Chapter-I Scope of work and Terms & conditions

1. SCOPE OF WORK:

Details of areas for "General disinfestations services and pest control treatment at BHEL, PSWR Hqrs & Transit Flats, Nagpur" are as follows:-

- 1. BHEL is having office setup at 5th & 6th floor of Shri Mohini Complex & 6th floor of Usha Complex, 345 Kingsway, Nagpur, Total 05 no spaces having total build-up area of 17445 sq ft.
- 2. BHEL is having transit flats located at 02 locations namely-
 - a). Shri Krishna Appt, macosabagh, near kadbi chowk, Nagpur (06 Flats), and
 b). VIP Transit Flat at 5, Ratnadeep housing Society, Byramji Town (01 Flat),
 Nagpur
- 2. General terms & conditions:
- 1. The rate should be quoted for superior quality of work.
- 2. The approved rates shall remain in force till completion of contract period.
- 3. Disinfestation shall be done using only approved/safer brands of pesticides / insecticides / rodenticides (ISI marked) approved by central insecticides board, etc. spraying the entire premises and surrounding area with special reference to kitchen pantries, toilets, drainage, sewer, furniture and fixtures by utilizing appropriate quality and quantity of chemical/pesticides which should cover complete eradication of all kinds of flying and crawling insects, beetles, pests, such as mosquitos, carpet moths, cockroaches, Lizards, bugs, rats etc.
- 4. Contractor shall also take all precautions to ensure that no damage & staining happen to any furniture fixture surface by way of spray used by their staff. In case, the said surfaces are damaged or get dirty, the contractor shall insure that the persons deployed by him clean the said surface as per the instructions of the authorized representative of the company.
- 5. Rodent control: Rodent treatment against rats and mice is to be carried out through trapping and baiting methods by using tracking powder or as instructed by BHEL authorised representative, as per latest ISI specifications. The chemical should be a branded ISI marked product of a company (Recumin Tracking Powder of bayer and equivalent). Physical & ultrasonic traps (not limited to gum traps) should also be deployed. Also non-lethal repellent system for rodent to be deployed at the specified places.
- 6. Anti-Termite (White ants treatment) with guarantee: Anti termite / wooden Borer treatment shall be done by using chloropyriphos 20 EC termisafe T. C. of Bayer's as per latest ISI specifications. To cover up all wooden furniture and fixture provided in the building. Applications by spraying and injecting in the holes & cavities in the furniture and fixture after keen observations of spots of termite attack and closing of holes, cavities.

The contractor shall have to do pest control services weekly in canteen at BHEL office premises and twice in a month in BHEL total sitting premises i.e. all the 05 blocks along with BHEL Transit Flats as elaborated under Sl.No 2/ Scope of work. Treatment day will be fixed as per schedule provided by HR department monthly.

- 8. <u>Penalty:</u> Service provider for general disinfestations services and pest control treatment should be done effectively. On receiving of written complaint for improper / inferior quality of work etc, Rs. 100/-(Rupees one hundred only) as penalty shall be recoverable from the monthly payment due and payable to the service provider on each incident found by BHEL. In addition, if the service is not provided on BHEL recommended date, the penalty @ Rs.100/- will be applicable for each day of delay till providing the service.
- 9. While using insecticides/any other harmful chemicals, the contractor must comply and implement all the statutory provisions of the State & Central Acts relating to the pest control work for example, The Insecticides Act, 1968 and Insecticides Rules, 1971 etc. In the event of non-compliance, the contractor will be solely responsible for any penalty/fine imposed by the statutory bodies. The firm/contractor shall be solely and fully responsible for lapses, violation and noncompliance (if any) & all the statutory dues and BHEL shall in no way be a party to it.
