1.	<p>a) Offer must be submitted in two part bid system for the item as per Enquiry in separate sealed covers :</p> <p>(i) For Techno commercial un-priced bid in one sealed cover / envelope and</p> <p>(ii) Another for priced bid in one more sealed cover / envelope</p> <p>(iii) Both the above covers at (i) & (ii) shall be put in a separate single cover clearly superscripting on the covers / envelopes the Supplier Name, enquiry no. and due date.</p> <p>b) "Un-priced offer with technical bid" is required to be furnished by the vendor.</p> <p>c) The difference between "Un-priced offer" and "priced offer" should be only the prices wherever applicable.</p> <p>d) Hand-written offers will not be acceptable.</p> <p>e) Techno-commercial bid will be opened first and after freezing technical & commercial conditions only, the price bid will be opened.</p>		
2.	<p>Offer validity should be 120 days minimum from date of price bid opening.</p>		
3.	<p>a) No revised offers will be accepted unless asked for / or any changes in specification</p> <p>b) The vendors will be allowed to submit the impact on their quoted prices due to changes in technical scope, specifications, commercial terms & conditions, only if in the opinion of BHEL such changes warrant changes in prices.</p>		
4.	<p>The quoted rates are to be on firm basis till the execution of order.</p>		
5.	<p>Payment Terms:</p> <p>a) The payment of lease charges will be made on quarterly basis after completion of each quarter and submission of invoices(s) in triplicate after signing the Lease Agreement.</p> <p>Bidder has to complete installation of all equipment at the locations identified by BHEL. Lease Period of Five years shall start from the date of successful installation of equipment by Bidder and acceptance by BHEL.</p>		
6.	<p>Penalty: For the delay in delivery, penalty shall be levied at the rate of 0.5% per week (or part thereof) subject to maximum of 10% of the total lease rent for entire lease period of all the equipments. This penalty will be deducted from the first quarter rental charges, in case the penalty</p>		

	amount to be deducted is more than the first quarter rental charges, the same will be adjusted from the consecutive quarter.		
7.	Warranty: Including 5 years warranty support with back to back support from OEM (Letter to this effect to be attached).		
8.	Supplies should strictly conform to BHEL Specification. All tests should be carried out as per BHEL Spec. All test certificates, guarantee certificates & Pre inspection reports should be furnished along with supplies. Clause-wise confirmation of specification is required to be submitted along with the technical bid, where ever applicable.		
9.	Registration Status: Vendors to confirm the status of the registration of their firm under Micro Vendors/Small Scale Unit/Large Scale Unit. Attach documentary evidence along with the technical bid.		
10.	Risk Purchase: a) If the vendor after placement of order fails to abide by the terms & conditions of the enquiry/ Purchase order, BHEL reserves the right to get the job executed from other agencies at the risk and cost of the vendor b) If the differential cost between the other agency and the original vendor is more, the same shall be recovered from the vendor along with incidental charges. c) If the differential charges are less than the original vendor price, no benefit on this account shall be passed on to the original vendor.		
11.	Force Majeure clause: If the party dose not supplied the material within stipulated time the force majeure clause will be applicable by not performing its contractual obligations due to unforeseen events beyond its control. These events include natural disasters such as floods, earthquakes and other "acts of God," as well as uncontrollable events such as war or terrorist attack. However, it does not cover failures resulting from a party's financial condition or negligence.

13.	Delivery time is 10 weeks from the date of placement of Purchase order/ Letter order.		
14.	Packing & Forwarding charges, if any to be indicated as percentage of Basic value.		
15.	Excise duty as applicable to be indicated		
16.	Taxes & Duties (CST / VAT) to be specified in percentage wherever applicable.		
17.	Service charges if any to be indicated.		
18.	Freight charges as applicable to be indicated		
19.	Insurance charges as applicable to be indicated		
20.	Evaluation: i) Price bids shall be evaluated on landed cost basis i.e., total cost to BHEL (after considering CENVAT or VAT benefit, if any) and w.r.t. the finalized technical scope and commercial conditions only. ii) In case of discrepancy in the prices quoted by the vendor in figures and words, the price quoted in words shall prevail and the same shall be considered for evaluation.		
21.	BHEL reserves the right to increase/ decrease the quantity		

	indicated and cancel the item(s) in the enquiry.		
22.	BHEL reserves the rights for rejecting any or all offers without assigning any reason thereof, in the interest of BHEL.		
23.	The Tender received after 11.00 hrs. on the due date will not be considered.		
24.	BHEL reserves the right to evaluate the tender either by reverse auction method or by conventional tendering process.		
25.	Price Schedule: a) Vendors are requested to submit the price bid in the format enclosed along with the enquiry. b) Price schedule duly filled up in all columns except the prices , duly signed & stamped by the vendor shall be submitted along with the techno-commercial offer.		
26.	Vendor has to ensure that along with material the following documents are to be submitted for entry into factory 1.Duplicate tax invoice for transporter 2.Dispatch document (DC) 3.Purchase Order copy		
27.	Reverse Auction: 1). BHEL reserves right to go for a reverse auction instead of opening the submitted price bid, based on the response received, BHEL will decide as its discretion to process the tender through reverse auction or by opening the price bids. Vendors are advised to accept reverse auction. Vendors are also advised not to quote higher prices in price bid, presuming that there will be an opportunity to reduce the same during the reverse auction. In case BHEL decides to process the tender by opening the price bids instead of reverse auction, there is no provision for revising the quoted prices and vendors may lose the opportunity by quoting higher prices.
