excess of the GVW as mentioned in the RC Book of the vehicle/trailer concerned. No claim or compensation for reimbursements, made against BHEL by Contractor shall be entertained by BHEL for any breach of the provisions/Acts or laws by the contractor.

25 Time Limit for Submission of Bills

- 25.1 The contractor shall make a claim for the services rendered under this contract to BHEL within (3)Three months of such service. If he does not prefer claim within the said period, he shall be deemed to have waived his right in the respect thereof and shall not be entitled to any payment on account thereof. Nevertheless, the accepting authority on written request can waive off this limitation and allow late submission of bills if the reasons for delay are found convincing and reasonable.
- No claim in respect of under payment to the contractor shall be considered valid or entertained unless a claim in writing is made thereof within (3) Three months from the date on which payment of the original claim thereto was made. Any claim for such under payment, not received within the stipulated four months period, shall be liable to be summarily rejected by BHEL. Nevertheless, the accepting authority on written request can waive off this limitation and allow late submission of bills if the reasons for delay are found convincing and reasonable.
- 25.3 However, in case of any specific issue over which the contractor had not billed for any particular activity the same can be allowed for payment, subject to with the prior approval of the General Manager, notwithstanding what has been laid down in the Clause on Payment. The decision of the General Manager shall be final and binding on the contractor.

- 25.4 In case of Risk Purchase is enforced, The contractor will hand over the clean cargo along with all related documents, NOC etc without any financial bearing to BHEL, enabling BHEL/BHEL nominated freight forwarder to carry out the work further
- 25.5 It shall be the duty of the contractor to acquaint himself with all safety regulations regarding handling equipment and Road Transportation of all types of containers. The contractor shall follow the safety requirements mentioned here and as applicable by laws, rules and regulations all the time during the period of contract.
- 25.6 The contractor shall indemnify BHEL against any violation of safety laws, rules and regulations while carrying-out operations as required by the contract.
- 25.7 No unauthorized person should be allowed to work on the Trailers/equipment etc. The drivers and crane operators should have valid license and should be proficient in their work. No person without a valid driving license should be allowed to drive the vehicle.
- 25.8 The Contractor is responsible for safe transportation of the goods. Contractor shall effect open delivery of the cases of major damage after completing the due processes.
- 25.9 The Contractor will ensure that damaged cases are repacked properly before dispatch after completing the survey by the relevant authorities.
