2. COMMENCEMENT OF WORK:

2.1 The Contractor shall commence the work on specific intimation from BHEL in writing or the time indicated in the LOI and shall proceed with the same with due expedition without delay. If the Contractor fails to commence the work as per the terms of Order/Contract, BHEL, at its sole discretion will have the right to cancel the Order/Contract. His Earnest Money and/or Security Deposit will stand forfeited without prejudice to any and all of BHEL's other rights and remedies in this regard.

3. INVOICES AND PAYMENT TERMS:

- 3.1 The Contractor will be required to raise the Invoice for the services rendered. The Invoices will have to be raised according to the explicitly agreed rates and payment terms of the contract.
- 3.2 In consideration of such services mentioned above rendered by the contractor, BHEL will pay charges and also applicable service tax to the contractor for every calendar month within 15 days of submission of clear bills. TDS as applicable will be deducted at source from the payment.
- 3.3 The payments shall be made through RTGS/NEFT. The contractor would be required to submit bank details for receiving the payments.
- 3.4 Even if the **prices offered are inclusive of Taxes**, the contractor will have to produce invoices showing the tax elements separately.

3.5 In case the, TDS is not to be made, the contractor r will have to produce the exemption letter from the relevant authorities to this effect along with bill submitted for payment.

4.OBSERVANCE OF LOCAL LAWS:

- 4.1The Contractor shall comply with all Laws, Statutory Rules, Regulations etc. The Contractor shall obtain all necessary permits/approval from the local Governing Body, Police and other concerned Authorities as may be required under law.
- 4.2 The Contractor shall pay all taxes, fees, license charges, deposits, duties, tolls, royalty, commissions or other charges that may be Leviable on account of any of the operations connected with the execution of this contract.
- 4.3 The Contractor shall be responsible for the proper behavior and observance of all regulations by the staff employed.

5 RISK PURCHASE:

BHEL reserves to itself the following rights in respect of this Contract without entitling the Contractor for any compensation.

- 5.1If at any time during the validity of the contract, the contractor fails to render all or any of the services required under the scope of work of the contract satisfactorily in the opinion of BHEL, whose decision shall be final and binding on the contractor, BHEL reserves the right to get the work done by other parties at the risk and cost of the contractor and also forfeit the security deposit.
- 5.2 To recover any moneys due from the Contractor, from any money due to the Contractor under this or any other contract or from the Security Deposit.

5.3 To claim compensation for losses sustained including BHEL's supervision charges & overheads in case of termination of Contract.

6.0 SAFETY OF MEN, EQUIPMENT, MATERIAL & ENVIRONMENT:

6.1 All safety rules, codes applied by BHEL/its customer at site shall be observed by the Contractor and his workmen without exception. The Contractor shall be responsible for

7.1 The Contractor shall during the performance of the contract take a suitable insurance to cover against bodily injury, death or damage to property of the Contractor or his employees.

- 7.2 The Contractor shall during the performance of the contract take out a Third Party insurance cover against bodily injury or death suffered by any third party/parties or damage to property occurring during the course of execution of this contract in accordance with appropriate statutory requirements
- 7.3 If due to Contractor's carelessness, negligence, non-observance of safety precautions, improper security arrangements or due to non-compliance of paper work needed for lodging insurance claim, damage to BHEL/its Customer's property, and if BHEL is unable to recover its claim from the Insurance Company, the deficit will be recovered from the Contractor.

8.0 LAWS GOVERNING THE CONTRACT:

8.0 The contract shall be governed by the Indian Laws for the time being in force and only courts in Mumbai, India shall have jurisdiction over this contract.

9.0 INDEMNITY:

9.1 The Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified BHEL all losses, claims etc. arising out of any of his acts or out of the acts of his Contractors or associates or servants during the currency of the contract.

10.0 SECURTY DEPOSIT:

- 10.1 Successful bidder shall submit 5% of the total contract value as security deposit within Three days of issue of LOI for the contract.EMD of the successful Bidder shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security Deposit
- 10.2 Security deposit may be made in any of the following ways:

During the currency of the arbitration proceeding, the Contractor will have to continue to perform in line with the contract and will not abandon the work in any way.

- **12.1** The offers from the bidders shall enclose a EMD as per Techno commercial Bid in any one of the following forms :
 - (i) Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before tender opening)
 - (ii) Banker's cheque/ Pay order/ Demand draft, in favour of BHEL.
- **12.2** EMD of the Bidder will be forfeited if:
- 12.2.1 After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the Bidder revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.

- 12.2.2 The Contractor fails to deposit the required Security deposit or commence the work within the period as per LOI/ Contract
- 12.2.3 If the bidder declines to accept the LOI or is unable to accept the work which has been awarded on the basis of the offer received from the bidder or revokes the offer within the validity period of the offer, the earnest money shall stand forfeited

EMD by the Bidder shall be withheld in case any action on the Bidder is envisaged under the provisions of extant "Guidelines on Suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors" and forfeited/ released based on the action as determined under these guidelines.

- 12.3 EMD of successful bidder will be adjusted towards part of the security deposit.
- **12.4** EMD of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned normally within fifteen days of placement of LOI/Work Order on successful bidder.
- **12.5** EMD shall not carry any interest.

