Intending vendors must remit the tender fee of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) against each tender in the form of bank draft while submitting the tender documents.

Amendments/Corrigendum, if any, will be hosted on our web site only. Other terms and conditions will be as per tender documents.

3. Envelope III : Techno-Commercial Bid.
4. Envelope IV : Price Bid

BIDS shall be opened at 2.00 PM on the due date in the presence of authorized representative of the bidders who may like to be present. The authorized representative should bring authority letter from their parent company (Manufacturer) for attending the bid opening.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS FOR OPEN TENDER

1.0 DEFINITION

Registered Vendors - Are those who are registered with BHEL, Haridwar for Megawatt rating/ Size/ Weight of tendered items in respective material grade or machining of such items.

Un-registered Vendors - Are those who are not registered with BHEL, Haridwar for Megawatt rating/ Size/ Weight of tendered items in respective material grade or machining of such items.

2.0 ESSENTIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Un-registered vendors may be approved by BHEL, if found suitable, on the basis of data furnished by them in Supplier Registration Form (SRF) for Foreign Vendors or Indigenous Vendors (as applicable).
2. BHEL team may visit the vendor (s) works for verification of capability and capacity claimed in tender documents/offer (s).
3. The tenders shall be submitted in three parts in separate sub-envelopes clearly super scribing type of bid, tender no., due date and the name of vendor with full contact details.
 - i. Part I – Tender fee or NSIC certificate for exemption of tender fee, Pre- Qualification requirement (Annex.2), Supplier Registration Form (Annexure – 4 or 5), Non Disclosure Agreement (Annexure-6) & Techno- Commercial Bid.
 - ii. Part II – Price Bid.All the four sub-envelopes to be put in a single covering envelope indicating tender no., due date and the name of vendor with full contact details. Offer should be complete in all respect (i.e. Part-I and Part-II).
4. Clearly state your status regarding Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises as per the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act-2006 by producing relevant certificate. MSE Suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (Two years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with CA certificate applicable for the year certifying quantum of investment in plant & machinery within the permissible limit as per the act for relevant status (Micro or small) where the deemed validity of EM II is over. Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the last date of technical bid submission.
5. Splitting is not applicable.
6. Any corrections / amendments shall be properly & fully authenticated with signature. No overwriting is acceptable.
7. Compliance of Pre Qualifying Conditions & Technical Acceptance Criteria as per attachment.
8. Part II containing Price Bid may be opened for those vendors who have qualified in the Part I.
9. Delivery schedule is as per our requirement. However vendor to quote best possible lead time from the date of placement of purchase order. Delivery is not sacrosanct. Offers of those vendors may not be considered if it is not found suitable to BHEL requirement.
10. Currency exchange rate will be applicable on the date of opening of Techno-commercial Bid for evaluation purpose.
11. BHEL reserves the right to split order on more than one vendor.
12. BHEL reserves the right to increase or decrease the tender quantities. Vendor should be prepared to accept order for reduced quantity without any extra charges. Vendor should also be prepared for giving quantity discount in case of increase in quantity.
13. BHEL reserves the right to reject any of all the quotations without assigning any reason thereof and no representation shall be entertained in this regard.
14. The bid shall be evaluated on landed cost to BHEL basis.
15. Total weight in Kg. & also package size essentially should be indicated.
16. BHEL will evaluate the technical bids against essential criteria/requirements. BHEL may seek clarifications, if required, from the qualified bidders only. The offers of those bidders, who are unable to respond in specified time frame, are likely to be ignored.
17. Validity of the offer shall be at least 120 days from the date of opening of techno-commercial bid.
18. LD Penalty shall be applicable at the rate of ½ % (half percent) per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the value of unexecuted portion of the order. In case of any variation in LD penalty, your prices shall be loaded to the extent, LD penalty not accepted by you.

19. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

- Indigenous Vendors: In all cases of dispute the matter shall be referred for arbitration to any arbitrator to be appointed by the Executive Director or any officer who is the administrative head of Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd., at Haridwar. The venue of arbitration shall invariably be Ranipur Haridwar. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. The arbitrator shall have the power to extend, from time to time, the time for making his award with the consent of the parties.
- Foreign Vendors: In the event of any dispute or difference arising between the parties to this contract regarding execution of same or their respective rights and liabilities there under, the same shall except as otherwise expressly provided therein, be referred to the arbitration of the two arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party; or in the case of the said arbitrators not agreeing then an umpire to be appointed by the two arbitrators in writing before entering on that reference and provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act, 1940 or any statutory notification, or re-enactment thereof and rules framed there under from time to time shall apply to such arbitration. If the two arbitrators do not agree on the appointment of umpire, the nomination of the umpire shall be done by the International Chamber of Commerce, Paris(France). The decision of arbitrators, or in case of their not agreeing, that of the said umpire shall be binding both on seller and purchaser. The venue of the arbitration invariably be New Delhi, India.

20. JURISDICTION

All question, dispute or differences arising under, out of or in connection with the purchase order shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of Haridwar courts.

21. OVER RIDING CLAUSE

All stipulations made in any correspondence other than those exchanged in regards to "instruction" in our tender documents / enquiry for submission of your offer, if at all shall be void to the extent they are repugnant to the conditions contained herein above and in the purchase order.

22. FINALITY OF MANAGEMENT DECISION

At all places in the preceding clauses BHEL Management's decision shall be final.

3.0 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID shall comprise of following documents:

- a. All the documents as per 2.3.i above. Techno-commercial bid shall be exact replica of price bid without prices.
- b. Complete technical offer as per specification, drawings, technical requirement and best possible lead time from the date of placement of purchase order as the delivery is not sacrosanct.
- c. Any additional documents.

Price Bid

- a. Price bid indicating prices to be submitted as part-IV of the tender.
- b. Prices shall remain firm till the execution of the order. Insurance shall be taken care by BHEL.
- c. For Indigenous Vendors : Please quote your rates on FOR destination basis. However, the insurance will be arranged by BHEL. You can despatch goods through any Indian Bank Association approved transporters having their branch at Haridwar/destination. For your convenience the names and addresses of transporters approved by IBA & BHEL are posted at our website <http://www.bhelhwr.co.in>. If any bidder still quotes on other than FOR destination basis then his offer will be loaded by the maximum freight, packing & forwarding charges quoted by any other bidder from the same or nearby station, against the enquiry/freight rate available BHEL. Further non-availability of BHEL approved transporter will not be accepted for rescheduling the delivery or waiver of penalties.

For Foreign Vendors :

(A) SEA CONSIGNMENTS:

Please quote your rates with both the options (a) FOB / FAS dispatching port & (b) C&F Landing Port. In case, if any vendor quotes only on C&F basis, the offer is liable to be rejected.

The import order will normally be placed on FOB / FAS basis as per Govt. Guidelines. BHEL will add freight, insurance and administrative charges for comparative statement.

In exceptional cases, the orders can be placed on C&F basis after approval from Ministry of

Shipping (Transchart).

(B) AIR CONSIGNMENTS:

Please quote your rates preferably with either of the options: (a) FCA dispatching Airport or (b) CPT Landing Airport.

- d. Prices are to be written in both Figures & Words. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail.