13.0 Discrepancy In Words & Figures: Quoted In Offer

- 13.1 If, in the price structure quoted for the required goods/ services/ works, there is discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (which is obtained by multiplying the unit price by the quantity), the unit price shall prevail and the total price corrected accordingly, unless in the opinion of the purchaser there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price corrected accordingly.
- 13.2 If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- 13.3 If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail.
- 13.4 If there is such discrepancy in an offer, the same shall be conveyed to the bidder with target date up to which the bidder has to send his acceptance on the above lines and if the bidder does not agree to the decision of the purchaser, the bid is liable to be ignored

14. REVERSE AUCTION:

14.1 BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) instead of opening the sealed price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. All bidders have give their acceptance for participation in RA. Non acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA. In case BHEL decides to go for Reverse Auction, only those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in RA will be allowed to

participate in the Reverse Auction. Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit "online sealed bid in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of "online sealed bid by the bidder will be considered a tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.

- 14.2 The procedure for Reverse Auction shall be intimated to such bidders in due course. However, the bidders are advised to quote their most competitive rates in the sealed bid Part. In case we are unable to finalize the order through Reverse Auction for any reason whatsoever, the order would befinalized based on the sealed price bids (Part-III).
- 14.3 In case of tender being finalized through Reverse Auction, the bidders will have to adhere to the guidelines provided in the Business Rules of Reverse Auction. In case a Techno commercially acceptable vendor does not agree to participate in the Reverse Auction process, the same will be treated as with drawl of the offer and their EMD will be forfeited. **Vendors are also warned against delay in participation and delaying the process of Reverse Auction.**

14.4 Terms and Conditions for Reverse Auction:

- **1.** For the proposed reverse auction, technically and commercially acceptable bidders only shall be eligible to participate.
- 2. Those bidders who have given their acceptance for Reverse Auction (quoted against this tender enquiry) will have to necessarily submit "online sealed bid" in the Reverse Auction. - 5. Business rules like event date, time, bid decrement, extension etc. also will be communicated through service provider for compliance.
- 6. Bidders have to fax the Compliance form (annexure IV) before start of Reverse auction. Without this, the bidder will not be eligible to participate in the event.
- 7. Reverse auction will be conducted on scheduled date & time.
- 8. At the end of Reverse Auction event, the lowest bidder value will be known on auction portal.
- 9. The lowest bidder has to fax/e-mail the duly signed and filled-in prescribed format for price breakup including that of line items, if required, (Annexure VII) as provided on case-to-case basis to Service provider within two working days of Auction without fail.

- 10. In case BHEL decides not to go for Reverse Auction procedure for this tender enquiry, the Price bids and price impacts, if any, already submitted and available with BHEL shall be opened as per BHEL"s standard practice.
- 11. Bidders shall be required to read the "Terms and Conditions" section of the auctions site of Service provider, using the Login IDs and passwords given to them by the service provider before reverse auction event. Bidders should acquaint themselves of the "Business Rules of Reverse Auction", which will be communicated before the Reverse Auction.
- 12. If the Bidder or any of his representatives are found to be involved in Price manipulation/ cartel formation of any kind, directly or indirectly by communicating with other bidders, action *as per extant BHEL guidelines*, shall be initiated by BHEL and the results of the RA scrapped/ aborted.

- 17.2.2. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract and shall adhere to relevant guidelines issued from time to time by Govt. of India/BHEL.
- **17.2.3**. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasonable cause, which causes loss of business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL.
- 18. If any bidder/ supplier/ contractor during pre-tendering/ tendering/ post tendering/ award/ execution/ post-execution stage indulges in mal-practices, cheating, bribery, fraud or and other

misconduct or formation of cartel so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price or acts or omits in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India, then, action may be taken against such bidder/ supplier/ contractor as per extant guidelines of the company available on www. bhel.com and/or under applicable legal provisions".

19. ARBITRATION

a) In the event of any dispute or difference arising out of the execution of the Order/Contract or the respective rights and liabilities of the parties or in relation to interpretation of any provision between BHEL & Service Provider in any manner touching upon the Order/Contract, such dispute or difference shall (except as to any matters, the decision of which is specifically provided for therein) be referred to the arbitration of the person appointed by the competent authority of BHEL.

Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made there under and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The venue of arbitration shall be at New Delhi.

b) In case of order/contract on Public Sector Enterprises (PSE) or a Govt. Deptt., the following clause shall be applicable:-

In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the Order/Contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred to by either party to the arbitration of one of the arbitrators in the department of public enterprises. The award of the arbitrator shall be binding upon the parties to the dispute, provided, however, any party aggrieved by such award may make a further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law secretary, Deptt. of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary or Additional Secretary when so authorized by the Law Secretary, whose decision shall bind the parties hereto finally and conclusively. The parties in the dispute will bear equally the cost of arbitration as intimated by the arbitrator.

20. LAWS GOVERNING THE CONTRACT

The Order/Contract shall be executed and governed by the laws of India and the courts of India alone shall have jurisdiction in respect of any matter arising under or in connection with the Order/Contract.

21. <u>JURISDICTION OF COURT</u>

Courts at Mumbai shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide the dispute, if any, arising out of or in respect of the contract(s) to which these conditions are applicable.
